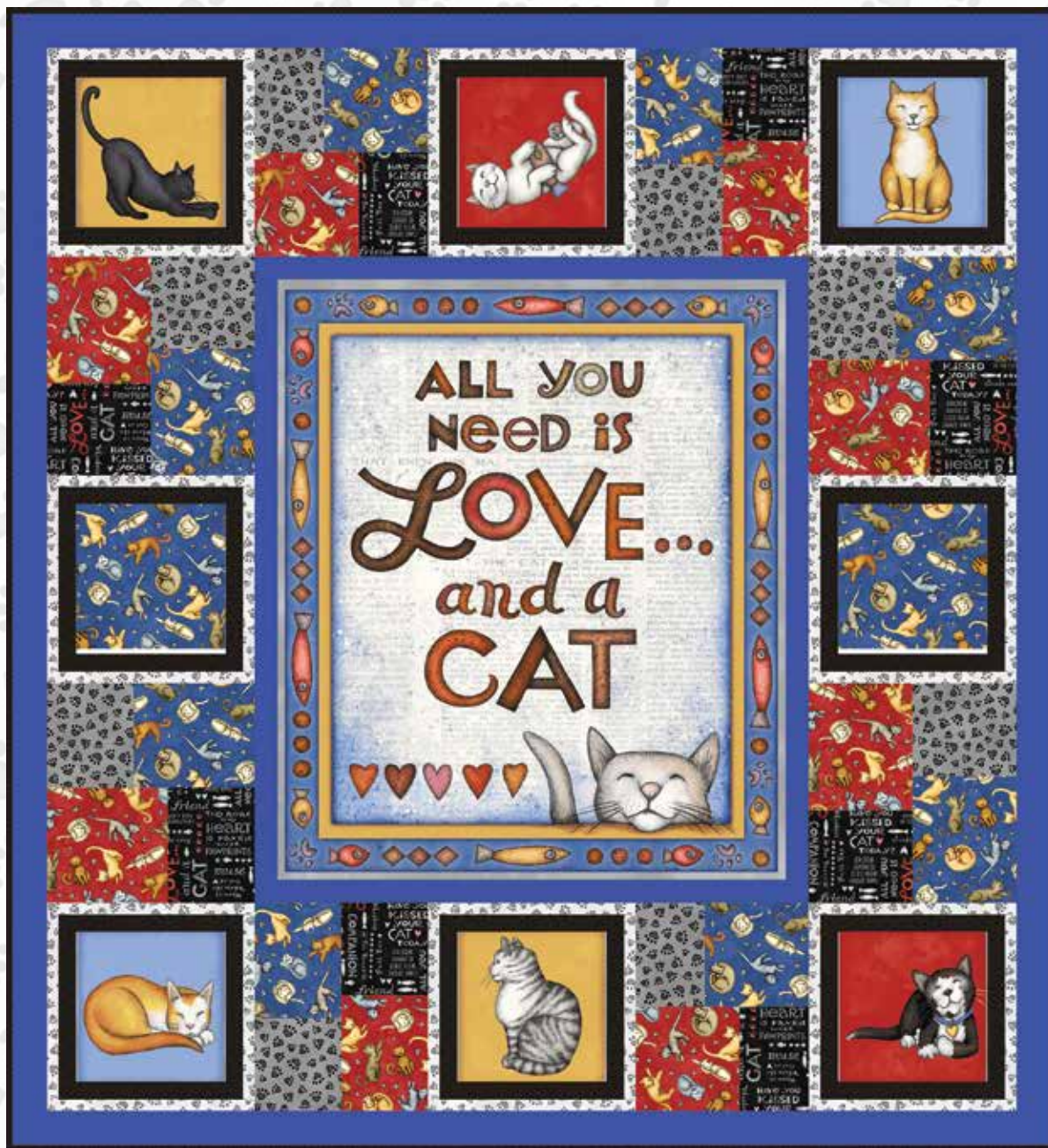

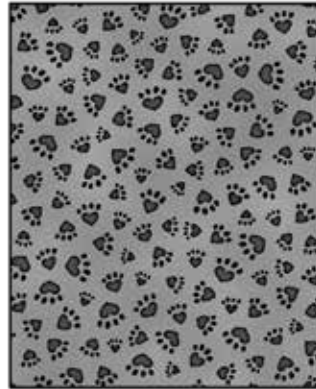

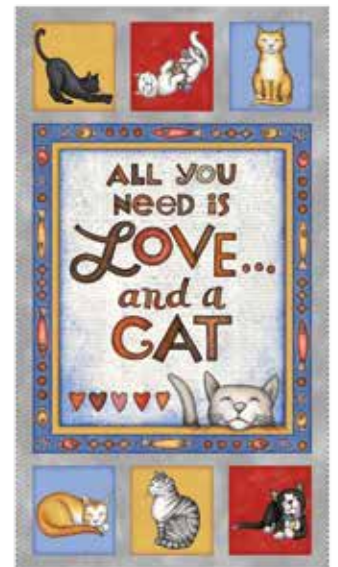

Materials

1 panel	24 inch Cat Panel - Multi (A)	9909P-97
2/3 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Royal (B)	1063-75
7/8 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (C)	1063-99*
1/3 yard	Paw Prints - Light Gray (D)	9904-9
1/3 yard	Paw Prints - Dark Gray (E)	9904-90
1/2 yard	Tossed Cats - Royal Blue (F)	9905-77
1/3 yard	Tossed Cats - Red (G)	9905-88
1/3 yard	Words - Black (H)	9907-99
3 yards	Tossed Cats - Royal Blue (Backing)	9905-77

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 inch Cat Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 22 1/2" x 26 1/2" rectangle, centered on the large block.
- (6) 7" squares, each centered on a small block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Royal (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 46 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 1/2" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 7" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Paw Prints - Light Gray (D), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 9 1/2" strips.

From the Paw Prints - Dark Gray (E), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" x 4 1/2" strips, (2) 5" x 4 1/4" strips, (2) 5" x 3 1/2" strips and (2) 4 1/4" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Cats - Royal Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" squares, (2) 5" x 5 3/4" strips and (2) 5" squares.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" x 6" strips and (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Cats - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" x 6" strips and (2) 5" squares
