Next, spot an abundance of wildlife in the Lamar Valley, where wolves, bison and elk take advantage of the natural warmth. Cover the park's interior on foot and by snow coach, past frozen waterfalls and winter landscapes that are inaccessible to cars. Spend time near Old Faithful exploring the area by snowshoe and on cross-country skies. Enjoy the serenity of Yellowstone without the crowds, and relax in warm and welcoming lodges each night. This is a winter adventure like no other!

Itinerary

DAY 1 ARRIVE IN BOZEMAN, MONTANA

Welcome to Bozeman, Montana a historic gateway town on the edge of forest and mountain wilderness. Upon arrival in Bozeman, take a complimentary shuttle to the hotel. Meet up with the group for orientation and a welcome dinner.

DAY 2 SCENIC DRIVE TO YELLOWSTONE'S PARADISE VALLEY & MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS

Depart from Bozeman this morning and enjoy a scenic drive through Paradise Valley to Yellowstone National Park. Along the way, stop in the quaint town of Gardiner for an early lunch before heading to Mammoth Hot Springs. Step out in your cross-country skis this afternoon and experience the winter wonderland of the Upper Terrace Loop Trail. This spectacular route leads to views of the hot springs, travertine terraces, and the surrounding mountains. Relax at your historic hotel tonight.

Activity: 2-3 hours/1.5-3 miles cross-country skiing with 200' elevation gain (easy to moderate options) Meals: B, L, D

DAY 3 SPOT WILDLIFE IN LAMAR VALLEY & TAKE A SNOW COACH TO OLD FAITHFUL

Start the day early with a trip to Lamar Valley, home to a large variety of the park's most charismatic creatures — wolves, bison, and elk! The valley's open meadows, framed by tree lines and mountains, provide habitat to support a large variety of animals. And with winter's white backdrop, they are much easier to spot. Board your private snow coach for a 4- to -5-hour interpretive journey from Mammoth Hot Springs to Old Faithful, where you'll spend the next two nights. The snow coach makes several stops along the way to share information on geothermal features and special features in the park.

Activity: 3 hours wildlife sightseeing

DAY 4 OLD FAITHFUL CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING & WINTER NIGHTS SOUNDSCAPE EXPERIENCE

Rise today for an exciting day of cross-country skiing in the Old Faithful area, at an elevation of 7,350 feet. With trails that begin right out the front door of the lodge, you'll be deep in the heart of a winter wonderland in moments! Enjoy skiing on mostly groomed trails, passing near thermal features where bison, elk and other animals take advantage of the warm ground. After an early dinner, hop into a heated snow coach with some

hot chocolate to experience the sights and sounds of Yellowstone at night. This is a unique adventure for your senses!

Activity: 3-6 hours cross-country skiing (options available)/2 hours snowcoach night tour

Meals: B, L, D

DAY 5 FIREHOLE RIVER SNOWSHOE TRAIL & JOURNEY TO CHICO HOT SPRINGS

This morning spend time in the woods on snowshoes! Snowshoe along the Firehole River and explore thermal basins with your interpretive guide. Hang up your snowshoes and board your private snow coach back to Mammoth Hot Springs. Next, transfer to Chico Hot Springs in the heart of Paradise Valley and enjoy a final farewell dinner with the group.

Activity: 3 hours snowshoeing

Meals: B, L, D

DAY 6 RELAX AT CHICO'S NATURAL HOT SPRINGS & DEPART FROM BOZEMAN

Enjoy a quiet morning or take an early plunge in the soothing open-air natural mineral hot spring pools at Chico. After breakfast, transfer from the hotel to Bozeman and bid farewell to Montana.
