





A pastor must know what he is doing, where he is going and why. Otherwise, intelligent people will not have confidence in him and will not follow him very far. A good pastoral leader cannot be constantly passive and nondirective. If tasks are accomplished, some of necessity must assume some degree of leadership. On the other hand, a good pastoral leader does not always have to do everything himself and does not think that his way is always the correct way. A good pastoral leader is able to provide direction, supervision and still have an appreciation for group dynamics.
