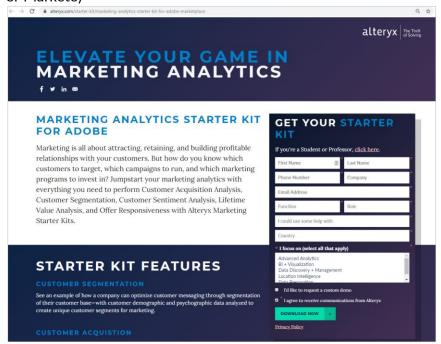

2. Complete the Get Your Starter Kit form and click Download Now.



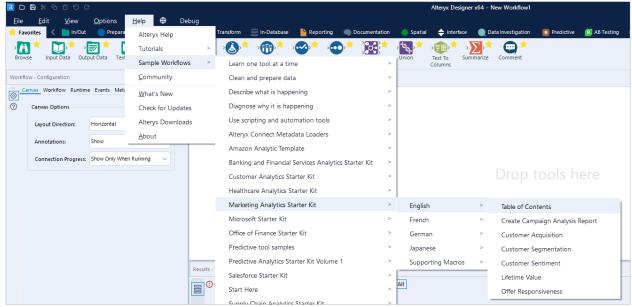
3. Open the downloaded Marketing\_NonAdmin\_x64.exe file.



4. Follow the prompts to install Alteryx Designer and the Marketing Analytics Starter Kit.



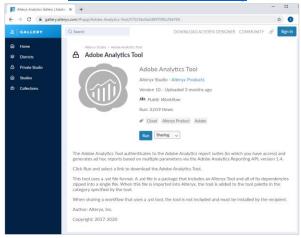

## Adobe Analytics tool for Alteryx Designer (Optional)

The Adobe Analytics tool authenticates to the Adobe Analytics report suites (to which you have access) and generates ad hoc reports based on multiple parameters via the Adobe Analytics Reporting API.

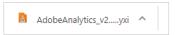
1. Go to the Adobe Analytics Tool listing on the Alteryx Gallery.

4. Open the downloaded yxi file.



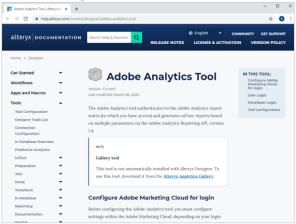
5. Click Install.



6. Adobe Analytics will show up in the tool palette within the Connectors category.



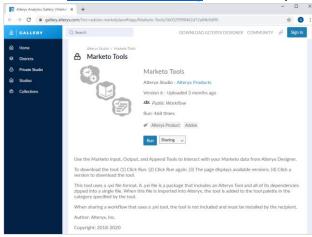

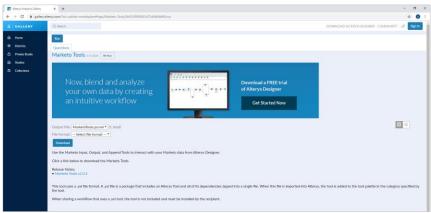
## Marketo tools for Alteryx Designer (Optional)

The Marketo tools (i.e., Append, Input, and Output) provide access to your Marketo instance from within Alteryx. Using the Marketo APIs, you are able to read Marketo records, create and update leads, and append information to existing Marketo data.

1. Go to the Marketo Tools listing on the Alteryx Gallery.



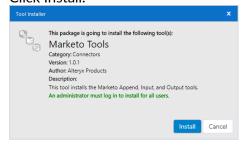
- 2. Click Run twice.

4. Open the downloaded yxi file.



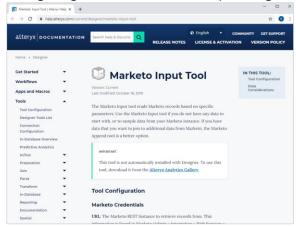
5. Click Install.
