I have a healthy pride for how well maintained this parish has been kept. We have beautiful grounds and landscaping to compliment our buildings. We all can be proud of our parish campus. What pleases me most is when I call upon parishioners to help and someone not only steps forward, but they donate back for a cost savings to the parish. The most recent example of this good stewardship is the back steps and stoop on the rectory.

The steps were deteriorating, so I called Dave and Marilyn Feuling and Dave didn't hesitate to get the rectory and garage steps repoured. Both steps were original and did not have good footings causing settling. Dave made a call for concrete removal to a Middleton contractor that happened to be a parishioner who I knew well from St. Francis, Cross Plains. Not only did Dave and Marilyn give a generous discount for a cost savings to our parish, but also my former parishioner, Jessica Kalscheur. Thanks to both the new steps cost half of what was estimated.

I have an architect friend who is designing railings to compliment the rectory at no cost for his time. When the new addition for the school was completed, there was an extra pallet and a half of stone that could not be returned. I have found a way to repurpose the stone so it will not go to waste to dress up the base of the rectory stoop and it will blend into the cream city brick nicely. Our friends at Cardinal stubbed out gas for my new grill at an always fair rate and in addition have made a very generous donation back to the parish far beyond my expectations. Thank you, Sharon and Rick. The stainless-steel grill was donated to me by a friend who worked at Wolf appliances, so that is no cost to the parish. I am grateful for all who love sharing their time and resources so generously to make our parish the exceptional parish that it is. You all make me proud to be your pastor.

## *Fall Bible Study*

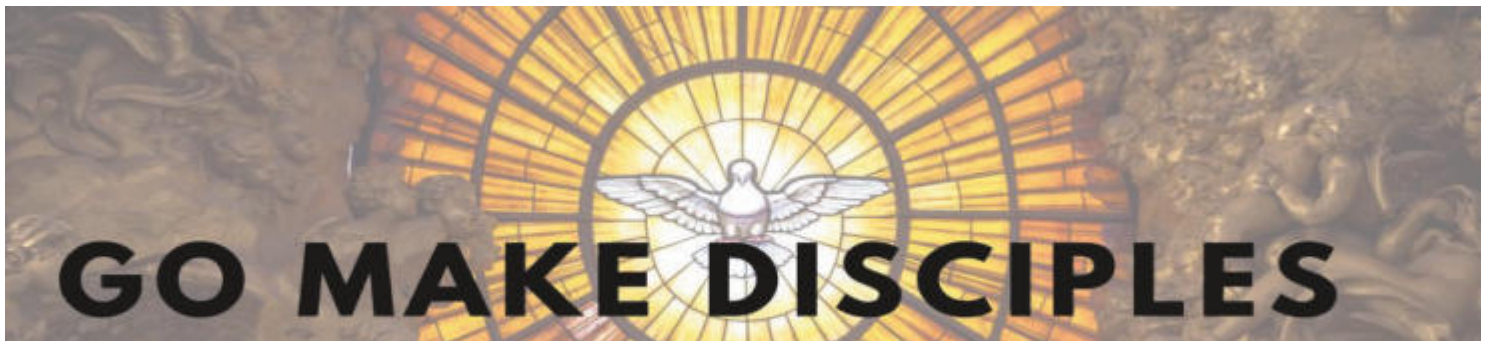
