Selection of CPC-CBT

- My clinical history
 - Exposed very early to the work of the family therapy pioneers
- My teaching history
 - Army Medical Department Center and School
 - Family Advocacy Staff Training Courses (FAST and FASTA)
 - Passionate about the quality of instruction
 - Inclusion of evidence based theories
 - Implementation of learning
 - "We don't treat children"
- Case Review Committee (CRC) and DoD Data Bases

Selection, cont.

- Joined the MEDCOM team in 2014
 - No child abuse treatment
 - Rarely even interview children
 - Wrong!!!
- Identified CPC-CBT
- Why CPC-CBT?
 - Strong belief in family systems
 - Worked w/ at-risk families and families w/ more profound abuse
 - Allowed for the development of a "train-the-trainer" program

Implementation

- 2015 Child Abuse Family Advocacy Staff Training Course
 - Participation not restricted
 - FAP Regional Consultants included
- 2016 Child Abuse FASTA launched CPC-CBT
 - Message to the field requesting volunteers
 - Articles
 - Participation limited to clinicians
 - 14 installations 32 Clinicians
 - Introductory preparatory phone calls
 - Training
 - Post TCONS

Implementation

- 2015 Child Abuse Family Advocacy Staff Training Course
 - Participation not restricted
 - FAP Regional Consultants included
- 2016 Child Abuse FASTA launched CPC-CBT
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 - Motivational Interviewing training
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Implementation

- 2017 Child FASTA February -Refresher training
 - Attrition
 - Included prevention staff
 - Definitely needed
 - On-going TCONS
- 2018 Child FASTA
 - Recruiting participants

Challenges

- Finding families
- Engaging families
- Time commitment
- Location challenges
- Handling discouragement
- Gaining leadership support and buy in
- "Tyranny of the urgency"
- TCONS
- Contracting

Way Ahead

- Brief Behavioral Health Leadership to gain senior leader support
- Assist participating installations in trouble shooting installation specific challenges.
