We will also create AFTJ goods, such as notepads and T-shirts, using the logo and/or character.

1. Contest Policy

A. Contestants must meet all the requirements as outlined in this document.

2. Eligibility

- A. To participate in these contests, a student should currently be enrolled or were enrolled during the 2014-2015 academic year in a Japanese course (language or cultural content) taught by an AFTJ teacher member.
- B. A student can participate in both logo and character contests.

3. Registration

Only the contestants who pre-register will be allowed to participate. The registration form can be found on the last page of this guideline packet.

4. Logo and Character Requirements:

- A. Contestants may submit an **ORIGINAL** hand-written or digitally-created logo and/or character.
 - 1. Contestants may create the logo and character by hand with any writing utensils (penciled creations will need to be darkened for scanning purposes)
 - 2. Contestants may create the logo and character digitally using any image-design software available to them. Use the CMYK format for printing.
- B. A logo and/or a character must include the word "AFTJ" in the design.
- C. Designs should be on a *white background with 1) up to 3 colors for AFTJ logo and 2) up to 4 colors for AFTJ character. *CMYK (c, m, y, k) (0, 0, 0, 0)
- D. Provide a brief explanation of the design concepts under the author's name and school name, using the submission form. The submission form can be found on the second to the last page of this guideline packet.

5. Formatting:

- A. Design each entry (logo/character) to fit within **6 inches x 6 inches square**. (The template is available on the next page.)
- B. The hand drawn entry must be scanned and submitted electronically in the **JPEG** image format. Use a resolution of **600dpi** (**3600** x **3600** pixels) or higher for scanning.

6. Submission Guidelines

- A. Each contestant can submit only one entry for the logo contest and one entry for the character contest.
- B. Name the JPEG file(s) with the author's last name, school name, and the category (logo or character).

(e.g. nozu usf logo.jpg / nozu usf character.jpg)

- C. Submit a logo/character in the **JPEG format** with the submission form to Motohashi Soichiro (Soichiro.Motohashi@kzoo.edu).
- D. Alternatively, we accept a logo/character in the **PNG format with transparent background**.
- E. The submission due date is **5:00pm on Friday, October 30.**



7. Prizes:


- A. The winning logo and character designers will each receive:

- B. The committee' decisions will be final.


9. Intellectual Property:
