President's Message

I still enjoy the AKC Gazette for the perspectives found in the breed columns. In one recent issue, twelve breed columns were about sportsmanship and ethics. I think we are slowly losing that in this sport and based on the amount being written from other breeds – it appears I'm not alone in this assessment. So, I thought I would just muse on a few of the nuggets I thought worth sharing from the recent issue.

From the Golden Retriever column a lament on poor sportsmanship of winners and losers and the observation that in today's world, where animal rights extremists want to take away our right to breed dogs or even have a pet, we need to stick together or our sport will be gone before we know it. I wonder what this sport will look like 50 years from now – or even 25 years from now. And the writer suggested – angry because your dog lost? Get over it. There are more important things at stake, like friendship, and the right to exhibit, own and breed your dogs. The joy of winning is fleeting....take time to invest more in the breed by volunteering, mentoring or bringing young people into this sport.

The Spinone Italiano column spoke to kennel blindness. It's an interesting disease...I'm sure you would agree generally applied to everyone but 'thee and me'. To paraphrase the writer, breeding incorrect dogs to incorrect dogs is not likely to produce correct. And while painfully obvious to anyone, the writer suggests that for the kennel blind – there is no incentive for them to keep learning and striving to improve their breeding when they think they are already doing everything

right. The kennel blind will not improve the breed until they can cure their disease and become able to see what others see. Words to think about...whatever the breed.

With a shrinking gene pool – we can't afford to be kennel blind – but truthful and honest with ourselves and others. It's not always easy – but it's so very necessary. We also have some great learning sessions at the National – I don't think members take advantage of them as they should. We learn sometimes in unintended ways...as a club we should be a source for that learning from within the membership and to each other. But, we need to take time...and listen.

And finally – a long article about ethics in the Rottweiler column. The writer recycled a 32-year old Gazette column on ethics – reinforcing perhaps that questions of ethics have always existed, just more in view these days in this age of the internet, social media, blogs and twitter. Thirty-two years ago, the writer spoke not only of ethics in regard to breeding but also in regard to our own qualities as owners and breeders and how we conduct ourselves in a moral sense. As suggested – having a code of

