

Adult Faith Formation Easter Study: Resurrection!

We will meet weekly during the Easter Season on Wednesday evenings, **beginning April 30**, to reflect on Catholic belief in the afterlife as revealed in the Gospels, the Letters of St. Paul, and the Book of Revelation. The recorded presentations will be given by Professor Candida Moss, a professor of New Testament and Early Christianity at the University of Notre Dame. Each evening we will hear two 25-minute presentations with time for discussion after each section. Our meetings will be from 7:30 to 9 p.m., and it will be helpful for participants to bring a Bible.

Wondering Why

Mary Magdalene's encounter with Jesus at the tomb on Easter Sunday morning is a profound and deeply mystical account of the Resurrection. St. John tells us that Mary Magdalene came to the tomb very early on Sunday morning, "while it was still dark" he emphasizes. John uses the symbol of darkness to illustrate that the Light of the World had been extinguished. Mary is startled to see that the tomb has been opened and she runs to tell the other disciples. Peter and the Beloved Disciple return to the tomb with Mary. Peter enters first and finds the burial cloths folded up inside. The other disciple also enters the tomb and the text says "he believed." However, both disciples return home. Whatever the Beloved Disciple believed at that moment, he apparently did not share his thoughts with the grief stricken Mary who is left alone and weeping at the tomb.

In front of Mary is the tomb, an open hollow in the stone—dark, empty. It is a place of death, of loss, of hopelessness. Her tears testify to her great sorrow. Mary peers into the darkness of the tomb. She is looking into her own despair. But the tomb is not empty, as she had thought. She sees something inside. Perhaps at first it was just a glimmer of iridescence forming into something more corporal. Two angels are sitting on the ledge where the body of Jesus had lain. Jesus is standing in the garden behind her; but she does not know that yet. We might imagine that the two angels are almost laughing in their joy when they ask her why she is weeping, for as Mary remains peering into darkness and death, the angels are facing the other direction —looking directly at the Risen Christ standing behind Mary. The angels know what has happened, but Mary does not. Overwhelmed by her grief, she can only comprehend the empty darkness. Enveloped in joy, the angels comprehend that death is forever conquered by Life.

Again, she is asked why she is weeping, this time by a voice behind her whom she takes to be the gardener. Her eyes are blinded by her tears. Perhaps the rising sun throws its shining aura around the figure who stands there, making his face difficult to see. But when he says her name, "Mary," she recognizes the voice of the Lord and rushes to embrace him, in the light, in the garden, in the new life of Resurrection.

God first created life in a Garden calling forth human beings to share his love and joy. Christ rose to everlasting life in another garden and stood calling his disciple out of mourning and into rejoicing. She mistook him for the gardener, but she wasn't altogether in error. Christ is the Gardener who plants us in our garden, waters us with his Living Water, prunes when necessary, and nourishes us with the Light of the World, which is himself.

This Easter, may all who are staring into dark places hear Christ call their names, so that they may look around, see the Light, and believe in the Risen Christ!
