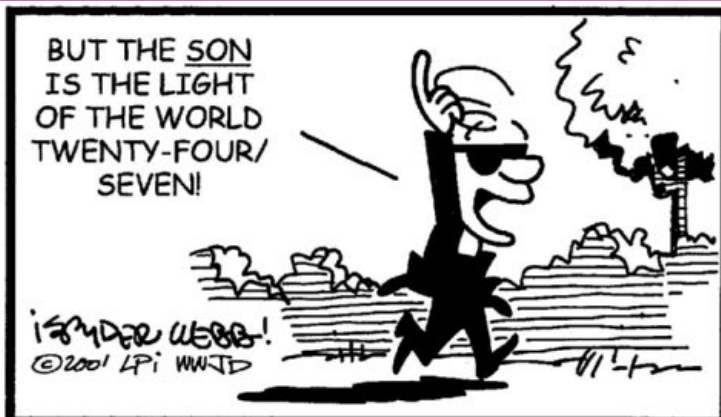

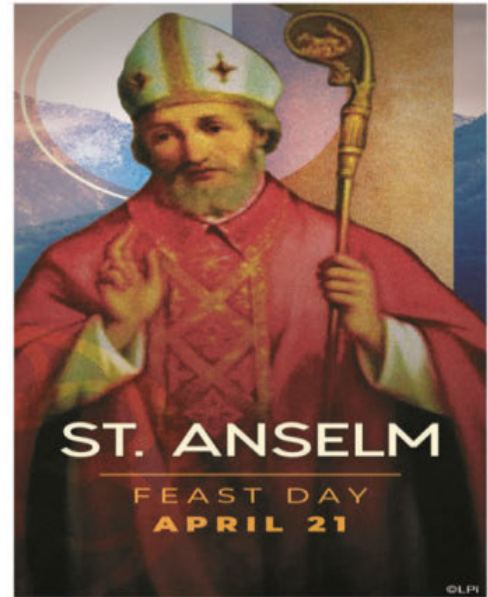

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Anselm of Canterbury left his home in Italy to travel as a young man and ended up at the monastery in Bec, France, which was known for the teachings of its leader, Lanfranc. Anselm rose quickly to become abbot of the community and his writings are now compared in importance to those of St. Augustine.

In 1093 Anselm was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury by William II Rufus, the son and successor of William the Conqueror. However, at the time there was a controversy in Europe over whether kings or the pope had the power to invest bishops. Anselm, who believed only the pope should have the right to invest an ecclesiastical authority, spent much of his time as Archbishop exiled in Rome.

St. Anselm's teaching and works of theology are his most important contribution to the Catholic faith. He is considered of the fathers of scholastic theology and his chief achievement in philosophy was the ontological argument for the existence of God. His work *Cur Deus homo?* taught that atonement for sins could only be achieved through Christ. He was canonized in 1494 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1720.

THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER

From the dogmatic constitution on the Church of the Second Vatican Council (*Lumen gentium* n. 9)

The Church as sacrament of unity and salvation

See, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah ... I will plant my law within them and inscribe it in their hearts. I will be their God and they shall be my people ... All shall know me, from the least to the greatest, says the Lord.

It was Christ who established this new covenant, the new testament in his blood, calling into being, from Jews and Gentiles, a people that was to form a unity, not in human fashion but in the Spirit, as the new people of God. Those who believe in Christ, reborn not of corruptible but of incorruptible seed through the word of the living God, not from the flesh but from water and the Holy Spirit, are constituted in the fullness of time as *a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people God has made his own ...*, once no people but now the people of God.

