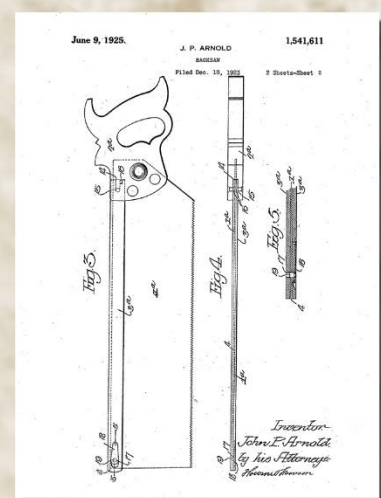
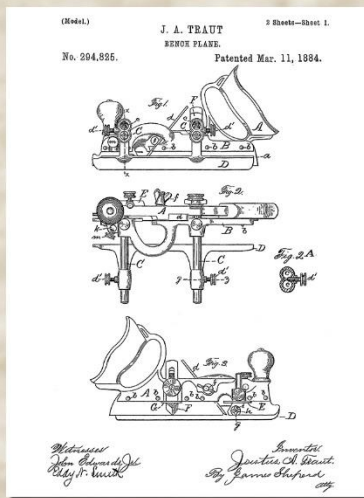
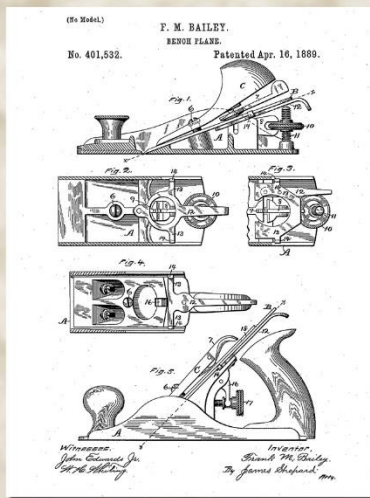
Stanley Tool Collectors Exhibit - "Celebrating over 170 years of Excellence"