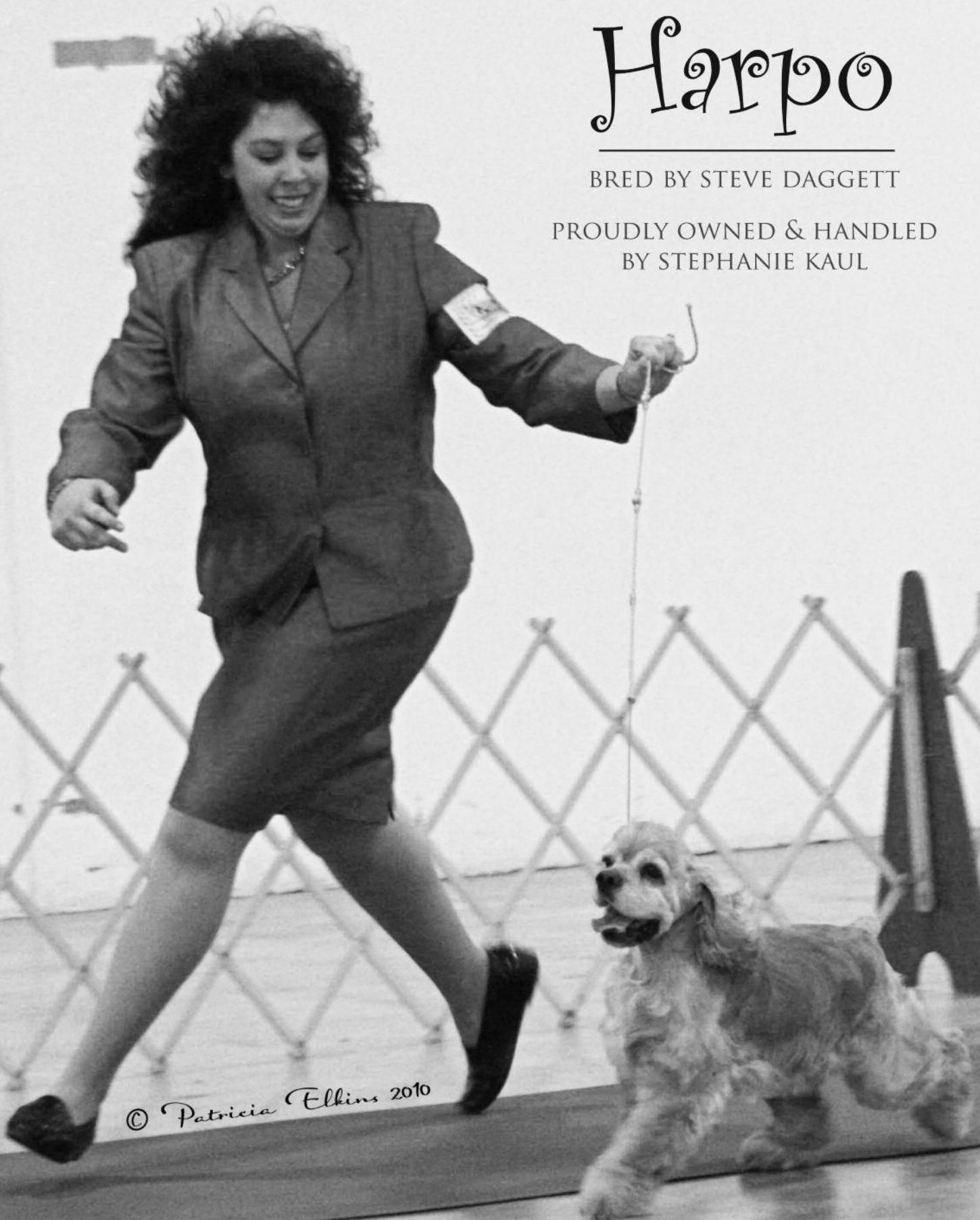

Rescue Rambling

This month we have two stories about cockers finding forever homes.

The first from Nancy Gallant:

We got two dogs in rescue from a man who had cancer. He was not able to take care of them but they were his babies and he had had them since they were 8 weeks and now they were six. They were sisters. He told us he would get better and someday he would come back and get them. Every couple of weeks we would get a letter from him to his girls telling them how he missed them and how sad he was that he had to give them up.

Time went by, and every time someone called for rescue I told them that we had these two girls. They had to be placed together because one was blind and depended on the other as her "seeing eye" dog. I would tell them the story and they would say, "Oh that is so sad but what else do you have?" One day a person came to look at rescue dogs and fell in love with the two girls. That night he brought back his family, a wife and a daughter and the daughter said to her dad, "which dog is it daddy that you said needs special love?"

They took both the girls and the letters and said when the girls died, they would bury the letters with them. The next day, a friend of the man's called us and said he had died two days before. We always felt that he did his work in heaven and sent that wonderful family to us to take care of his dogs.

Ch ***'s Audrey's Aussie Girl**

In April, 2010, I received an email from a member of the Greater Ft. Myers Dog Club advising that the wife of one of their club members had recently passed away, leaving him with her three beloved cocker spaniels that he could not properly care for. Arrangements were made for the girls to "get into rescue" while attempts to return them to their breeders/prior owners were made. This is the saga of the oldest of the trio, who also was the last to find a new home.

Her name is Aussie, formally known as CH *****'s Audrey's Aussie Girl, whelped 5/12/98. I contacted Aussie's breeder as soon as she was identified. While initially agreeing to accept Aussie back, the concern of caring for a geriatric dog led to her changing her mind. So, on May 1st Aussie came to me for foster care while awaiting a new home.

Again, a solution and plans were made for Aussie to go to her forever home in Alaska. Fate once again intervened and the airline refused to accept her. Back to Melbourne Aussie and I

drove. A couple of months later, thought I had found a home with my neighbor and her daughter, who loved Aussie from first sight and frequently came over to get her to spend afternoons. Before making the permanent commitment, the elderly grandmother took ill and all agreed it was not in Aussie's best interests to go through with an adoption.

In the meantime, Aussie had totally gained my heart and was quite at home with me and my 3 girls. A trip with me to ASC National in Richmond, VA., where Aussie strutted through the 2010 Rescue Parade with dear friend Fulvia Bartoli. In my eyes, she was winning Best in Show! I would not have been prouder had she been a bitch I'd personally bred and delivered 12 years ago.

