

Promethean ActivInspire: Downloading and Using Resource Packs

The Promethean Planet website has tons of resource packs for educators to download. Resource packs will contain such things as images and activities. Note that you must back up any downloaded resource packs or you will have to re-download them if your computer fails or after you return from summer break.

1. Navigate to the **Promethean Planet website**: <http://www.prometheanplanet.com/>

2. **Log into** the site

Enter your **planet ID** and your **password**. Then click the **login button**.

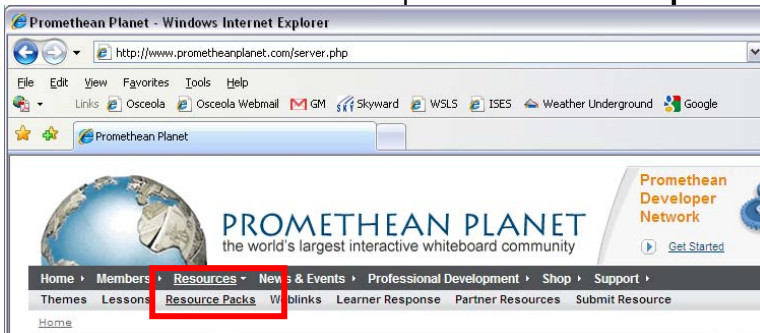

3. Click the **resources link** to explore the **resource packs** available.



4. **Search for a resource** you currently desire to use by **typing keywords in the search box**. You can also set your subject area and grade level to search. Be sure to check the resource packs radio button if you just want resources and not lessons.

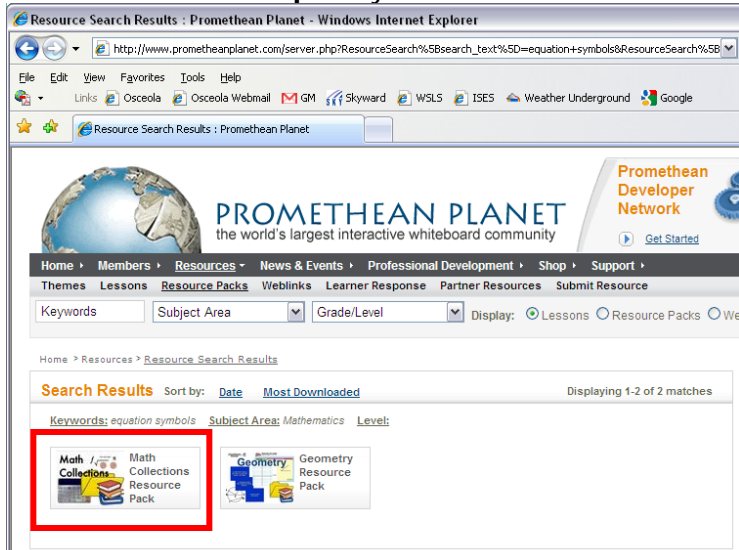

Enter keywords and use the drop down to select your subject area.

