USC OLYMPIANS: 1904-2016

USC's participation in the Olympics dates to 1904, when Emil Breitkreutz became the first USC student to compete in the Olympic Games, bringing home a bronze medal in the 800 meters. Since then, there have been 451 athletes who attended USC before, during or after their Olympic appearance. They have collected 309 medals—including 144 golds, 93 silvers and 72 bronzes—and have won at least one gold medal in every Summer Olympics since 1912.