Aussie's needs were simple... her big "flaw" being that she is a trash diving diva! She can get ANYTHING out of the trash can, even with a lid on it and particularly if it is edible. Aussie's other love is food. About an hour before dinner time, Aussie would start telling me that it's time to eat. She'd be the first at the cookie jar in the morning and last to leave it at night. She always picked one or two "baby-sized" toys that she'd tuck up under her just like it was her real baby (she was never bred). One of my favorite moments is bedtime when Aussie would curl up on her bed next to mine and give me that good-night kiss (she has the sweetest little butterfly kisses).

It's looking like all roads lead to Aussie living her life here with me in Florida, right?

Well, fate intervened again for our Aussie girl. This time a surprise! Planning a trip to Atlanta, I contacted some puppy buyers to arrange a reunion to see how "the kids" are growing. I mentioned Aussie to one couple, who immediately emailed me saying "It sounds like it is meant to be. We lost Rocky to a stroke in May. We looked around at a couple of the rescue groups but nothing worked out. Now I know why, we were waiting for Aussie."

So Aussie is now with this wonderful couple in Atlanta, where she is the much-loved matriarch of her final home. In Chris's words, "She is so beautiful. Thanks for sharing the photos. She is such a sweet girl and has been giving Larry lots of kisses. She found the dog doors very quickly and has taken a few runs around the back yard. Lucy is resting and has put herself to bed already and Bandit is beside himself with happiness at his new friend."

I know that her beloved mistress, Audrey Pfeiffer, has watched over and guided Aussie to her final home in Atlanta. She certainly has enriched my life and will forever be loved.

The Dedham Tradition

Hugh Robertson, a fifth generation potter, opened the Dedham Pottery Company in 1896 in Dedham, Massachusetts during the American arts and crafts movement. The Company was a working pottery until 1943. During that time the pottery's artisans created over fifty designs for their dinnerware and serving pieces. The most popular design was the enduring little bunny now known as the "Dedham Rabbit". This rabbit became the identifying signature of Dedham Pottery and remains so today. Through the years the "Dedham Rabbit" has won an international following. Pieces of original Dedham Pottery are highly prized by collectors, from individuals to prestigious institutions such as the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, Massachusetts and the Smithsonian Institution, in Washington DC. In 1973, The Potting Shed owned by Chotsie Starr began making her own line of reproductions of the Dedham Pottery. These reproductions have met with high praise and are currently available at places like the Museum Shop at the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston and the Potting Shed located in Acton, Massachusetts.

