COOKING CORNER



Filled Cookies

1 cup sugar
½ cup shortening
½ cup sour milk
2 ½ cups flour
1 egg
Pinch salt
1 tsp baking powder
¼ tsp soda
1 tsp vanilla

Filling:

1 cup raisins
½ cup sugar
½ cup nutmeats
½ cup water
Salt
1 T flour

Boil filling until smooth. Roll dough into cookies. Put a spoonful of filling on each cookie, put another cookie on top, pinch edges together and bake.

Jello Cottage Cheese and Pineapple Salad

1 small box small curd cottage cheese
1 can crushed pineapple (Very well drained)
1 box Cool Whip
1 box (small) strawberry Jello (dry)

Mix cottage cheese and pineapple together real well. Mix in dry Jello. Then fold in cool whip. Chill.

Stuffing & Zucchini Casserole

3 lg. zucchini, cut in cubes, unpeeled
1 carrot, grated
1 onion, cut fine
1 can cream of chicken soup
8 oz. sour cream
2 c. (16 oz.) Pepperidge Farm stuffing
1 stick margarine, melted

Mix stuffing with melted margarine. Add 1/2 to first 5 ingredients, sprinkle 1/2 on top of

casserole. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes

Heavenly Salad

1 cup marshmallows
½ cup blanched almonds
1 cup pineapple
½ cup mayonnaise

Mix and let stand several hours on ice. When ready to serve fold in 1 cup of whipped cream.

Potato Chip Cake

1 pound butter, melted
1 cup sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
3 cups flour
2 cups crushed potato chips
1 cup chopped walnuts

Mix all ingredients until well blended. Grease and flour 9x13 inch pan, put cake mixture in pan. Chill 1 hour and bake in 350 degree oven for about 30 to 45 minutes.

Potato Stuffed Hot Dogs

8 frankfurters
2 cups seasoned mashed potatoes
1/2 cup grated American cheese

Slit frankfurters lengthwise almost through, spread open and place cut side up on a greased baking sheet. Place 1/4 cup potatoes in each frankfurter; sprinkle with cheese. Bake in a 400 degree oven for 10 to 15 minutes.

4 servings.

Fruit Salad

1 c. sour cream
1 c. flaked coconut
1 c. Thompson seedless grapes
1 c. banana slices
1 c. miniature marshmallows
1 c. mandarin orange segments
1 c. pineapple chunks
Mix all ingredients together.

Refrigerate overnight. Stir again before serving. Makes 6 servings

Strawberry Salad

2 (3 ounce) pkg. strawberry Jello
2 cups boiling water
2 package frozen strawberries with juice

8 ounce cream cheese
1 cup sugar
8 ounce Cool Whip
1 1/2 cup crushed pretzels
1/2 cup melted butter
2 tablespoons sugar

Dissolve Jello in boiling water and add strawberries. Pour into an oiled pan or mold. Let it set for 1 1/2 hours. Then mix the cream cheese, sugar and Cool Whip together and spread it over the Jello. Finally mix the butter, pretzels and sugar and pat down on top of the cream cheese mixture.

Apple Jello Snack

Medium Apple
Sugar-Free Jello
Take apple, cut into chunks, mix in 2 tablespoons of your favorite jello

7-Up Jello Salad

1 pkg. lemon Jello
1 cup hot water
1 (8 ounce) cream cheese
1 small can pineapple, crushed
1 (12 ounce) can 7-Up
Dissolve Jello in hot water. Slowly add Jello to cream cheese. Stir until smooth. Add pineapple and 7-Up. Chill.

Historical – Cottage Cheese-Watercress Spread

Mix 1 cup finely chopped watercress (about 1 bunch) with 1 cup cottage cheese and 1 teaspoon grated onion. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Makes about 1 ½ cups spread.

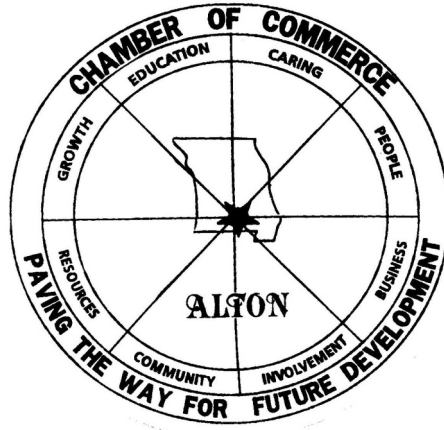
