

About Website Backups

A website backup is a copy of all your website's data. Backups should include products, themes, categories, customer data, orders, pages, blog posts, inventory, gift certificates, and more. Industry best practices recommend the 3-2-1 backup strategy: 3 copies of your data, on 2 different mediums, with 1 copy stored offsite (or on a cloud backup app such as Rewind).

A reliable backup should be:

- Updated as often as your website gets changed
- Capturing as much data from your site as possible
- Stored in a separate location from your website, and easy to access and restore.

What Shopify and BigCommerce Offer In Terms of Backups

- You and your ecommerce service provider (Shopify/BigCommerce) share the responsibility of keeping your data secure and available.
- BigCommerce and Shopify are responsible for the software, infrastructure, and disaster recovery of the entire platform. Merchants
 are responsible for password security, permissions given to users and third-party apps, and backups of the data put into their stores.
- Both have a macro-backup of their entire system but they will NOT use it to recover a single account to a previous point in time.





Shopify and BigCommerce don't save all the data that stores need to be up and running. They follow something called the Shared Responsibility Model of data storage:



Facts about Ecommerce Security

- The most vulnerable industry is ecommerce, experiencing 32.4% attacks in various forms. Ecommerce sites and apps have storage and exchanges of critical data and sensitive info, so it tempts malicious elements the most. (source)
- Nearly 70% of small business websites will face some type of cyber attack. In 2019, 10% percent of small businesses hit with a cyberattack were forced to shut down as a result. (source)