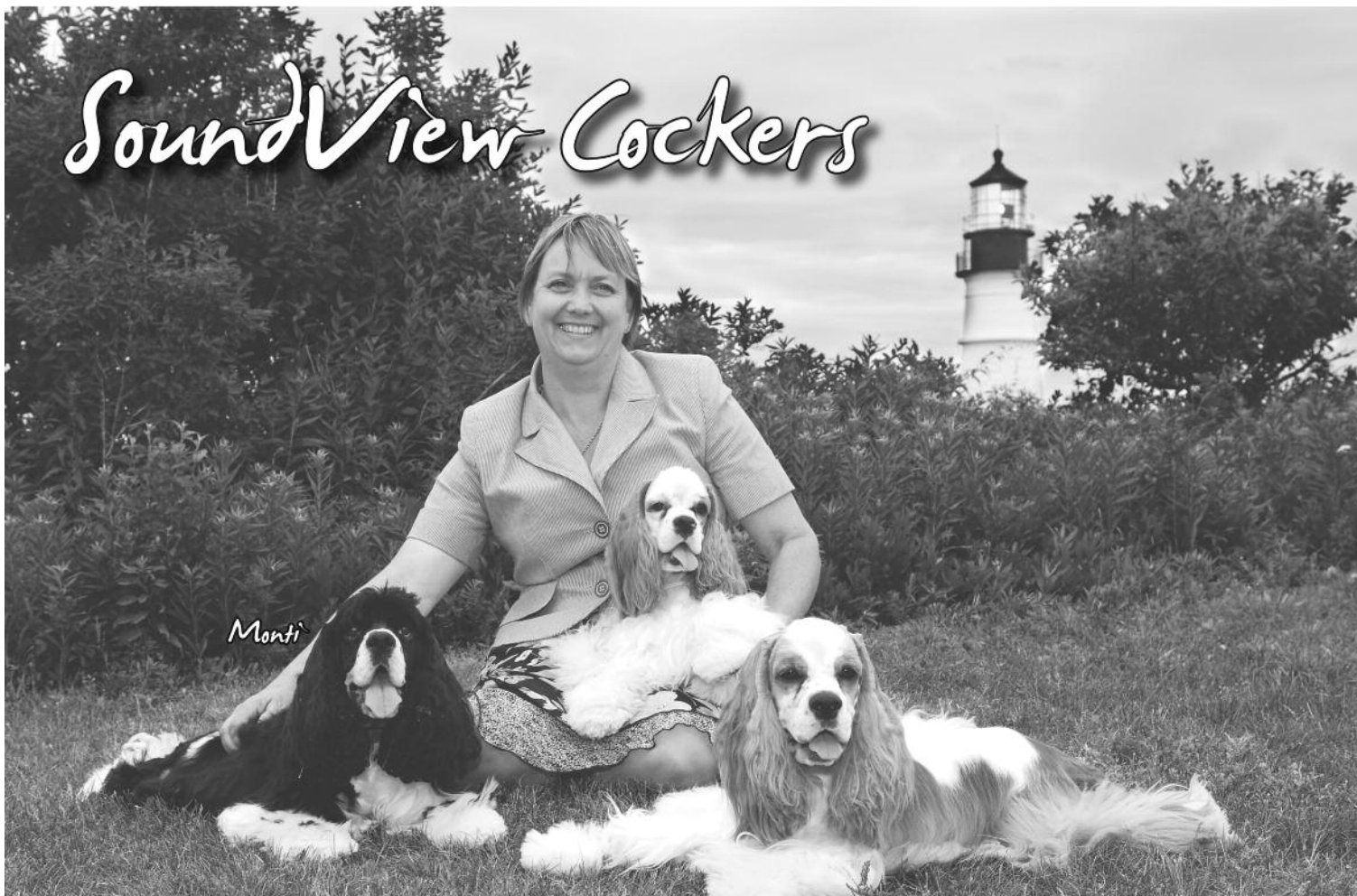

Featuring the Stud Dog

A popular male that stands at stud can have a significant impact on the breed due to the tremendous number of bitches that it is possible for him to breed. A stud dog must therefore be sound physically and mentally and, of course, be of excellent example of the breed type and great health without compromise". The future may very well depend on what he produces — if that stud is very popular he will have many offspring which will carry on his traits. In breeding, rule # 1 - Do no Harm to the breed!

Researching Stud Dogs. If you cannot visit the prospective stud in person contact the stud dog's owners and ask for a video of him in a natural setting. You want to see him running around and from every angle. Photographs are second best, they can be very deceptive. Do your homework well in advance of the breeding. It may take months to gather all of the information you will need. Inform the stud owner about when you will need the stud. Do not wait until the bitch is in heat to contact potential stud owners. They don't like last minute breedings either and they will need time to receive information from you about your bitch.

Open, honest discussion is very important. Talk to each stud dog's owner about your bitch, her strengths and weaknesses. Ask the owner to tell you about the stud's strengths and weaknesses. Determine if he would be a good candidate for your bitch. Discuss both the bitch's and the stud's temperaments, habits, attitudes, etc. Determine what traits the stud puts on his offspring. Is he dominant in any particular traits such as head, jaw, angulation, bite, etc. Ask if the stud owner has kept any pups from the stud. If not, why not?

Determine Health and Soundness. Ask for copies of any tests that have been done. OFA certification for hips and/or elbows; his CERF EXAM sheet as proof of having normal eyes. Also, request a copy of other tests if available or done. Any tests done will help in your choice of who to pick as a stud. Brucellosis is a serious venereal disease that causes abortions, still births and sterility, among other problems. It is also transmissible to humans and other mammals. NOTE: It benefits a stud dog owner now and in the future to have a stud cleared of potential genetic defects. They can make

wiser breeding decisions when armed with more knowledge.

