State Wildland Qualifications Committee Meeting. Merydth Walter presented an overview of the training and qualification structures in Victoria Australia and outlined the pathway she followed to obtain her qualifications. She also distributed a Course Overview, Oral and Skills Assessments, Written Assessments, and Theory Assessments packets for the positions relevant to the pathway she followed throughout her career. Given the amount of information and the time constraints of the meeting on 3/10, the committee tasked a sub-committee (Todd Abel, Bob Arthur, Susan Burger) to meet separately prior to the next meeting on April 6th 2020. Their task was to review and analyze the training and qualification requirements in Victoria, Australia, compare them with the NWCG 310-1 requirements, and then provide a proposal re: a transfer of her qualifications to the committee at the next meeting.

APRIL 1, 2020

Sub-Committee Equivalency Meeting Attendance: Todd Abel, Bob Arthur, Susan Burger, Krista Countryman

The sub-committee met for the purpose of (1) Analyzing the course content for the courses that were completed by Merydth Walter in Victoria, Australia as she advanced throughout her career from one position to another (2) Analyzing the performance requirements that were included in the task books she completed to become qualified in the positions she obtained as she advanced from one position to another (3) Compare the training and performance Merydth completed to the NWCG approved task books and courses (4) Determine what/if NWCG requirements for training and/or task book completion have been met. (5) Award equivalency credit for Training/Task Book experience where the criteria have been met.

During the process of review, the sub-committee requested her certification documents. Merydth obtained many of her qualifications prior to the use of Task Books in Victoria and, for the more recent qualifications, she stated she is not sure if she has them and, if she does, they are packed away in a storage unit in Australia and she does not have access to them now. She did not keep her training assessment packets. She has the letter from the Training Manager in Victoria stating her top level qualifications and little more.

Given the amount of documentation that Merydth did not have, the sub-committee was unable to compare her actual task books or her training to the NWCG requirements. Based on the letter from her Training Manager (which IS an acceptable form of documentation per SOG-804) the sub-committee is proposing the following:
