
# Present Simple

#### 1. We use the Present Simple for:

- regular habits and daily routines;
- facts, things in general;
- permanent or long-lasting situations;
- timetables and schedules.



- always sometimes every day
- often rarely ...
- usually never

#### **FORM:**

1. To form the Present Simple we add -s to the infinitive of the verb in the  $3^{rd}$  person singular (he, she, it)

E.g.: | live

He / She / It lives







2. But when the verb ends in:

a) 
$$-o$$
,  $-ss$ ,  $-sh$ ,  $-ch$ , we add  $-es$ 

E.g.:  $|g_0 \rightarrow he/she/it goes$ 

I ki<u>ss</u> → he/she/it kisses

I wash → he/she/it washes

I watch → he/she/it watches



b) a consonant followed by -y, the -y changes into -ie and we add -s

E.g.: I study → he/she studies

c) a vowel followed by -y we just add -s

E.g.: I play  $\rightarrow$  he/she plays

3. To form the **negative** and the **interrogative** we need the auxiliary verb <u>to do</u> in the present simple. This means we have to add <u>-es</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> person singular (he, she, it) while the main verb will be used in the infinitive.

E.g.: Do you like?

Does he like?

You <u>don't</u> like. She doesn't like.
