
- 1. Is more commonly associated with ipsilateral varicocele
- 2. Develops in Hesselbach triangle
- x = 3. Is more commonly associated with torsion of ipsilateral testis

Option 1:	Neither direct nor indirect hernia is associated with varicocele. A "sports hernia" is groin pain without demonstrable inguinal hernia in an athlete related to overuse of abdominal and upper thigh muscles.
Option 2:	A direct hernia occurs through Hesselbach triangle.
Option 3:	Torsion of the testis typically occurs after vigorous exercise and is unrelated to inguinal hernia. Nearly 90% of patients who have testicular torsion have nausea and vomiting. The testis is swollen, elevated, and may lie horizontally.
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