Temperament. A stud dog should be able to be in close contact with people and other dogs without hurting anyone or getting nervous or scared. If you can't meet the stud in person, ask people that know him or have bred bitches to him what they think. A perfectly wonderful stud may not have any titles for a variety of reasons. Firsthand experience, and talking to others, is the best way to determine the temperament of any stud.

Relatives. Try to see as many relatives, especially offspring, of each potential stud as you can. Ask the stud owner for a list of owners of bitches that have had pups sired by the stud dog. Talk to the bitches owners and ask for their opinion of the offspring produced. Determine if he puts his good qualities on the offspring. Does he throw himself? Does he throw better than himself? Worse? If he produced well with one bitch and not with another, look at the pedigrees to see if the good one is comparable to yours. He may "click" with one bloodline and not another. Usually an experienced stud dog's owner will know which bloodlines go well with their stud. If no offspring are available, look at the stud's parents, grandparents, siblings and the siblings' offspring. Is the stud similar to his relatives, or is he unique? In general, traits that are similar across relatives are more likely to appear in his offspring than traits that are unique.

Pedigrees. Look at the pedigree of the bitch and all of the potential stud dogs. A pedigree is useful only if you know about the ancestors. What did they look like, were they sound, what did they produce, etc. A nice, tight line breeding is great if all of the dogs in the pedigree are exceptional, and you can have some assurance of getting those qualities that you most desire. An outcross may be what you need. Sometimes an outcross produces exactly what you want, sometimes not, just like a line breeding may not turn out as expected.

Strengths And Faults. Make a list of all the strengths and faults of the stud dog as you did for the bitch. Narrow the list down to the three worst faults and the three best features. Decide if you can tolerate the faults and if the strengths are

what your bitch needs. Make a list of all of the studs that have the single best attribute that corresponds with your bitch's worst fault. If your bitch has a poor head for example, but is correct in body, look for studs with outstanding heads whose offspring also have outstanding heads. Of course you must still look at the total stud. You wouldn't want to breed to a dog with an outstanding head that, for example, has a very poor/narrow chest and a poor top line. Use your judgment! Remember, a serious fault in your bitch will not be corrected by a stud that is overdone in that area. Typically, you will get pups with traits of each, not a blend. It is always best to breed to a male that is better than your bitch's faults, and is correct and balanced over all.

Working With Stud Dog Owners. Stud fees are as wide ranging as the stud dogs themselves. Discuss all expenses involved in breeding to a particular stud. If you are shipping semen, find out who pays for collecting and shipping of the semen. Usually the bitch owner pays all expenses involved, but some stud owners provide the semen under the general stud fee and others split the cost.

When is the stud fee due? How much of a deposit is required if any? When do you pay the balance? Can you send payments as soon as you know the bitch is pregnant? When will the litter application be signed? Most stud owners will not sign a litter registration application until the entire stud fee is collected. Be sure to have money put aside for this expense.

Sometimes the stud fee is paid with a puppy from the resulting litter, other times a straight fee. Ask if the stud owner wants pick of the litter or if they would accept second pick. Will the stud owner come and pick the pup personally,

have someone else do it, or will they want you to choose? If they are not picking the pup up personally, find out who pays to have the pup shipped.

What about the "what if's"? What if only one or two pups are born? What if the breeding doesn't take at all? The pups are absorbed, aborted, still born, etc? What if none or only a few live to eight weeks? Find out in advance what the stud owners policy is for every conceivable scenario. Most stud owners will offer a repeat breeding at no charge if there are no pups from the first attempt. Some will offer another breeding if only one or two pups are born. Find out what is the minimum considered to be a litter.

Get It In Writing. Get every little detail in writing. After deciding on a stud or studs and finding out the details, make sure the stud owner(s) put it in writing. If the contract is not acceptable, edit it and return it to the stud owner for correction or clarification. Be sure everything you discussed and all of the contingencies are in the contract. Remember, FAR more problems occur due to misunderstandings than outright dishonesty.

