

AKO-5004 Software Installation Instructions



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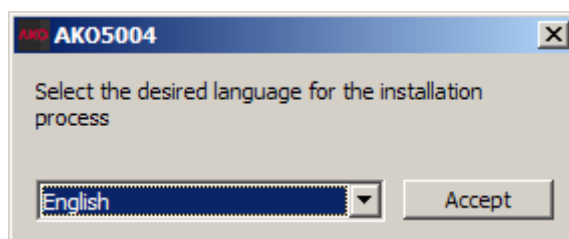
Minimum Requirements

The minimum system requirements for AKO5004 to function properly are:

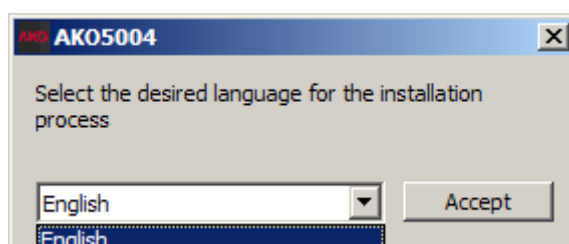
- NTFS file system.
- Operating System: Windows XP SP2, Windows Vista 32 bits, Windows 7 32 bits or Windows 2003 Server.
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher.
- 512 MB of RAM
- 800 MHz processor
- Approximately 100 MB of hard disc space per sensor connected for one year, on any device.
- CD-ROM drive
- Mouse
- VGA video card and monitor. Recommended resolution: 1024 x 768.
- 1 free USB port.

Installation Process

Insert the CD that came with the product into your computer's CD-ROM drive. The following window will appear:



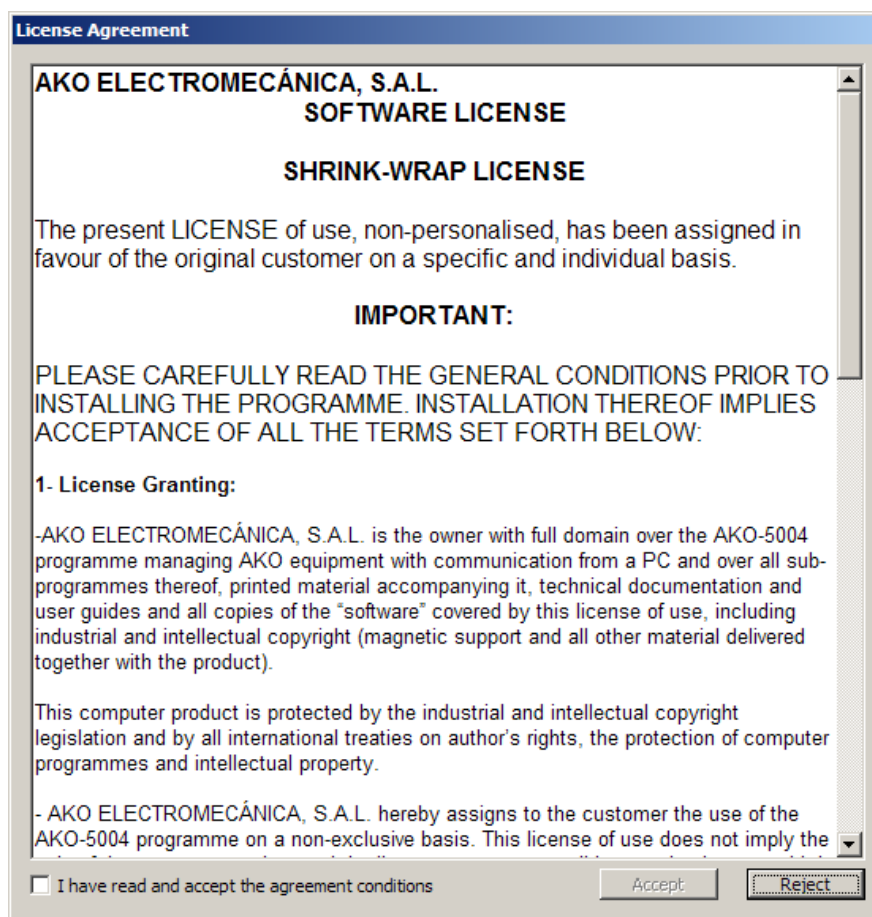
The language selected by default is Spanish, but you can change it by clicking on the drop-down menu.



When you have selected the language, click **Accept**.

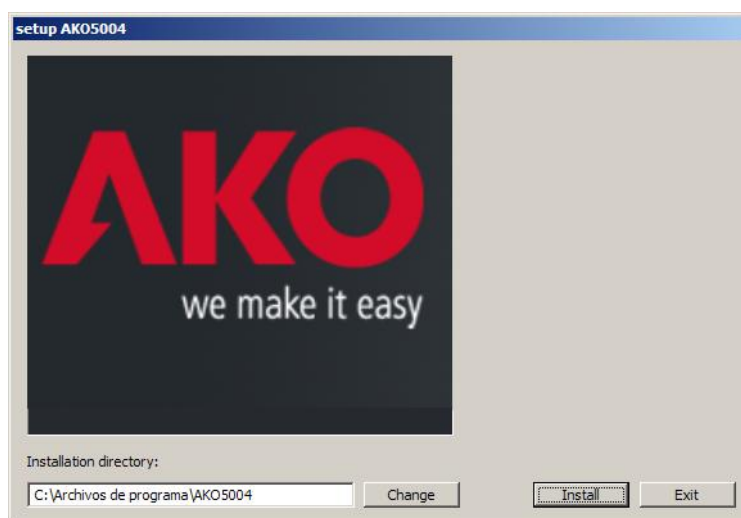
As shown below, the License Agreement will appear with the general conditions listed with all the terms that the user must **accept** in order to continue with the installation process.

