- 1. Currently working in response service needed
- Has documented history of participation in successful salvage and/or marine firefighting operations, including equipment deployment
- Owns or has contracts for equipment needed to perform response services
- Has personnel with documented training certification and degree experience
- Has 24-hour availability of personnel and equipment and history of response times compatible with the regulation









- 6. Has on-going continuous training program
- Has successful record of participation in drills and exercises
- Has salvage and marine firefighting plans used and approved during real incidents
- Has membership in relevant national and/or international organizations
- Has insurance that covers the salvage and/or marine firefighting services which they intend to provide









- 11. Has sufficient up front capital to support an operation
- 12. Has equipment and experience to work in the specific regional geographic environments where the vessel operates
- 13. Has the logistical and transportation support capability required to sustain operations
- 14. Has the capability to implement the necessary engineering, administrative and personal protective equipment controls to safeguard the health and safety of their workers
- 15. Has familiarity with the salvage and marine firefighting protocol contained in the local RRP.

























































#### Oil Pollution Safeguard:


#### Caribbean Wreck Problem




- At least 300 known large shipwrecks in the Caribbean present risk to natural and economic resources.
- These wrecks may contain 10– 30 times as much oil as spilled from Exxon Valdez, as well as other hazards – chemicals and munitions.
- Potentially-leaking wrecks threaten ecological resources, fisheries, and the US\$53–74 billion tourism economy.

## CRISK Based on US RULET Project






