**Eddie the Elk Wears
a Bow for a Good Cause**



October is Liver Cancer Awareness Month and Eddie is showing his support by wearing a green ribbon. More than 700,000 people are diagnosed with liver cancer each year throughout the world. Liver cancer is also a leading cause of cancer deaths worldwide, accounting for more than 600,000 deaths each year. Only cancers that start in the liver are called liver cancer, these are known as primary liver cancers. They include Hepatocellular carcinoma (hepatocellular cancer) this is the most common form in adults.

Hepatocellular cancer (HCC) can have different growth patterns:

Some begin as a single tumor that grows larger. Only late in the disease does it spread to other parts of the liver. A second type seems to start as many small cancer nodules throughout the liver, not just a single tumor. This is seen most often in people with cirrhosis (chronic liver damage) and is the most common pattern seen in the United States.

Other forms of liver cancer Intrahepatic cholangiocarcinoma (bile duct cancer), Angiosarcoma and hemangiosarcoma, Hepatoblastoma.

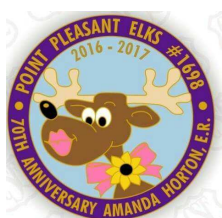

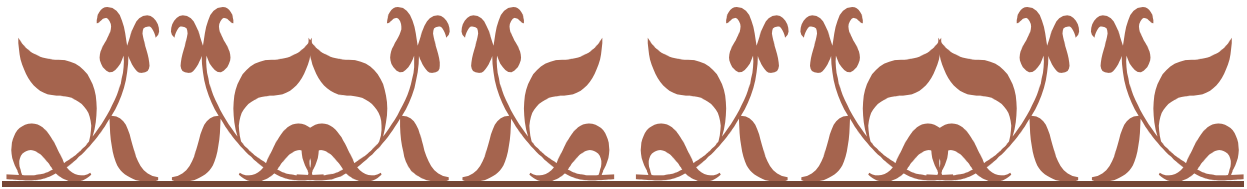

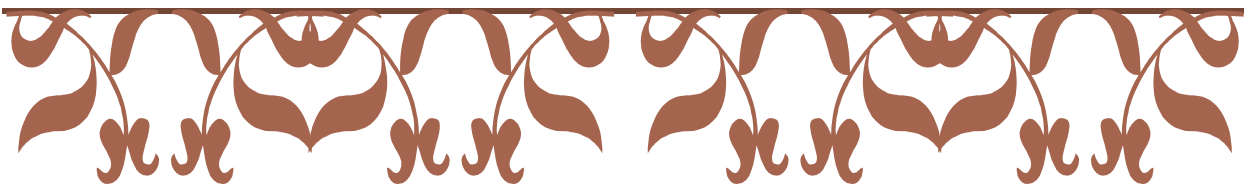
Point Pleasant Lodge Scholarship Programs

Attention: Parents, Grandparents, and the Class of 2017:

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) 2016-2017 Scholarship Year begins on-line September 1, 2016. All graduating 2017 High School Seniors may apply for the Most Valuable Student (MVS) Scholarship and if you are an Elk child or grandchild, you may also apply for the Legacy Scholarship at Elks.org. Point Boro and Point Beach Seniors may ask their Guidance Counselors for assistance. They are quite knowledgeable about these scholarships and the application requirements. Scholarship grants range: \$4,000-\$50,000 over 4 years. The MVS application is available online at enf.elks.org/mvs and must be submitted online by the November 30, 2016, deadline. The Legacy application is available at this url: <http://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/Legacy.cfm> and is due February 17, 2017.

If you are a resident of Point Pleasant, Point Pleasant Beach, Bay Head, and Lavallette and are enrolled at CBA, St. Rose, Red Bank Catholic, MATES or another high school, please join us and apply. The Point Pleasant Elks is ready to sponsor you in your quest for college financial assistance.

Since 1944, the ENF has been helping the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks go to college through the Emergency Educational Grant program. Children of deceased or totally disabled Elks members are eligible to apply. The Elk member must have been a member of good standing for at least one year at the time of death or disability. The applicant must be unmarried, under the age of 23 and attending an accredited U.S. institution of higher education as a full time student. Applications are available starting May 1 and must be submitted to the ENF by October 31.