If you click the **Reject** button, you will immediately exit the software installation process.

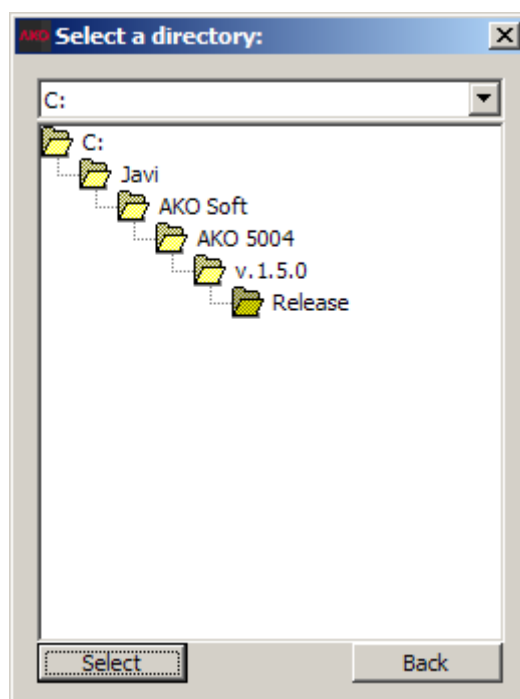


To accept the conditions, you must select **I have read and accept the agreement conditions** and click the **Accept** button.

As shown below, the system will allow you to select the directory in which to install the application.



By clicking on **Change**, you will access your computer's directory tree. From here, you will be able to choose the subdirectory where the application will be installed:

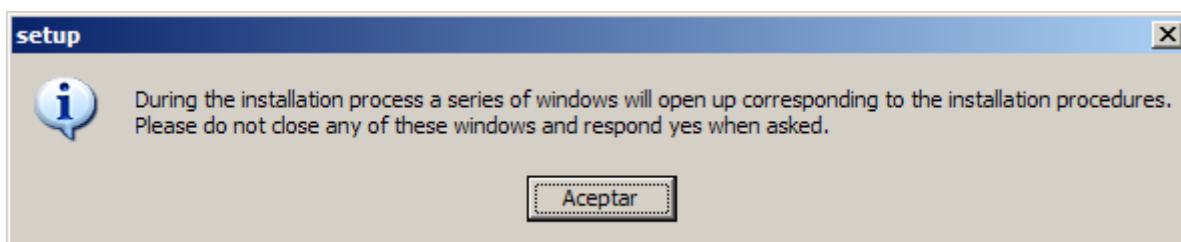


Select the subdirectory where you want to install the application and click **Select**. The selected directory will appear as Installation Directory.

ATTENTION, changing the default installation directory is not recommended.

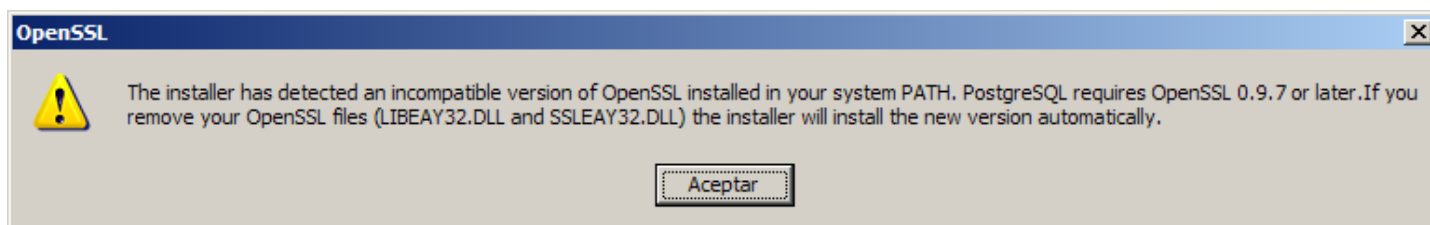
Then click on **Install** and the installation process will begin.

The first window explains that the installation process requires you to be present since it will ask a number of questions that you must respond to. Click **Accept** and the process will begin to install the software.