This messianic people has Christ as its head: Christ *who was given up for our sins and rose again for our justification*; bearing now the name that is above every name, he reigns in glory in heaven. His people enjoy the dignity and freedom of the children of God, in whose hearts the Holy Spirit dwells as in a temple. They have as their law the new commandment of loving as Christ himself has loved us. They have as their goal the kingdom of God, begun on earth by God himself and destined to grow until it is also brought to perfection by him at the end of time, when Christ, our life, will appear, and *creation itself will be freed from slavery to corruption and take on the freedom of the glory of God's children.*

This messianic people, then, though it does not in fact embrace all mankind and often seems to be a tiny flock, is yet the enduring source of unity, hope and salvation for the whole human race. It is established by Christ as a communion of life, of love and of truth; it is also used by him as an instrument for the redemption of all, and is sent out into the whole world as the light of the world and the salt of the earth.

The Israel of old was already called the Church of God while it was on pilgrimage through the desert. So the new Israel, as it makes its way in this present age, seeking a city that is to come, a city that will remain, is also known as the Church of Christ, for he acquired it by his own blood, filled it with his Spirit, and equipped it with appropriate means to be a visible and social unity. God has called together the assembly of those who in faith look on Jesus, the author of salvation and the principle of unity and peace, and so has established the Church to be for each and all the visible sacrament of this unity which brings with it salvation.

PENSAMIENTOS PARA CONSIDERAR

De la Constitución dogmática *Lumen gentium*, sobre la Iglesia, del Concilio Vaticano segundo (Núm. 9)

LA IGLESIA, SACRAMENTO VISIBLE DE LA UNIDAD

Mirad que llegan días —oráculo del Señor— en que haré con la casa de Israel y la casa de Judá una alianza nueva. Meteré mi ley en su pecho, la escribiré en sus corazones; yo seré su Dios, y ellos serán mi pueblo. Todos me conocerán, desde el pequeño al grande —oráculo del Señor—. Alianza nueva que estableció Cristo, es decir, el nuevo Testamento en su sangre, convocando un pueblo de entre los judíos y los gentiles, que se congregara en unidad, no según la carne, sino en el Espíritu, y constituyera el nuevo pueblo de Dios. Pues los que creen en Cristo, renacidos de germen no corruptible, sino incorruptible, por la palabra de Dios vivo, no de la carne, sino del agua y del Espíritu Santo, son hechos por fin una raza elegida, un sacerdocio real, una nación consagrada, que antes era «no pueblo», y ahora es «pueblo de Dios». Este pueblo mesiánico tiene por cabeza a Cristo, que fue entregado por nuestros pecados y resucitado para nuestra justificación, y ahora, después de haber conseguido un nombre que está sobre todo nombre, reina gloriosamente en los cielos. Este pueblo tiene como propia condición la dignidad y libertad de los hijos de Dios, en cuyos corazones habita el Espíritu Santo como en un templo.

Tiene por ley el mandato de amar como el mismo Cristo nos amó. Tiene, por último, como fin, la dilatación del reino de Dios, iniciado por el mismo Dios en la tierra, hasta que sea consumado por él mismo al fin de los tiempos, cuando se manifieste Cristo, nuestra vida, y la creación misma se vea liberada de la esclavitud de la corrupción, para entrar en la libertad gloriosa de los hijos de Dios. Este pueblo mesiánico, por tanto, aunque de momento no abarque a todos los hombres, y no raras veces aparezca como una pequeña grey, es, sin embargo, el germen más firme de unidad, de esperanza y de salvación para todo el género humano. Constituido por Cristo en orden a la comunión de vida, de caridad y de verdad, es empleado también por él como instrumento de la redención universal, y es enviado a todo el mundo como luz del mundo y sal de la tierra. Y así como al pueblo de Israel según la carne, peregrino en el desierto, se le llama ya Iglesia, así al nuevo Israel, que va avanzando en este mundo hacia la ciudad futura y permanente, se le llama también Iglesia de Cristo, porque él la adquirió con su sangre, la llenó de su Espíritu y la proveyó de medios aptos para una unión visible y social. La congregación de todos los creyentes, que miran a Jesús como autor de la salvación y principio de la unidad y de la paz, es la Iglesia convocada y constituida por Dios para que sea sacramento visible de esta unidad salutífera para todos y cada uno.
