#### Cabrillo Marine Aquarium 🔵

Largest collection of Southern California marine life on display in the world, outdoor tide pool touch tank. And here you'll learn about the natural history of San Pedro Bay from prehistoric times to present.

#### Cabrillo Beach 👴

On the north is a calm, sandy shoreline; south is Hurricane Gulch, the open Pacific Ocean waters. And it's home to the historic 1932 Bathhouse that was used during the 1932 Olympic Games in Los Angeles and where you'll find lots of history about the area.



#### SS Lane Victory 🔸

A real World War II era steamship that still operates and which served through the Vietnam War. In the ship's museums, which are located in the former cargo holds, you'll learn about the heroic story of the Merchant Marine, whose members suffered the greatest rate of casualties during World War II.

#### LA's Official Tall Ships •

The Exy Johnson and the Irving Johnson are the only twin brigantines in the world. And they were built right along the San Pedro Waterfront. You can sail on these ships or visit them at the dock.

#### Banning Museum 🔸

Built in 1865 in the midst of the Civil War by the father of Los Angeles Harbor and today carefully preserved and restored. The museum gives a real feel for life during all the eras the mansion was occupied by the Banning family.

#### Drum Barracks 🗧 🗨

It served as Western outpost of the Union Army during the Civil War and helped ensure the Confederates couldn't get a foothold in California. Historic artifacts on display. Guided tours available.

#### Ft. MacArthur Museum

Tracing the history of Ft. MacArthur from pre-World War I through the Cold War. Built in the palisades above Pt. Fermin and includes a range of information about the Los Angeles home front during WWII.

#### Muller House Museum 😐 🔶

A one-time home of a shipbuilder built in 1899. And it's now in its third loca-

tion, having been moved twice before. Now operated by the San Pedro Bay Historical Society. Open the first and second Sunday afternoons between 1 and 4 p.m. Last tour begins at 3:30 p.m. Masks and sign-in are required.

#### Los Angeles Maritime Museum ••

In the former ferry building with history of the harbor. Note: The Maritime Museum is currently closed for construction of a town square in front of the facility. A virtual visit is available on its website.

#### Pt. Fermin Lighthouse 😐 😐

It's an 1874 Victorian stick style structure that's been restored to show how lighthouse keepers lived during its history. until its light was turned off in 1941. Located in Pt. Fermin Park at the foot of Gaffey Street, Do climb over any walls in the area. Sunken City is adjacent. Do not climb over or around fences in this area.



## Your Guide to Getting Around

Find your way around San Pedro-and all of LA.

There are lots of ways to get around.

The Historic Downtown is within walking distance of the San Pedro Waterfront or you can take the trolley on weekends.

The Downtown Trolley operates on weekends between the Cruise Terminal, 6th and 7th Streets, and Pacific Avenue, CRAFTED at the Port of Los Angeles, SS Lane Victory, and a stop at Battleship Iowa.

DASH buses operate on routes throughout the greater San Pedro area, south as far as 25th Street and west to Western Avenue.

Commuter Express line 142 has direct service to the Downtown Long Beach Transit Gallery where you can catch the A Line train that travels to downtown Los Angeles and connects to most rail lines that run throughout the greater Los Angeles area. Catch the 142 at Harbor Blvd. and Miner Street or at stops along 7th Street and Gaffey Street north of 7th Street.

Metro Transit buses operate several lines into, out of, and around San Pedro, mainly along 7th Street, Pacific Avenue, and Gaffey Street (although other streets are also served).

Connections to Metrorail are available from Downtown Los Angeles's Metro Center and some buses stop at rail stations along their routes.

The Palos Verdes Transit Authority pro-

vides bus services around the Palos Verdes Peninsula, to San Pedro, and as far north and west as Redondo Beach