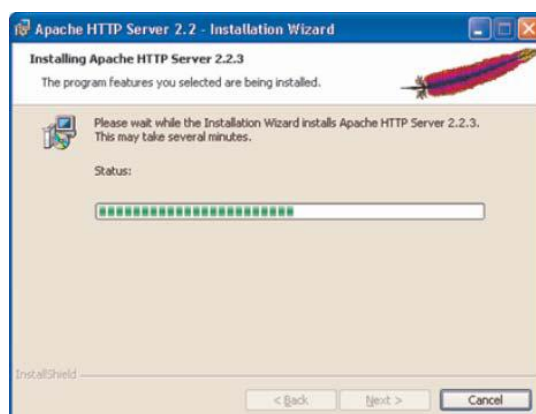
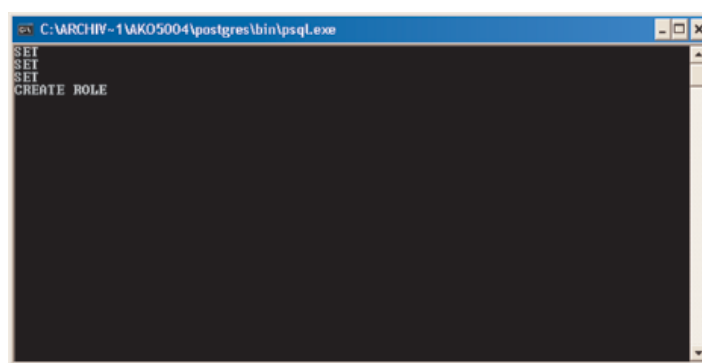
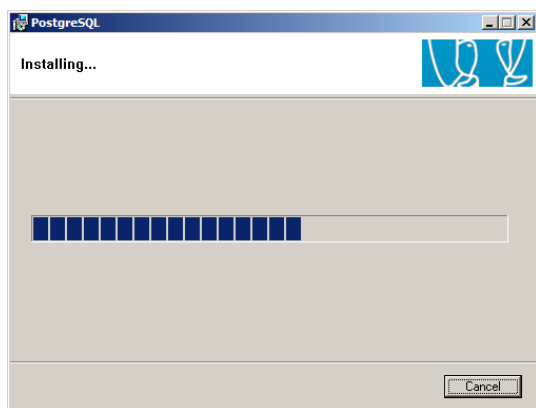


The system will now begin to install the different applications that comprise AKO 5004.

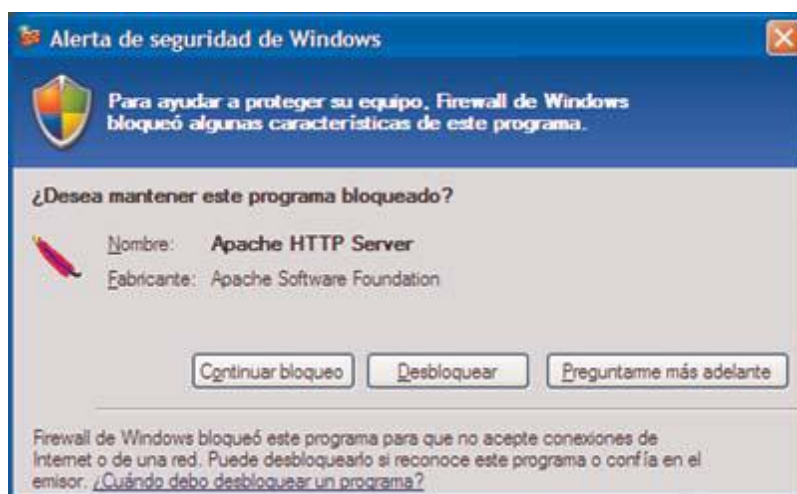
The installation setup may display the following dialogue. This is a message informing you that the application is attempting to install a dll file that already exists on your system. Click **Accept** and the process will continue as normal.



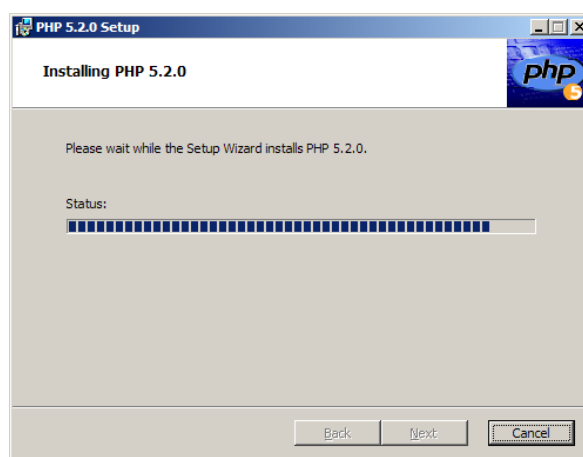
The system will now begin to install the different products that comprise AKO 5004, and the following windows will appear:



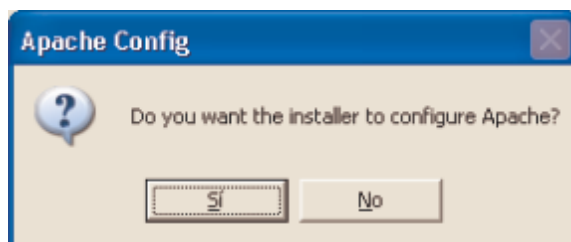
At this point, in some cases, your system may display the following window (it may remain hidden until the end of the installation):



