
Air Vehicles Directorate Visitor's Guide

Visiting Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Area B

Personnel visiting the Air Vehicles Directorate between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. should enter through Gate 1B on Springfield Pike and stop at the Visitor Reception Center, Building 58 (telephone 937-255-3238), to obtain personal and vehicle passes. Vehicle registration papers must be presented. After registering, display the vehicle pass in the lower left corner of your car's windshield. This will allow you to enter and exit the base through any open gate for the remainder of that day. If you plan to arrive after 5 p.m. on a weekend or holiday, please contact the person or organization you are visiting prior to your arrival for entry instructions.

Airport Limo Services

A commercial airport limo service is available between the Dayton International Airport and Wright-Patterson AFB. Trips begin from the airport at 6:00 a.m. Monday through Friday. Their hours are 6 a.m. to midnight Sunday through Thursday and 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Friday and Saturday. The cost is \$25 one-way, and \$47 round-trip. For additional information, call 937-898-4043.

To Wright-Patterson AFB, Area B, Gate 1B

From Cincinnati

I-75N to I-675E, exit 15 (Col. Glenn Hwy).

Turn right on Col. Glenn Hwy. Turn right on Harshman Rd. Turn right on Springfield Pk.

Pass the Air Force Museum.

Turn right at Gate 1B. Stay in left lane to Visitor's Reception Center, Building 58.

From Columbus

I-70W to I-675S, exit 15 (Col. Glenn Hwy.)

Turn right on Col. Glenn Hwy. Turn right on Harshman Rd.

Turn right on Springfield Pk.

Pass the Air Force Museum.

Turn right at Gate 1B.

Stay in left lane to Visitor's

Reception Center, Building 58.

From Dayton International Airport

I-70E to I-75S.

Exit on Webster St./Route 4.

Contine on Route 4.


Exit on Harshman Rd. to the right.

Exit on Springfield Pk.

Proceed under the overpass.

One mile on the right is Gate 1B.

Once you enter the base, stay in the left lane to the visitor's center.

I-70W to I-675S, exit 17. Turn right on N. Fairfield Rd.


From Dayton International Airport


I-70E to I-675S. Exit 17 to N. Fairfield Rd. Turn right to area hotels.


It is approximately 20 to 25 miles from the Dayton airport to Area B and nearby hotels, a 20 to 30 minute drive.



Directions to the Air Vehicles Director's Office

From Gate 1B

Stay in left lane through the gate.

Continue up the hill and turn right at K Street.

Continue to the stop sign and turn left on Eighth Street.

Use the parking lot across Eighth Street from Building 45.

Enter on L Street.

From Gate 19B

Turn left on Skyline Drive.

Turn right on Eighth Street.

Building 45 is the third building on the left.

Use the parking lot across Eighth Street from Building 45.

Enter on L Street.

From Gate 22B

Stay in right lane through the gate.

Bear right onto Loop Road just inside the gate.

Turn left on Tenth Street.


Turn right on M Street and left on Eighth Street.

Building 45 is on the left.


Use the parking lot across Eighth Street from

Enter on L Street.




