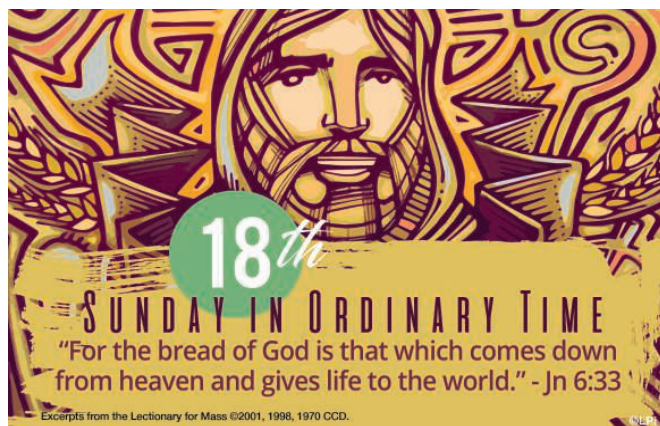

SOUND SYSTEM UPDATE

We were planning on having the speakers installed in August to complete our *Sound System*

renovation. However, one speaker is on back order and won't come in until September. The speakers, and some other audio work, will now be installed the week of September 24-28. Work will be going on in church and in the church basement during this time.

IMPROVEMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION

In my letter to you that you received with your six month financial statement, I indicated that preliminary figures showed we would be \$11,000 short in our operating budget. We have the final figures now and are actually \$18,592 short. We must address this deficit immediately. Therefore, all monies collected in the Improvement Fund envelopes, which will be changed to the Deficit Reduction envelopes, will be put toward reducing our deficit. We will track our progress each week in the bulletin. You have been so generous in the past with your donations in the Improvement Fund envelopes that we have been able to make many needed improvements at Sacred Heart. Thank you for that and I know that you will continue to help to reduce our current deficit. We were planning on using the Improvement Fund envelopes to start fundraising to help remodel our kitchen in the church basement. That fundraising will be put on hold until our deficit is eliminated. However, the work of the Kitchen Remodel Committee will continue and they will be able to use \$20,000 from the Sacred Heart Foundation to continue their work. We are not able to use Foundation funds for normal operating expenses.

Scrip cards are purchased at a discount from hundreds of retailers locally and nationally. They are then sold to the buyer at face value. The profit remains with our parish or can be applied towards the tuition of an Assumption family of your choice. For example, \$20 can purchase a \$20 Kwik Trip card. The scrip office purchases Kwik Trip cards for less than face value and the difference is going either to the parish or a student. Here at St. Alexander's we sell scrip every Sunday before and after Mass. We have a variety of cards on hand and what we don't have in stock can be pre-paid and picked up the following Sunday. In the bulletin you will find, this week and from now on every 1st Sunday of the month, a scrip order form. Please support our scrip program to raise funds for the parish!