- (1) 5 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 3/4" x 5 1/2" strips and (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Words - Black (H), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" x 4 1/2" strips and (2) 5" x 3 1/2" strips.
- (1) 4 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips and (2) 4 1/4" x 4 1/2" strips.

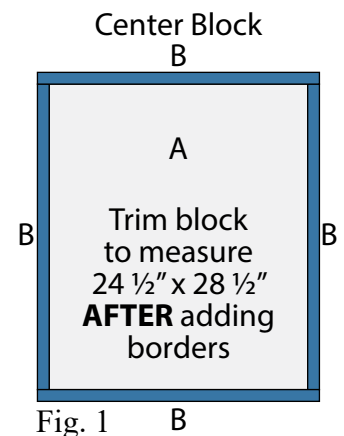
From the Tossed Cats - Royal Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 53" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53" x 57" back.

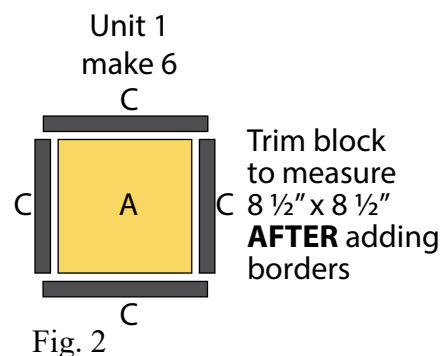
Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric A large block. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A large block to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 28 1/2"**.



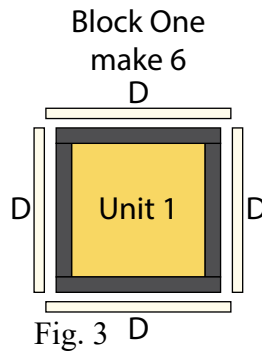
2. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric A small block. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small block. Trim the block to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.



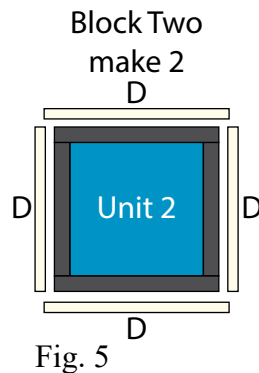
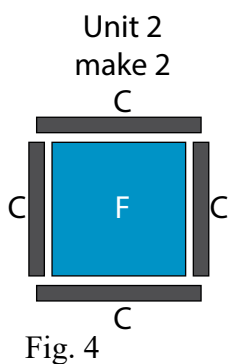

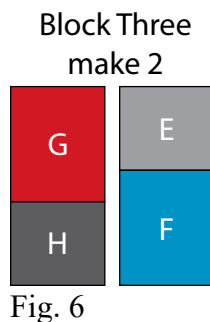
3. Sew (1) 1" x 8 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 9 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



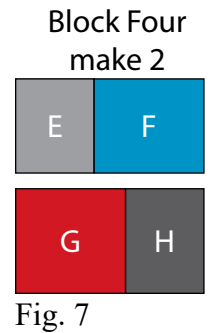
4. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 7" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.



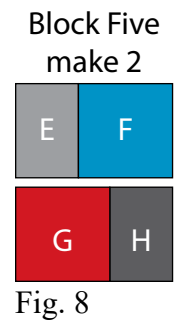
6. Sew (1) 5" x 6" Fabric G strip to the top of (1) 5" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to make the left column. Sew (1) 5" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 5" x 6" Fabric F strip to make the right column. Sew together the (2) columns lengthwise to make (1) 9 1/2" x 10" Block Three rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.