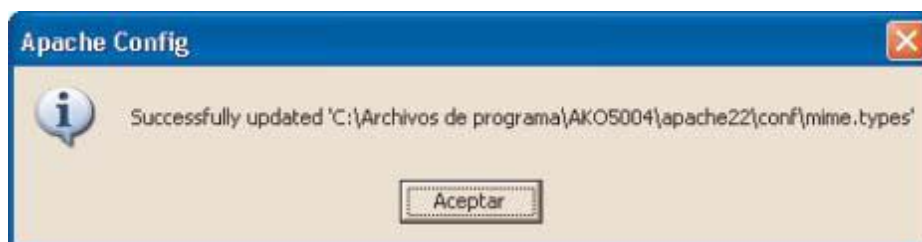
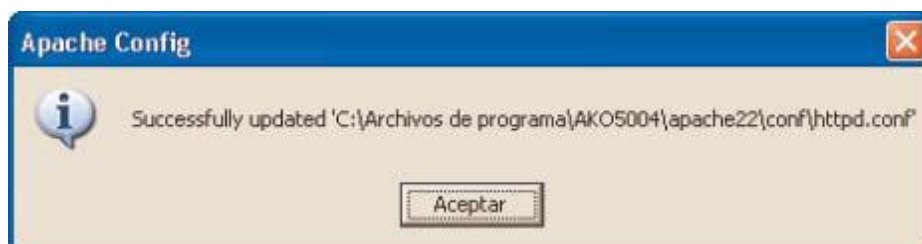
This Windows Security Alert comes from Windows Firewall. Click **Unblock**.



When this product (**PHP 5.2.0**) is installed the system will ask you:

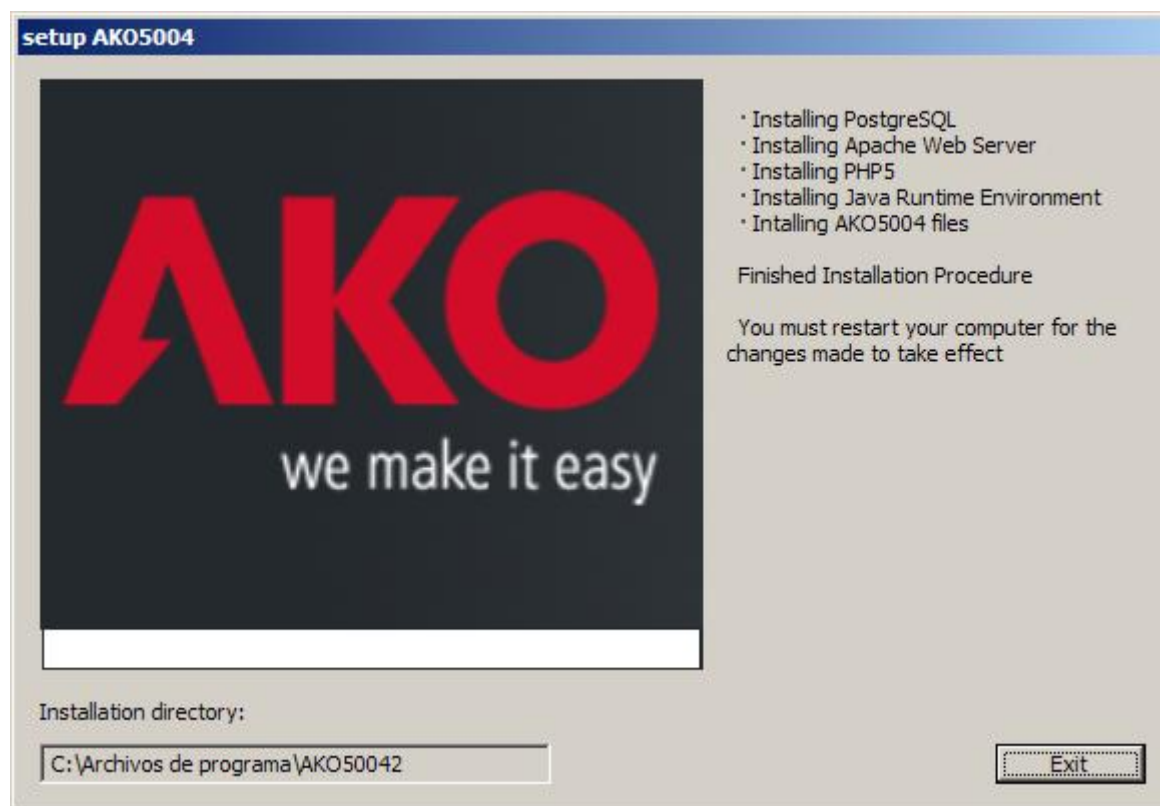


Click Yes, which will bring up two new messages:



Click Accept and the system will proceed with the installation.

Finally, Setup will display the following window informing you that the installation has been successfully completed.

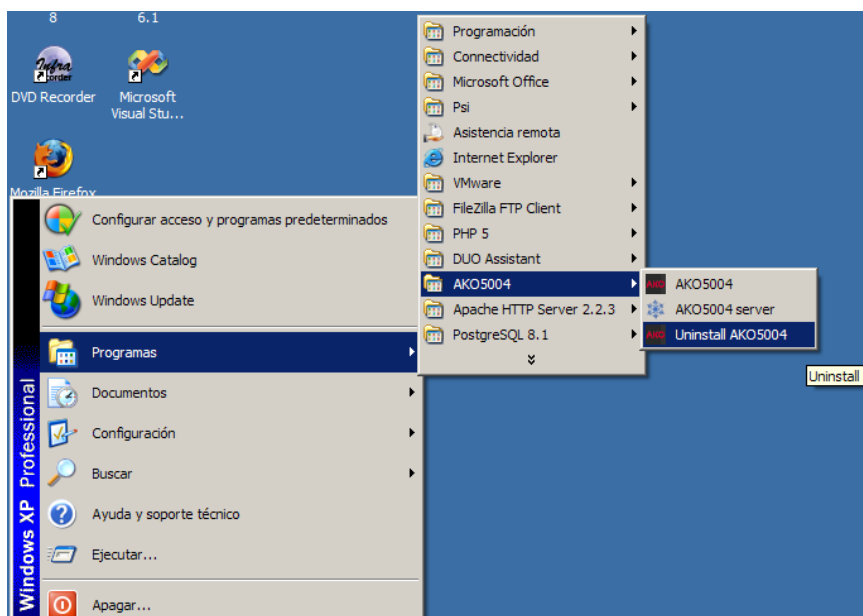


Click **Exit** to close the installation.

