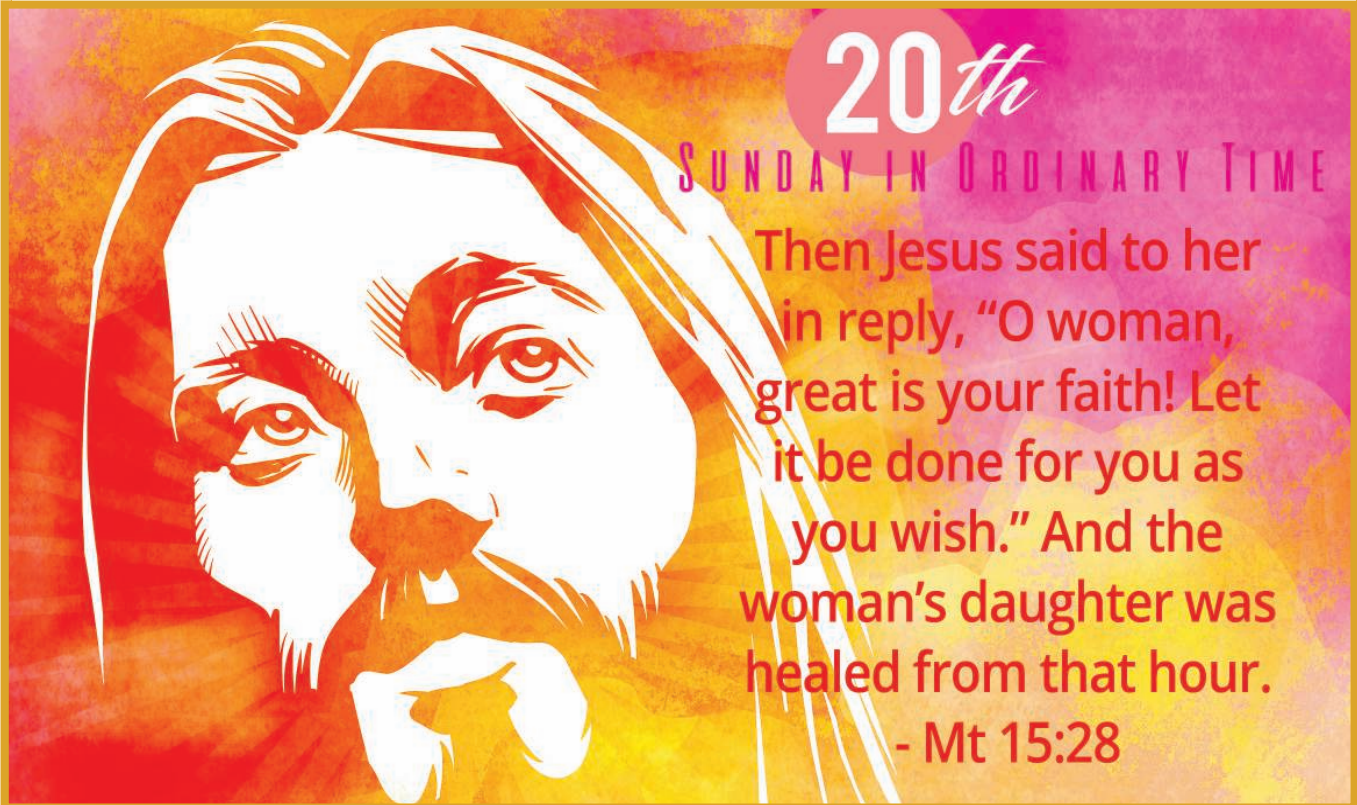

Our enrollment is up a little this year. Our Preschool and Grade 8 are full, some of the other grades are also near capacity. We are welcoming new Middle School Science and 3rd Grade teachers, as a result of relocation and a retirement. We wish Miss Michalak and Mrs. Thresher all the best as they move on to new chapters in their lives. Our new teachers come with a wealth of experience and a desire to teach in a faith-based environment. As I type this, things are looking good for Saint Paul School.

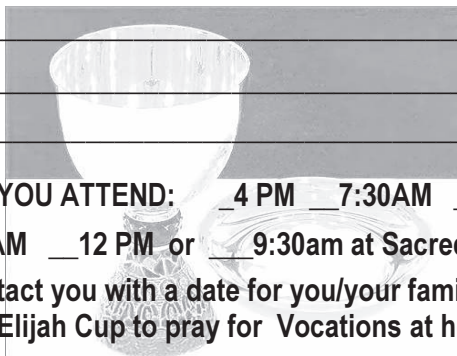

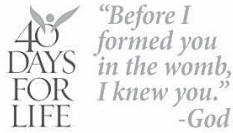

We'd like to invite you to join with the Culture of Life ministry in this year's **40 Days For Life** campaign. Our parish campaign runs from September 27<sup>th</sup> through November 5<sup>th</sup>, and we're planning a variety of parish activities to raise awareness of the evils and heartbreak of abortion, promote a culture of life in our society, and pray for the end to abortion in our world – all in a peaceful and dignified manner.

.....40 Days for Life is a community-based campaign that takes a determined, peaceful approach to showing local communities the consequences of abortion in their own neighborhoods, for their own friends and families. It puts into action a desire to cooperate with God in the carrying out of His plan for the end of abortion. It draws attention to the evil of abortion using a three-point program:

**Prayer and fasting**  
**Constant vigil**  
**Community outreach**

The mission of the campaign is to bring together the body of Christ in a spirit of unity during a focused 40-day campaign of prayer, fasting, and peaceful activism, and to seek God's favor to turn hearts and minds from a culture of death to a culture of life, thus bringing an end to abortion.

- Abortion Clinic Vigil – New Haven - 10/14 (Sat) 8:00am – 11:00am – joining with Helpers of God's Precious Infants Ministry
- Stations of the Cross at Sacred Heart Church - 10/20 (Fri) 7:00pm
- Abortion Clinic Vigil – Hartford: 10/21 (Sat) 8:00am – 11:00am – joining with Helpers of God's Precious Infants Ministry
- Rosary on the parish green - 10/28 (Sat) 11:00am
- Campaign Closing Mass at Sacred Heart Church - 11/5 (Sun) at 9:30am
