

TOURNAMENT RULES

Scramble Rules

- 1. All play will proceed from the white tees for men and from the red tees for women.
- 2. Each hole will be played as follows:
 - a. All players on each team make a tee shot.
 - b. A tee shot will be selected and each player plays from approximately the same position as the selected shot (within one club length of the chosen shot and no closer to the hole- you may not improve your lie from the rough or sand trap).
 - c. Play will continue in the same manner until each hole is complete, including putting.
 - d. Tap-ins allowed but mark your ball position first in case you miss.
- 3. The scoring format is based on the team low score for the round.
- 4. Seed or replace all divots and repair ball marks on greens.
- 5. When finished be sure your scorecard is complete and submitted through the app. <u>Prizes</u>

1st, 6th, and 12th placed teams will be recognized in the MCA newsletter.

Event Information

- 1. Each team can use one mulligan per side. (Sale of mulligans will close when the tournament begins).
- 2. There is no raffle this year.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Please follow State of Minnesota Emergency Executive Order 20-81 and their guidelines.
- Social distancing of 6 feet.
- Do NOT play if you feel sick or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last two weeks.
- Do NOT touch or handle any tournament supplies or equipment that is not yours.
- *Clubhouse is not open, not even bathrooms.
- Portable restrooms are available on holes #4, 6, 11, 14 and 17.
- Registration: A registration table will be set up. Carts will be labeled with your name and will have a name tag in the cup holder.
- *Deer Run is allotting 2 carts per foursome.
- The putting green and driving range will be open.
- *Lunch: box lunches to be eaten on your carts before golf.
- Rules: We will have a QR code at the cart. This will include items listed here and the golf tournament rules.
- *Tee times on #1 and #10 starting at 11:30am.
 - Specific tee times are available.
- *Scoring: Group online scoring will be through an app.
- Mulligans: Please purchase ahead of time if possible. We will have contact free purchase options the day of.
- *No Deer Run sponsored games: Long drive, etc.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Sponsor signs will be provided by the MCA as usual.
- Please follow CDC guidelines when sponsoring the holes.
- Deer Run is requesting hole sponsors provide their own tables and chairs.
- Hole sponsors will be on the hole from 11:30am to approx 6:30pm.
- *Sponsors: Sponsors allowed to be at holes, practicing social distancing. No games or contests.
- We encourage sponsors to set up a 6'-0" perimeter to remind themselves and others to leave space. A folding table is only 2'-6" wide, so golfers should stand 3'-6" back from the table.
- *2 drink tickets per player included.
- *Deer Run continues to have two drink carts on the course.
- *Dinner will not be provided by Deer Run. We are not able to have a happy hour or raffle. After you complete your last hole this concludes your scheduled activities.
- The Golf Committee is reviewing alternate dinner options and will share the information if these are able to be worked out.
- Due to the additional time we will be on the course as well as other procedures undertaken by Deer Run, they are not able to offer discounted rates. We reviewed ala carte pricing but are still able to offer the best value with the contract we have used with them in years past. Pricing adjustments will not be made.
- There is not a standard set of laws governing golf course protocol. Different courses and organizations have slight variations on the protocols they are following. We have worked with Deer Run to understand their rules and provide guidelines to the best of our ability. Please let us know if you have questions or concerns.