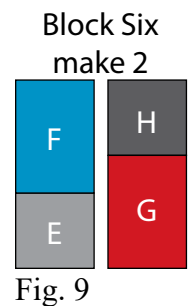
7. Sew (1) 4 1/4" x 5" Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) 5 3/4" x 5" Fabric F strip to make the top row. Sew (1) 5 3/4" x 5 1/2" strip to the left side of (1) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Fabric H strip to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 9 1/2" x 10" Block Four rectangle (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.



8. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 5" Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) 5" Fabric F square to make the top row. Sew (1) 5" Fabric G square to the left side of (1) 3 1/2" x 5" Fabric H strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 8" x 9 1/2" Block Five rectangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Block Five rectangle.



9. Sew (1) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top of (1) 4 1/4" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip to make the left column. Sew (1) 4 1/4" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top of (1) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Fabric G strip to make the right column. Sew the (2) columns together lengthwise to make (1) 8" x 9 1/2" Block Six rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Block Six rectangle.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew together (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from top to bottom. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of the Center Block.

11. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three rectangle, in that order from top to bottom. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Center Block.

12. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six rectangle and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Center Block.

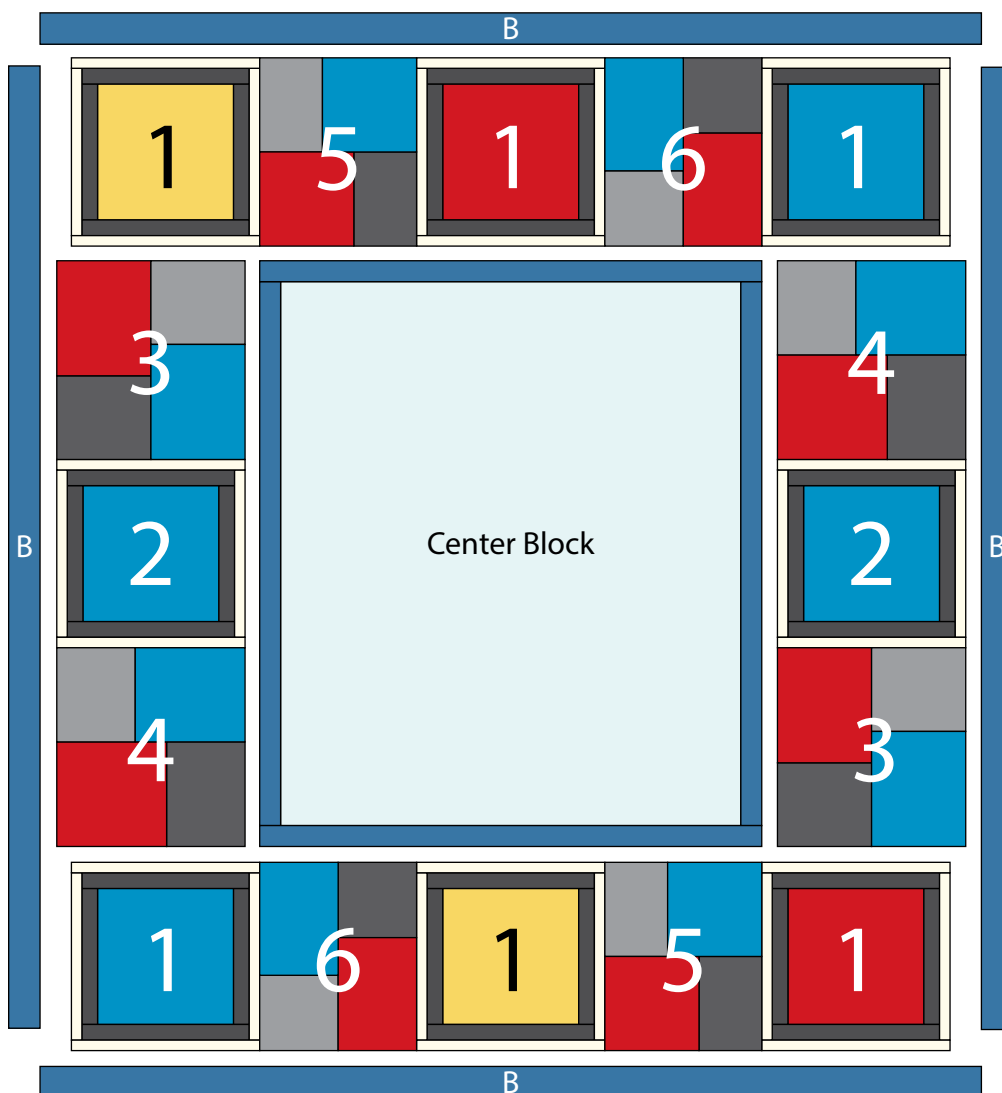
13. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five rectangle and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 2" x 46 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 45 1/2" Fabric B strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