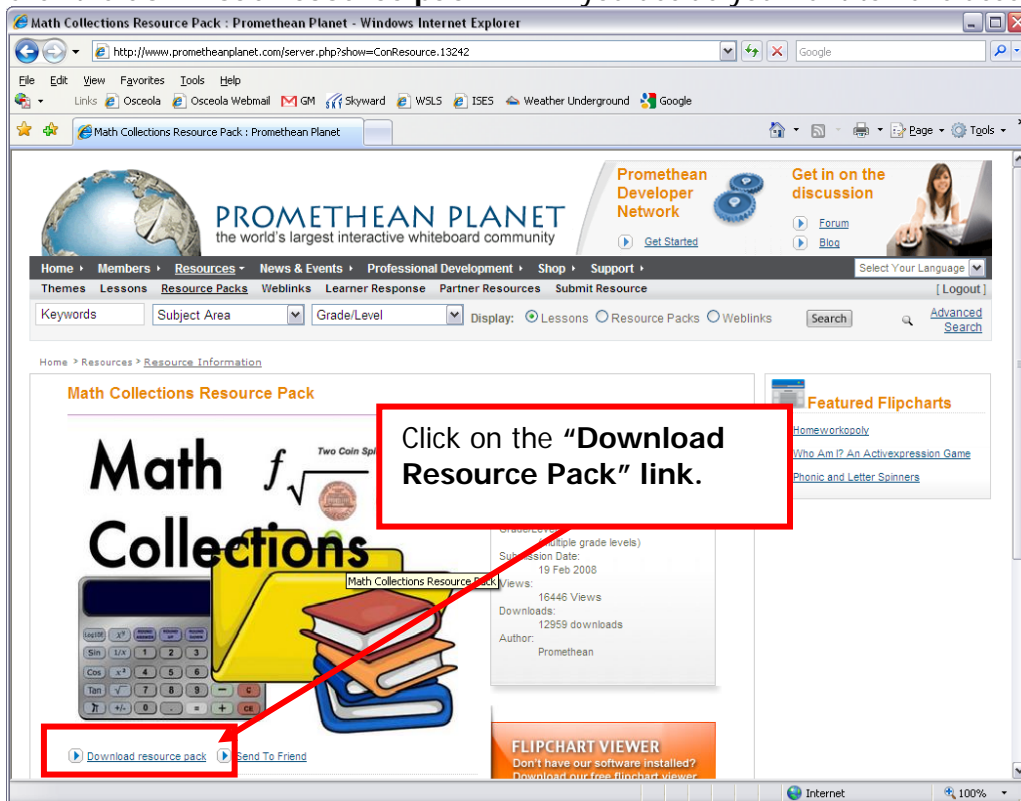

5. Click on a resource pack you want to learn more about.



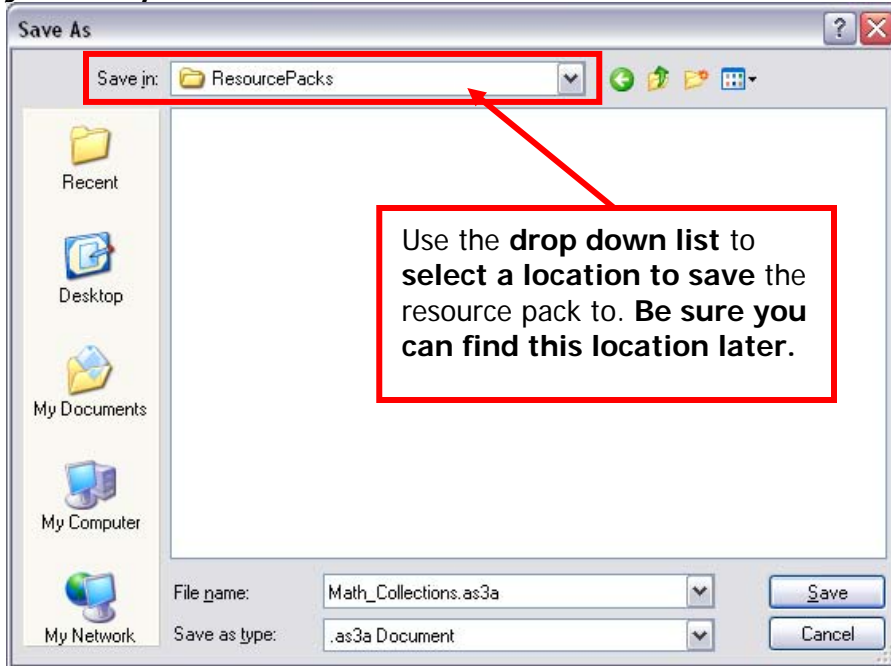
6. Click the **download resource pack** link if you decide you want to have access to these resources.



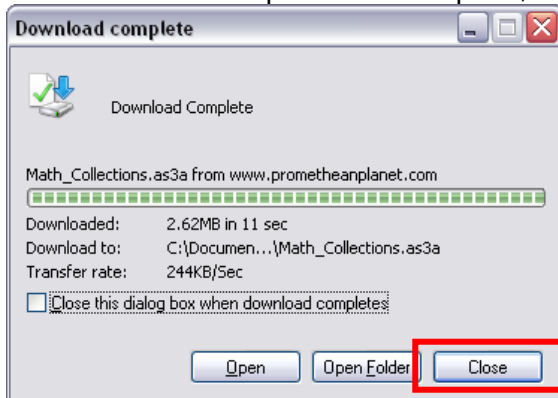
7. Click the **save** button to start the download process.



