What's New

In addition to the launch of a new Touring Coupe trim, the 2016 Accord receives an extensive update to stretch its lead over the competition.

ALL TRIM LEVELS:

- Styling updates include a new grille, headlights, front fascia, hood (Sedan), taillights and rear fascia.
- Every trim wears handsome new wheels.
- A comprehensive Honda Sensing[™] suite of safety and driver-assistive technologies is either available or standard on every single trim level (CVT- or 6AT-equipped models). It includes these features:
 - Collision Mitigation Braking System[™] (CMBS[™])¹
 - Forward Collision Warning (FCW)²
 - Lane Departure Warning (LDW)³
 - Road Departure Mitigation (RDM)⁴
 - Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC)⁵
 - Lane Keeping Assist System (LKAS)⁶
- Four-cylinder single-exhaust CVT sedan models receive a 1-mpg higher EPA highway fuel-economy rating,⁷ thanks to reduced engine friction, less rolling resistance and smoother aerodynamics.
- The Electric Power Steering (EPS) on all trims has been retuned for better road feel and responsiveness.
- Every Accord Sedan now features an aluminum hood for lower weight, improving fuel efficiency and dynamic performance.
- Accord's body structure has been stiffened in several places for greater cornering accuracy.

2016 Accord vs. 2015 Toyota Camry

 Accord 4-cylinder and V-6 engines have more power and torque.



 Accord comes with a choice of CVT, 6MT or 6AT transmissions, but only a 6AT is available on Camry.

- The 4-cylinder CVT single-exhaust Accord Sedan models have better EPA fuel-economy ratings than the 4-cylinder Camry in every category (see charts below).
- Accord V-6 Sedans have a much better EPA highway fuel-economy rating than the Camry V-6 (see charts below).
- Accord has more interior room in most dimensions including every front-row measure (non-moonroof models).