ATTENTION, you will need to restart your computer for the application to work properly.

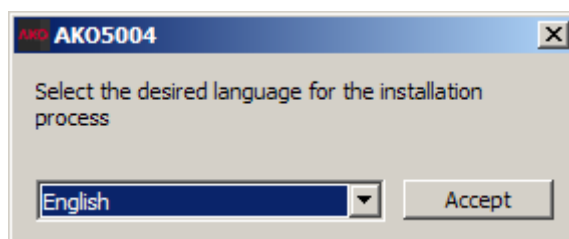
Uninstalling the Product (Automatic)

AKO 5004 has an automatic uninstall process. To uninstall, run the programme Uninstall AKO 5004 that is located in:



The application will guide you through the process of uninstalling the product.

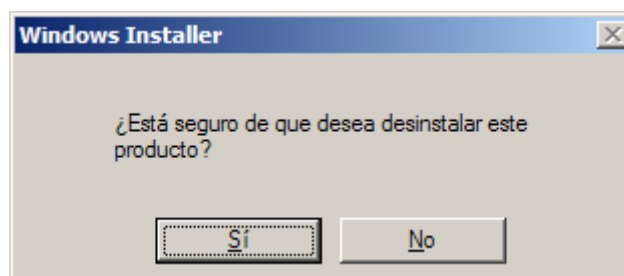
It will first ask you to select the language:



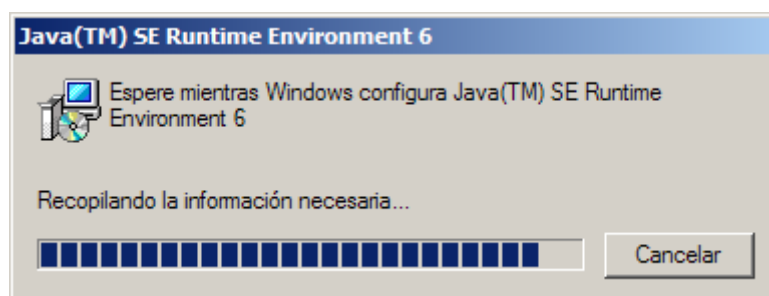
Once selected, click **Accept**, which will begin the AKO 5004 uninstall process after displaying a window to inform you that the uninstall will be irreversible and will ask for your confirmation. If you are sure you want to uninstall AKO 5004, click the **Uninstall** button.



The process will ask you again if you are sure that you want to do this. Click Yes.



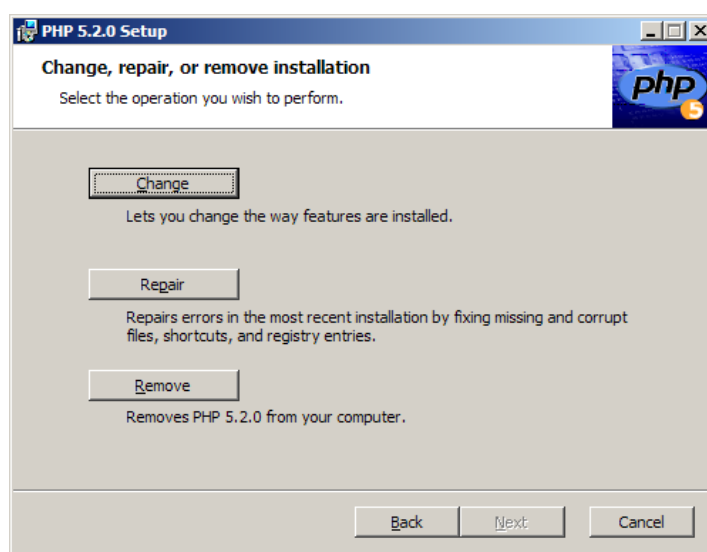
The uninstaller will now begin to display a series of windows with information about the product uninstall. Follow the instructions in this manual to complete the uninstall correctly:



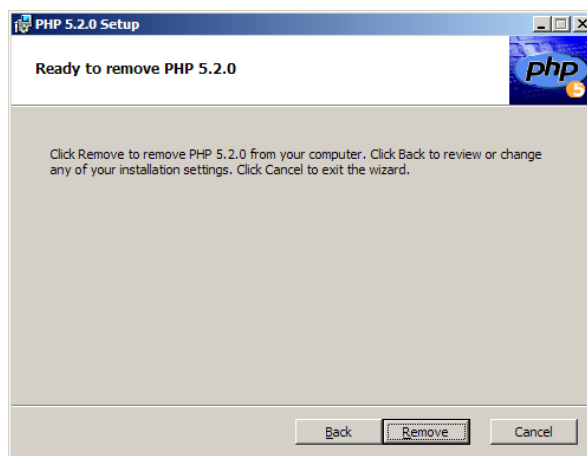
At this window, click **Next**:



