The programs you will see here tonight exemplify what community television is all about: “empowering people to use media for human purposes.” This year we are marking the 15th year of the Fest and we are pleased that the Alliance for Community Media – Midwest Region accepted our invitation to participate and make it the Best of the Midwest Video Fest!

Media access centers from a nine-state area, Illinois, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, and Nebraska, were invited to enter. Eight centers participated: Iowa City Channel 4, Village of Elk Grove EGTV, Northwest Community Television, Showcase Chicago – Cable 25, Dakota Media Access, Village of Mount Prospect (IL), PATV – Iowa City, and CTV North Suburbs (Minneapolis area).

Joining these eight centers were twenty Wisconsin community access centers: Beloit Access Television, Fitchburg FACT TV, Janesville JATV 12, Jefferson JPEG, Kenosha Community Media, Marshfield Community Television, MATA Community Media, Merrill Productions, Oshkosh Community Media Services, Pleasant Prairie Media, Rice Lake Public Access Community Channel, River Cities Community Access, River Falls Community Television, Sun Prairie Media Center, Town of Sevastopol Community Television, Sheboygan WSCS, Trempealeau County Community Television, Watertown Television, Whitewater Community Television, and West Allis Community Media Center.

It was a banner year for the fest. Not only did we see a significant uptick in participation by WCM member stations, we also saw a big increase in entries. In all, 185 programs were judged this year, a more than 50% increase over last year, and 38% more than we normally see in the “average” fest. WOW! 12 of those programs were from outside of Wisconsin.

Clearly, despite many significant local setbacks, community access television is still going strong. Part of the reason is because people want more local coverage – more than we can find on local radio, local broadcast news, and even the local press – so many of them have folded or cut back to one day a week. In a recent study, the Pew Institute estimated that the number of jobs in journalism has declined 30% since its peak in 2000. At the same time Pew found another trend emerging. “In 2012, a continued erosion of news reporting resources converged with *growing opportunities* for those in politics, government agencies, companies and others to *take their messages directly to the public.*” The web has made this possible.

A Word about Video Fest Changes and the Show Order

This is the third year of a changed fest. Producers can submit programs online, fill out registration forms on-line, and pay on-line. Judges can use Excel-based judging forms to enter scores and comments, streamlining the awards process. This year we divided the categories between amateur and professional producers, with different judging metrics and types of judges for each. As in previous years, “Excellence,” “Achievement,” and “Merit” Awards were granted based on the raw scores earned in the judging process. This year, as last year, the high score and the low score were thrown out for each program and only the middle scores were averaged to determine the final score.

We have had a lot of feedback over the years asking us to find a way to shorten the Fest so people have more time to socialize. We are taking a stab at it again this year! Please note that the order of Achievement and Excellence Award recognition is in by last name and you may be recognized for several programs at once.

MERIT AWARD WINNERS: These programs and their producers will be listed in a rolling PowerPoint during dinner. Merit Award winners will be asked to stand and be recognized at the start of the show. Your awards are available at the side of the banquet room.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD WINNERS: A still from your program will be shown on the screen. You will be called individually to the stage to collect your award.

SIGNIFICANT COMMUNITY PROGRAM Producers: Your access station representative will introduce you, and you will be able to make some remarks.