8. Use the **drop down menu** to save the resource pack to a location you will find it later. *Please note that you will need to back up all your downloaded resources to save them in case your computer should fail.*

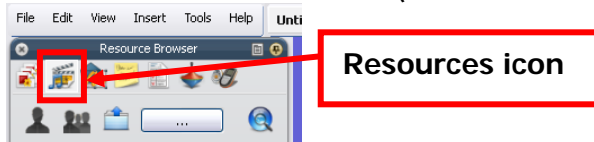


9. Once the download process is complete, **click the close button.**

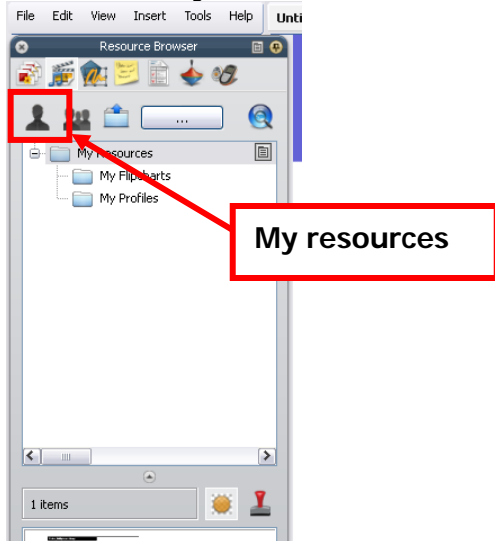


10. Open **ActivInspire**

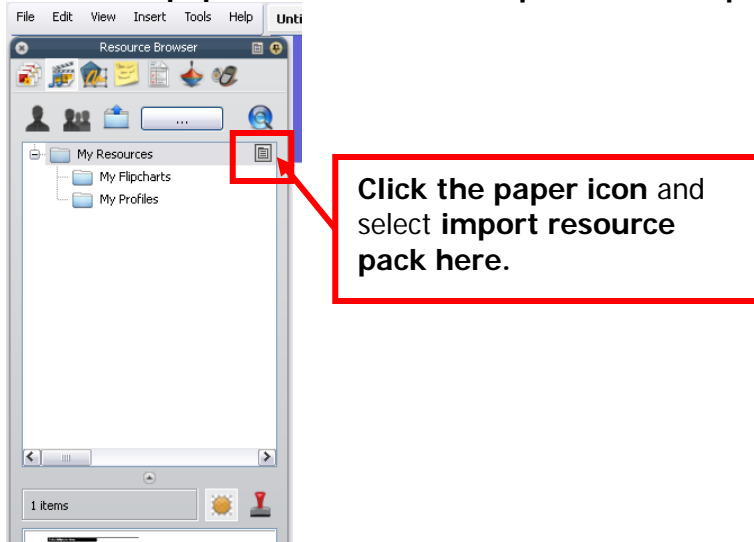
11. Click on the **resources icon in the browsers**. If the **browsers are not turned on**, go to the **view menu** and **select browsers** (if **browsers** is already checked, then they are already turned on).



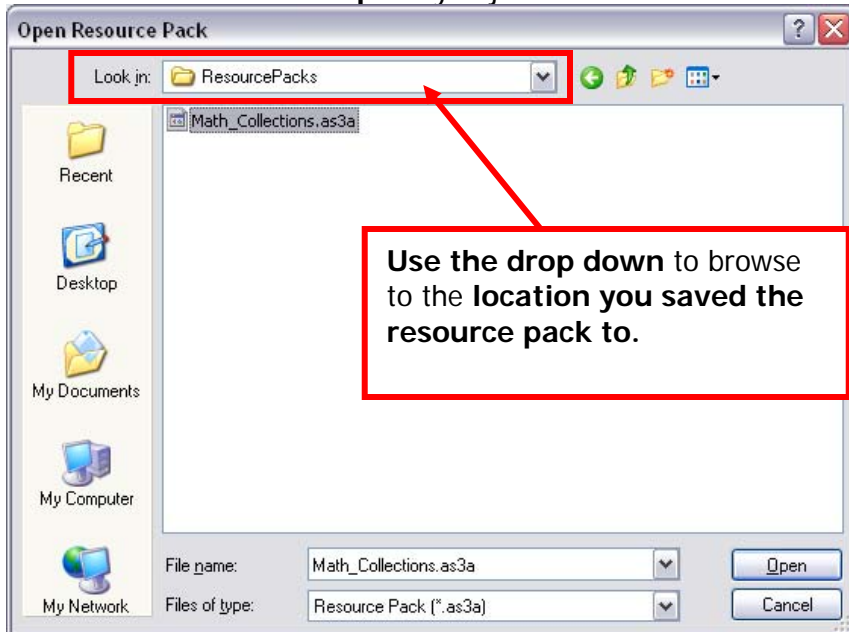
12. Click on the **My Resources** icon

14. **Browse to the resource pack** you just downloaded and **click open**
