



HOW TO WRITE GOOD SHORT ANSWER QUESTIONS (SAQS)

It's easy! You already do this in science! It's called **CER**.

Claim.

Answer the question!

Evidence.

Support your answer with specific evidence!

Reasoning.

Explain your evidence!

This is the same thing as ACE (answer, cite, explain) and APE (answer, provide, explain)

One thing that changed from middle school to high school was my writing skill. One effect of the Neolithic Revolution was population growth. With the advent of agriculture, a larger population could be supported due to a reliable surplus of grains like wheat and barley. Because food was more readily available and was easier to acquire, families could support more children, which led to an overall population increase.