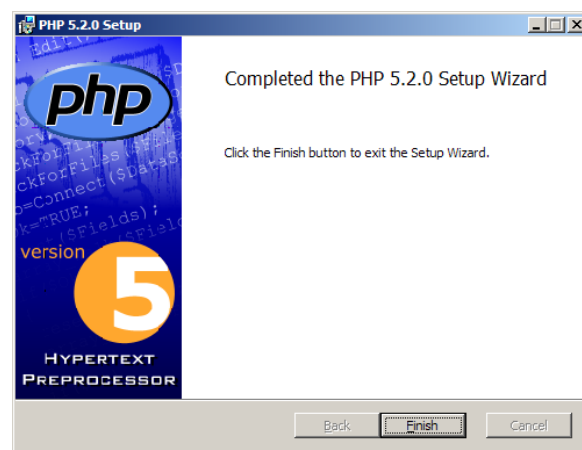
Select the **Remove** option and click **Next**:



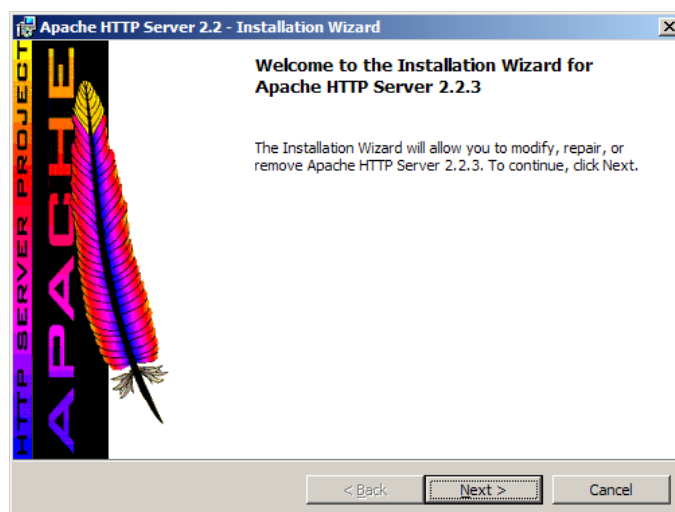
Click **Remove** again:



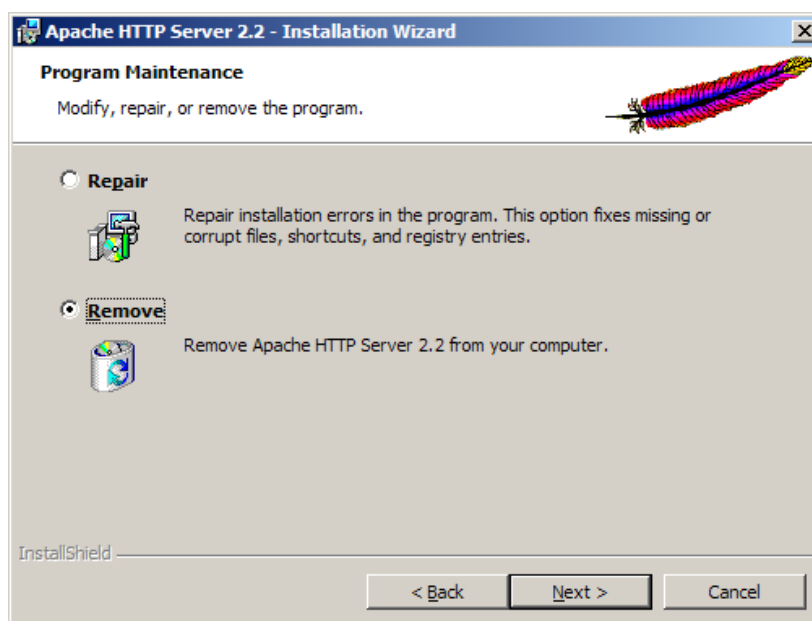
Click **Finish**:



