

Report from the Vision team of Greystone United Methodist Church

The vision of Greystone UMC is not ours -- it belongs to Christ. Our mission is to carry out His vision. We are reminded often in scripture to set goals: "run the race set before us." (Heb. 12:1 Set by God.) "Press toward the mark of the high calling of Christ." (Philippians 3:14) Our present Church Mission Statement reads: "Living out our heritage of reaching each new generation for Christ." It is a challenge to be active, to be moving in the direction of THE GOAL set before us.

Just as each of us has a spiritual growth goal, so our Faith Family has a growth goal. If we as individuals are growing spiritually, pursuing holiness, then surely that will be reflected and evidenced in our Faith Family's spiritual growth in the coming months.

Our vision team will be looking forward to lead our Faith Family forward in reaching our community for Christ. Just as Christ was asked, "who is my neighbor" so we should ask, "who is our community?" If you have read it, we challenge you to find specific points to pray over and ask God how you might participate in the spiritual growth of our Greystone Faith Family in the coming year. Share them with your small groups and begin inviting people to join you in worship.

This is an exciting time in the life of our church. There is a freshness sweeping through the Family. There is a renewed desire to be actively moving with God in the coming months. Our Vision Team has been challenged to set some specific goals as well as follow up on previous goals. Specifically, we are already at work preparing to follow through on a Communion rail and kneeling pads for our worship area, considering informative signage both inside and outside our facility, and seeking God's direction for Greystone UMC in the next 3 years as we consider a plan for strengthening our leadership development and mentoring our new members.

As your Vision Team, we are praying for God's guidance and revelation of goals for the coming years. We are praying our eyes to be open to the ways and means of actively reaching Christ's vision of making disciples. We want you to join us in being a moving, active body of believers. Together we want to encourage each other to move with God in carrying out the mission and the vision set before us. Let us begin this year reaching **every** generation for Christ. 
