















Calendar Pieces Back To School Theme AB Pattern

Because this All About Me Theme is typically run at the beginning of the school year, the months of August and September are printed on the next page!






## **Playdough Recipe**


4 c (1000 mg) flour 2 Tbsp. (30 ml) oil food coloring 1 ½ c (375 mg) salt 1 c (250 ml) water


- 1. Add food coloring to water.
- 2. Add oil.
- 3. In separate bowl, mix flour and salt.
- 4. Add to wet ingredients. Mix, knead and play!


# Letter Cards for: Playdough Alphabet Activity Mats and for Literacy in the Library Activity


- 1. Print the following letter pages.

- 6. Print 2 copies of each and laminate for the children to use as a matching game!




































### **Potato Head Game**



# Potato Head Picture Die:

- 1. Print out this picture die onto sturdy tag board.
- 2. Fold into a cube.
- 3. Glue the tabs in place.
- 4. I also use clear, packing tape to cover the entire cube.
- 5. The children then take turns rolling the die.
- 6. They put on the piece of the potato head that lands up right!
