PICO

When looking for evidence a critical component is constructing the question in a way that will find results.

Patient, Population or Problem

What are the characteristics of the patient or population?

What is the condition or disease you are interested in?

What is the nursing process problem ?

Intervention or exposure

What do you want to do with this patient?

How do you want to change the nursing process?

Comparison

What is the alternative to the intervention ? (ie Placebo, no change to process, different drug)

Outcome

What are the relevant outcomes (e.g. morbidity, death, complications, efficiency, patient satisfaction?)

Problem one Your patient is a 68-year-old woman with osteoarthritis and moderate hypertension, She has seen information on one of the new COX-2 inhibitors on the internet. She has heard that they cause less GI bleeding. She, however, is also concerned that the new drugs will mean more out of pocket costs each month.

P : 68 year old woman with osteoarthritis and moderate hypertension

I : COX-2 Inhibitor

C: other NSAIDS

O: Pain control / Less GI bleeding

In a 68 year old woman with osteoarthritis of the knee, can COX-2 Inhibitor use decrease the risk of GI Bleeding compared with other NSAIDs?

Example two The nurses on the medical surgical floor have heard that Music can help their Surgery patients to control their pain. They are thinking on implementing this on their floor. They have been asked to provide evidence that it will work before they start using this therapy

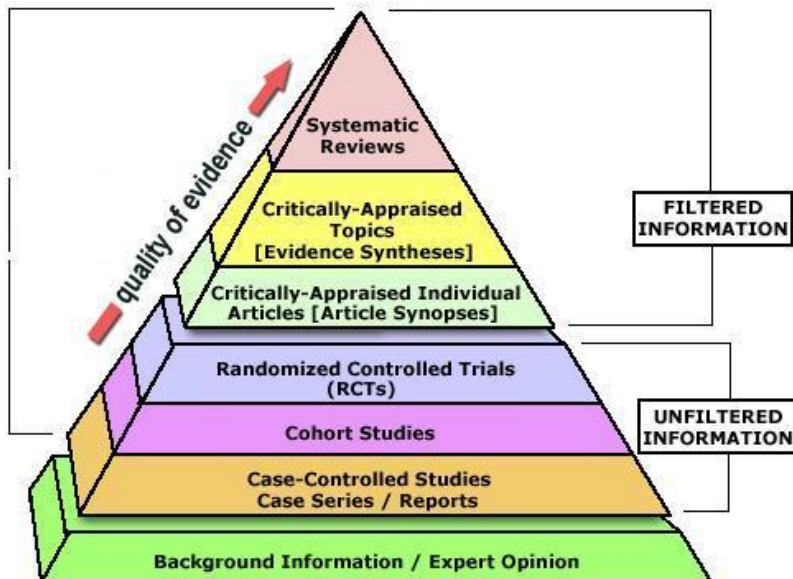
P: Adult Surgery Patients

Hints:

- Click on a Subject Heading to view its tree - related terms that are more general and more specific.
- Select the Explode box if you wish to retrieve results using the selected term and all of its more specific terms.
- Select the Focus box if you wish to limit your search to those documents in which your subject heading is considered the major point of the article.
- If your search did not map to a desirable subject heading, select the box Search as Keyword.
- If you select more than one term, you can combine them using a boolean operator (AND or OR).
- If you wish to see the scope note for any term or heading, click on the information [i](#) icon, when available.

In most cases you want to explode you subject heading. As you can see there are three specific types of osteoarthritis besides osteoarthritis. You want to pick up the narrower terms. You accomplish this by exploding. Please also read the hints above. Click on the continue button. You now get a list of subheadings. This is where you choose therapy.

Click on limits at the top. This is the important work in doing an evidence based search. You have a lot of choices. You should always limit to English and Journal article as Comments and letters are only someone's opinion, not evidence. You see that if you are doing a broad subject you can limit to Cochrane Systematic Review here. They are the topic reviews. You can use clinical queries. On a more general subject as limits also. Instead of selecting drug therapy in subheadings you could have selected therapy from the clinical queries. You must select additional limits to get to age groups. These can be very important in a search as this is how you restrict to geriatrics or pediatrics.

Look at your results. You will see that some are reviews and some are Randomized Control Trials. Which ones will give you the highest level of evidence? You can select the ones you want to keep and then print, email or export to a word or text file. You also can add these to your projects. You will need to set up a private account after logging into our Ovid account in order to do this. The bibliographic links will take you to the Pubmed citations. If you are logged into my ncbi in Pubmed with our login ahs1 library1 , you will get links to the articles the we have available to you. Some of the citations in OVID have links directly to the full text but the links in Ovid are not as complete as those in Pubmed. Pubmed and Medline OVID are the same database but it easier to limit your search in OVID.

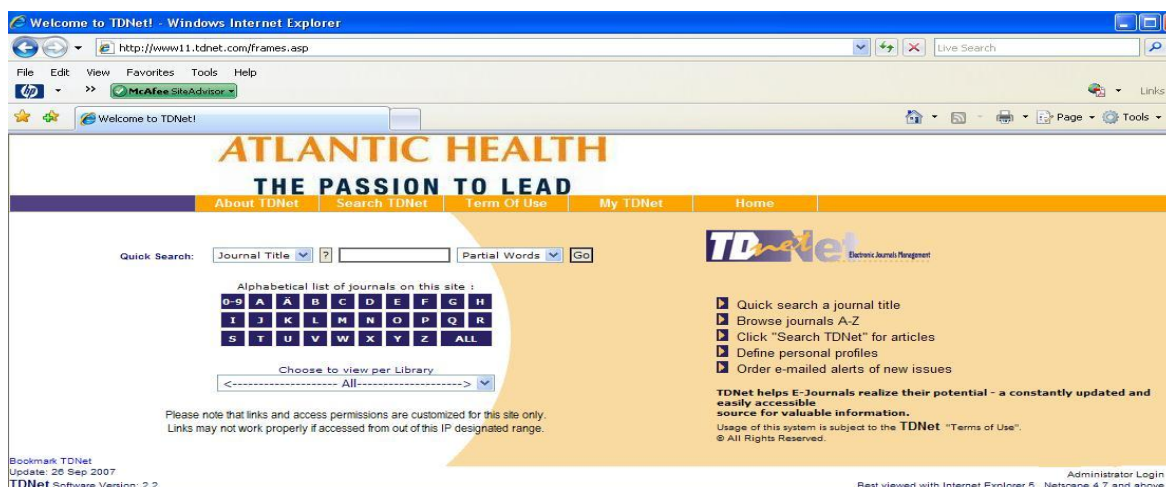