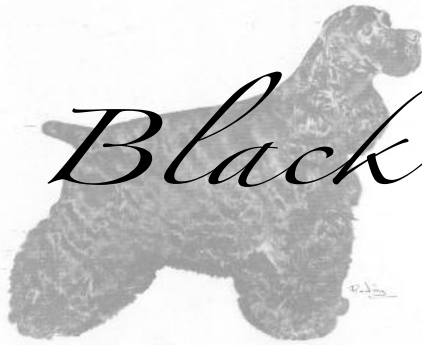

ethics for a club or breed does not automatically mean we will achieve those goals – but they serve as a guide and as a reminder to people.

I remember being chair of the committee that first crafted the current code of ethics for the ASC many years ago. Perhaps in my young (our younger) exuberance – I thought we could legislate a higher practice of ethics — a code that had meat and could be enforced. But, I later understood you can't legislate ethics – but the Code of Ethics is a guide and a principle to remind people of their responsibilities. And that is a worthy goal.

Speaking to ethics in breeding – the AKC has approved our request to add merle to the registration color choices with a Z registration. The Z would carry forward then on all offspring from that dog or bitch and this would enable us to identify and isolate those dogs from breeding. It is the opinion of the ASC Board this is an impure gene – that doubly carries severe health issues. There is no reason why any ethical breeder would want to promote this type of breeding in my personal view – although

I understand I have been called a zealot by some who do breed them. As I said above – you can't legislate ethics...but we can try and protect our breed and identify this gene and then wise and informed people will make wise choices we hope.

This will not be implemented until July 2011 as AKC needs to schedule the changes. But, this is great timing as in parallel – the ASC Foundation has reviewed and gathered together a very complete study of the genetics here and once shared with the membership this will go a long way to providing education for all along with the Z identification. Much, much more information coming your way in January...with time for the membership to review and discuss the material and ensure the membership is in alignment with the Board on this direction before we give the final implementation nod to AKC. I'm excited to see light at the end of the tunnel after so many years and so much effort and am sure you are too.

Until next time...a bit of wisdom from Sally Brown – sister to Charlie Brown of the Peanuts comics — "I think I've discovered the secret of life. You just hang around until you get used to it'.

