



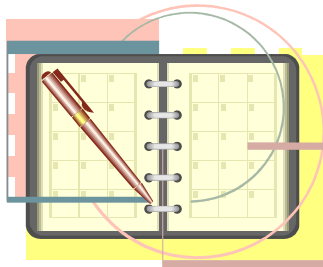

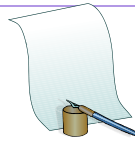

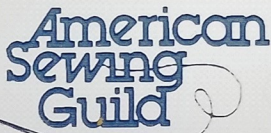
If you know of other venues that would make a good annual meeting, let us know. We are always open to new possibilities and experiences.

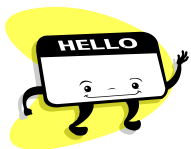

East Valley Project: Curve Appeal Table Runner

At the June meeting, Lyn Verdrey (below left picture) guided East Valley Neighborhood Group members through the process of creating stylish table runners and placemats using a pattern from Tiger Lily Press. Members purchased their patterns several months ago, chose their fabric, and had it cut and ready to sew during the June meeting. The placemats and table runners quickly took shape under Lyn's expert guidance.



Judy Sharp (upper right picture) basted her bias tape to the placemat using small dots of Fabri-Tac adhesive by Beacon (pictured above) in preparation for top-stitching. Several members who use this product reported that it works well as a temporary, and even permanent bonding agent for their projects.



Joan Livingston (left picture) demonstrated the use of a bias-tape maker while Arlene Haferman and Barb Rice observed. Although it would be quicker to use purchased bias tape, members preferred making their own bias tape using contrasting fabric.

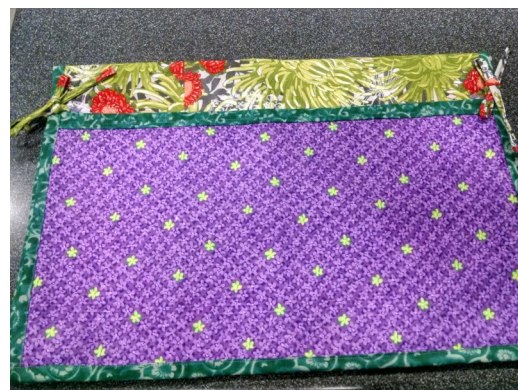

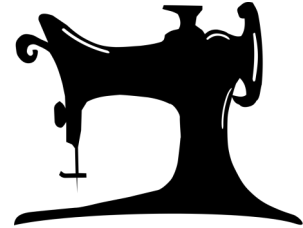

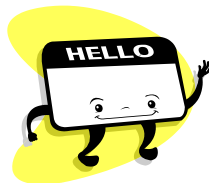