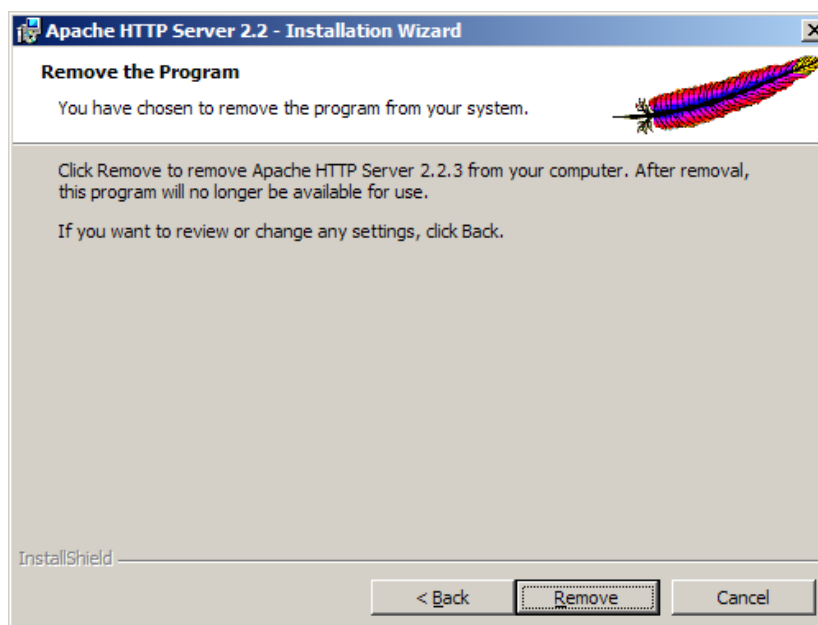

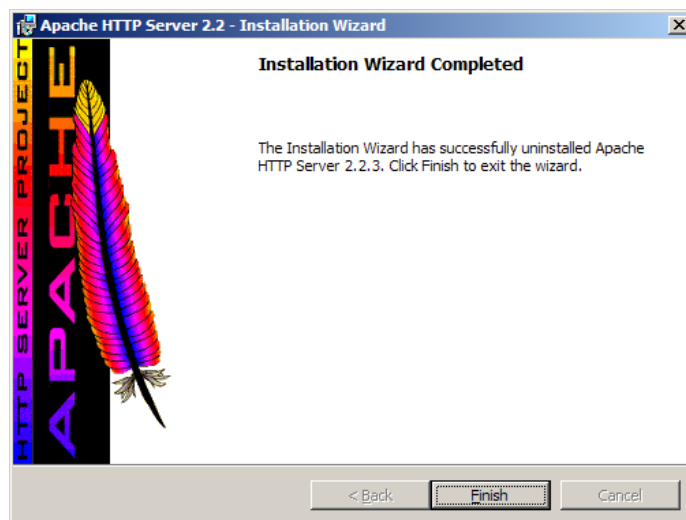
At this window, select the **Remove** option and click **Next**:



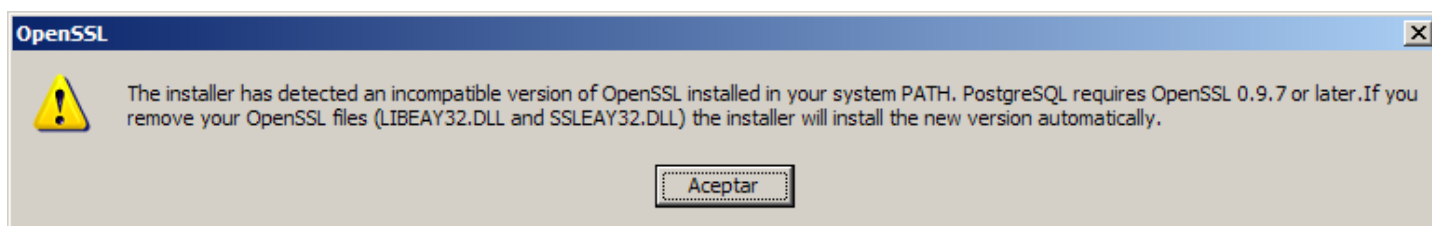
Click **Next** again:



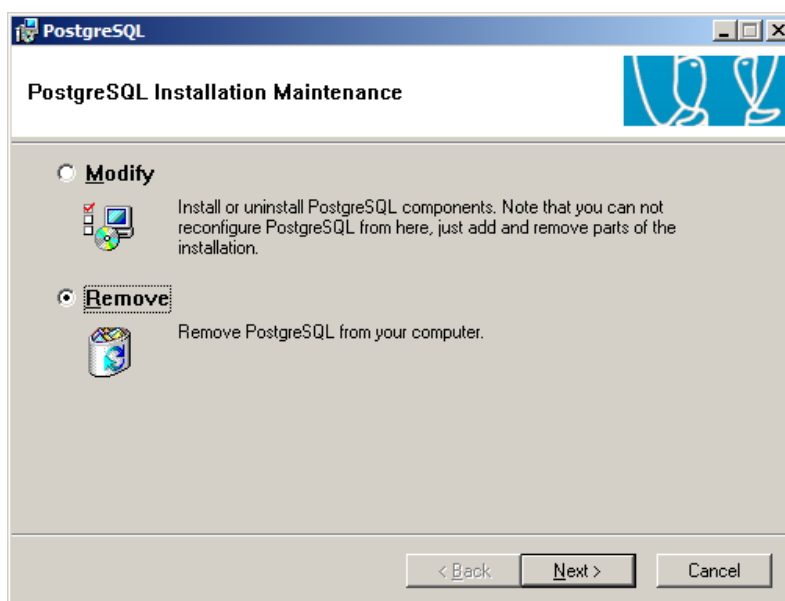

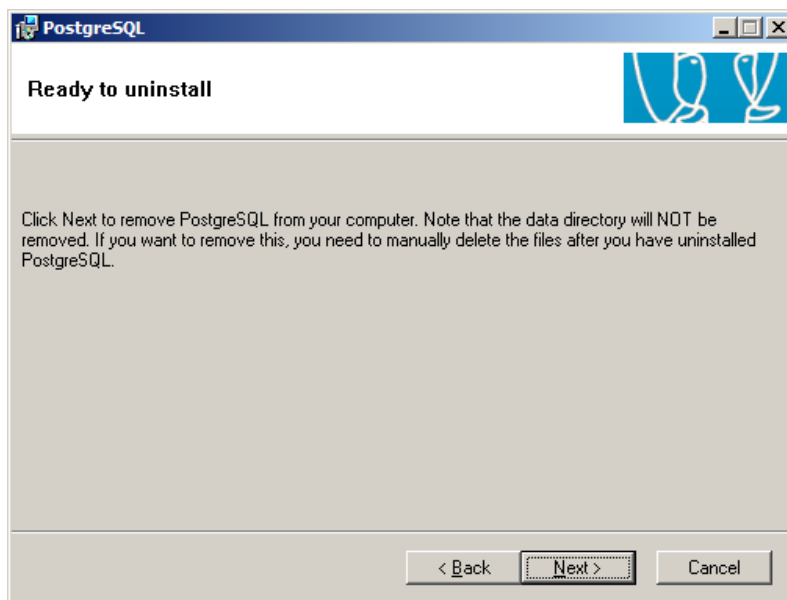
If the following message appears, click **Accept**.