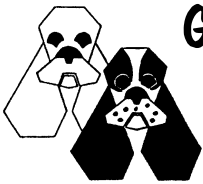

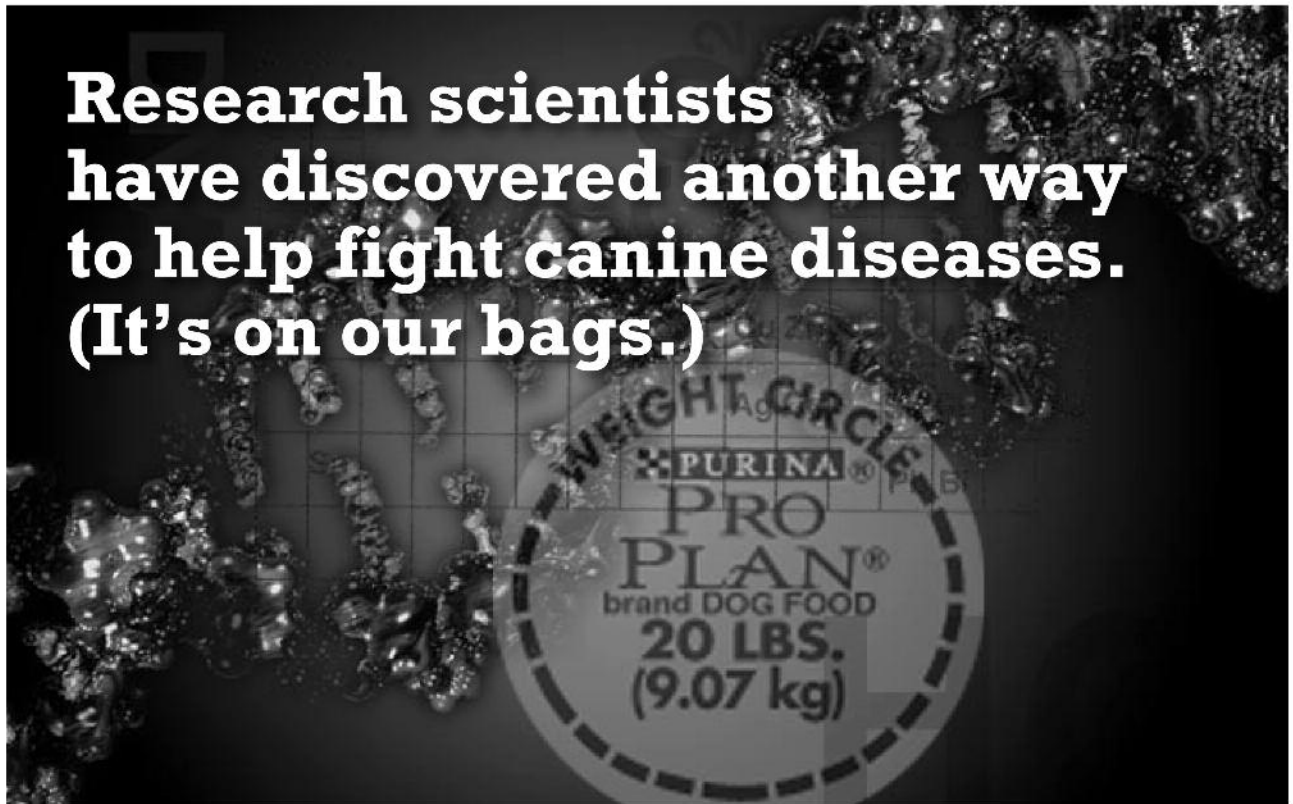

LaMar Mathis is a life member of the American Spaniel Club, joining in 1966 (44 years of membership) and an AKC judge of multiple groups since 1972.

LaMar and Elaine Mathis married after LaMar's return from Korea. Serving as an artillery forward-observer, he received a purple heart for severe shrapnel damage to his chest requiring 32 transfusions and much hospitalization. This information is given as it is amazing given the fact that, as of this date, LaMar, at 78+ years of age, may be the

oldest cocker exhibitor presently exhibiting his breeder/owner/handled dogs in the breed and group rings and successfully still winning at both.

LaMar was an AKC professional handler winning multiple all-breed Best in Shows and BISS on the various breeds of dogs. However, the LaMar breeding program has always been solely devoted to the cocker spaniel. LaMar had the pleasure of handling cocker spaniels for famous kennels of the past such as Hardee, Nor-Mar, Fi-Fo, Silver Maple, Shiloh-dell, Earnsliffe, to name but a few.

Ch. LaMar's Ivory Summer retired as the top winning bitch all varieties in the history of the breed in 1969 owner/ handled by LaMar.

Ch. LaMar's Saratoga, Ch. LaMar's Montana's sister, was the top winning Bitch all varieties in 1998. The multiple group winning Ch. LaMar's London was the top producer in 1974 and his son, Winterwood, the top winning cocker all varieties in 1975. There were many other multiple Group winners carrying the LaMar prefix. Generation after generation of producers came down from the line of London, Winterwood, Congressman, Claphands, Hu-Mar and the beautiful top winning bitches, Winter Beauty, Colleen OBrien and Ziegfield girl. LaMar's Kennels has also bred Best in Show and top producers in multiple foreign Countries.

Six cockers from LaMar's kennels received the recent ASC Hall of Distinction awards, including Ch. LaMar's London LOMX-HT, Ch. LaMar's Montana LOMX-HT, VP-HT, and Ch. Forjay's Soul Sensation LOMX-HT. London was the oldest dog awarded the first awards by the HOD, and Montana (now 13-1/2) was the first dog awarded a LOMX-HT VP-HT (a top producer, offspring top producers and versatile producer of outstanding performance dogs). London, James and Montana all have produced All-Breed Best in Show winners.

LaMar has whelped puppies, kept every LaMar cocker in full coat no matter the age, assisted with the many breedings of three popular stud dogs, evaluated, trimmed, presented, won and judged the Cocker Spaniel breed. The above indicates a lifetime of hard work toward the cocker spaniel breed, it was, however, indeed a chosen and most satisfying venture generation after generation.

With 53 years as a cocker breeder, handler of some of the outstanding cocker spaniels of the past, as well as a judge for 38 years his diverse background brings forth a wealth of knowledge of correct cocker structure, movement, type and the official standard. Your vote will be appreciated.
