AGES 14 to Adult:

- Prepare 32 bars (or 1-minute) of a musical theater song from or in the style of the show. Bring sheet music in the correct key; an accompanist is provided.
- Bring your headshot, or an up-to-date picture of yourself.

- **Callbacks** will be held from 2-6pm on Sunday, June 27. Be prepared to read sides, sing songs from the show, and dance at callbacks. Sides and music selections will be provided.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN:

- Annie: A streetwise orphan; she is eventually taken in by Oliver Warbucks. Spunky, friendly, big voiced.
- **Orphans:** The other girls in the orphanage with Annie. They are gritty, vulnerable, honest, and loveable. Includes Molly, Kate, Tessie, Pepper, July, and Duffy.
- **Oliver Warbucks:** A successful and shrewd businessman. Rich, stiff-collared, bullish (which hides his soft heart).
- **Grace Farrell:** Secretary to Oliver Warbucks. Poised, accomplished, and brilliant.
- **Miss Hannigan:** The orphanage matron who cannot stand children but is fond of liquor. Very disillusioned and often hysterical.
- **Rooster:** Miss Hannigan's no-good brother looking for a quick buck. A sleazy, slick con man.
- **Lily:** Rooster's girlfriend, who is also out for a quick buck. While some consider her to have a few screws loose, stimuch smarter than most assume.
- **Bert Healy:** The ultimate radio personality. He helps Annie by broadcasting about the search for her birthparents.
- Roosevelt: The 32nd President of the United States. A Democrat and friend of Warbucks.
- **Ensemble:** Includes Warbuck's Staff (Drake, Mrs. Greer, Mrs. Pugh), Boylan Sisters, Cabinet Members, Hooverville Citizens, and various other characters.
