Elevated Work Platforms and Scaffolding

Injuries and fatalities involving scaffolds, ladders, and elevated work platforms are a significant percentage of all construction-related accidents. 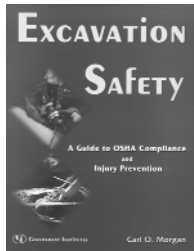

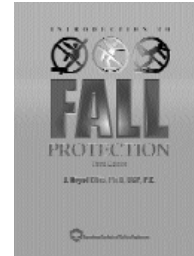
