Rhoda Bloom Kosher Food Pantry Needs Your Support – *Ongoing!*

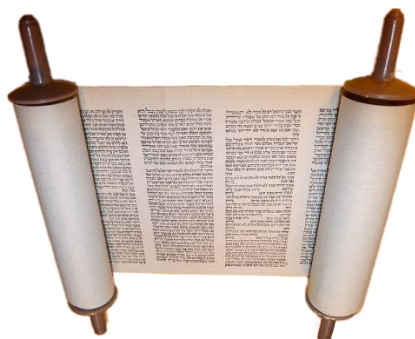

This QCD would help offset satisfying your RMD, potentially lowering your taxable annual income (and possibly your tax bracket) while at the same time greatly helping Congregation Shir Shalom.
