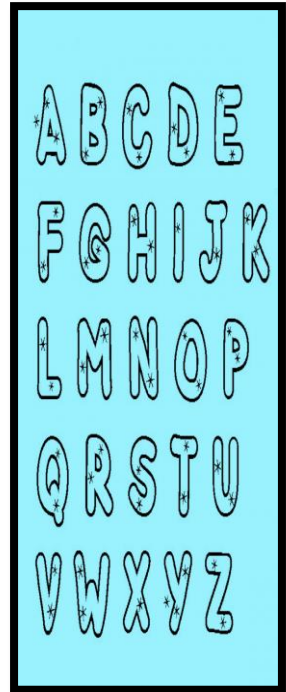

Wagging their tails behind them.

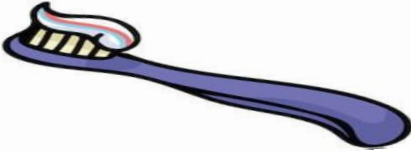
4. AFTER A BATH

Two wet legs and a shiny nose.



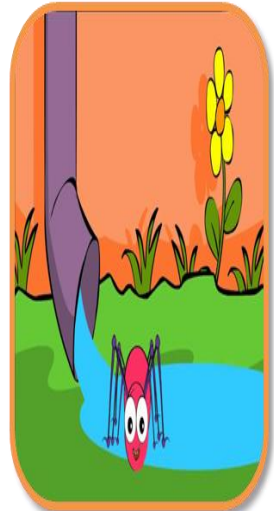
5. I HAVE A TOOTH BRUSH

She led the others with a quack, quack, quack**



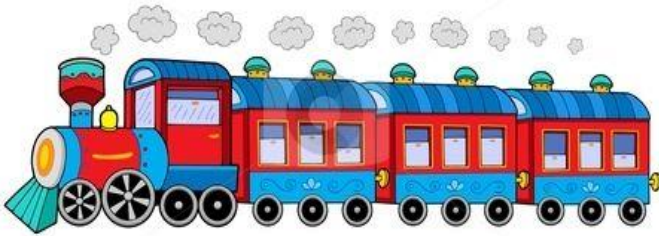
8. RAINBOW RAINBOW

What fun it is to be just me!

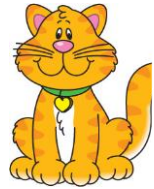


14. WHAT THE ANIMALS SAY ?