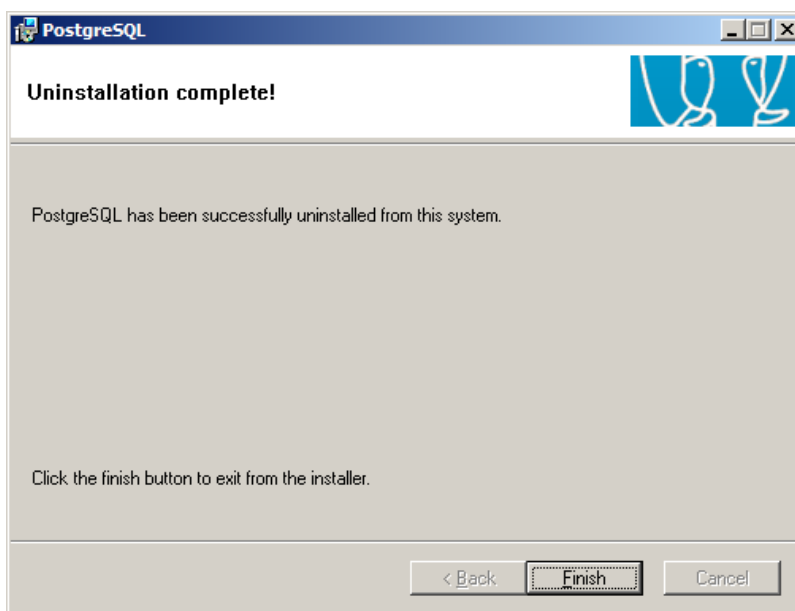
At this window, select **Remove** and click **Next**.



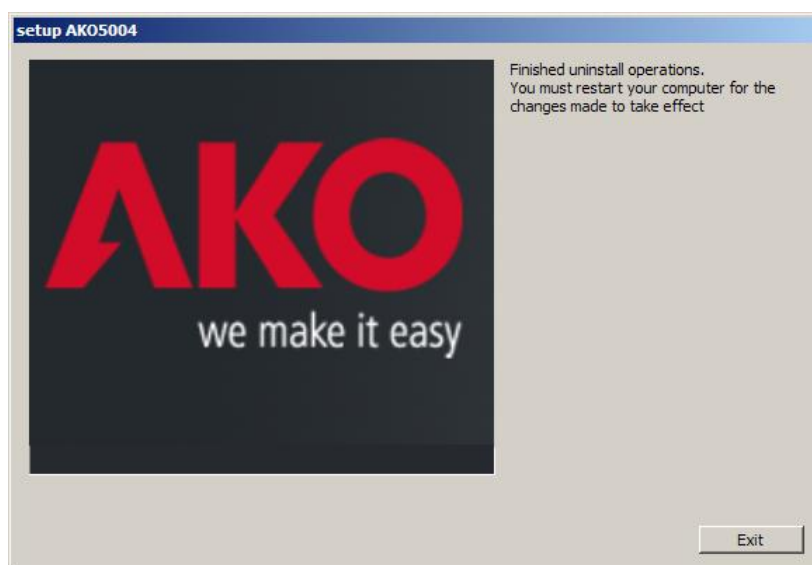
Click **Next** again:

The application will then tell you that the uninstall has finished. Click **Exit**.



ATTENTION, you will need to restart your computer for the uninstall to work properly.

Manual Uninstall

If you have problems with the uninstaller or have a version of the AKO 5004 software that does not contain this function, the correct way to manually uninstall the product is as follows:

1. **Stop and Close the AKO5004 server.** Right click on the  icon and select the **Stop** option. When the icon has turned red, right click and select the **Exit** option.
2. **Stop and Close the Apache HTTP Server.** To do this, open the **Apache Monitor** window (right click on the  icon and select **Open Apache Monitor**). Select the Apache2 service and click the **Stop** button. When the status icon of the service turns red, click the **Exit** button.
3. **Uninstall Apache HTTP Server 2.2.3.** To uninstall this product, use Add or Remove Programs in Windows.
4. **Uninstall Java(TM) SE Runtime Environment 6.** To uninstall this product, use Add or Remove Programs in Windows.
5. **Uninstall PHP 5.2.0.** To uninstall this product, use Add or Remove Programmes in Windows.
6. **Uninstall PostgreSQL 8.1.** To uninstall this product, use Add or Remove Programmes in Windows.
7. **Delete the AKO5004 installation folder** (by default, AKO5004 is installed in C:\Program Files\AKO5004\)

When these 7 steps have been completed, you must restart your computer for the changes to take effect.
