VOLUNTEERING AT ST. THERESA'S CHURCH / SCHOOL

- A Certificate that you have attended the required diocesan **Protecting God's Children Workshop** (NOTE: Even if you completed a safe environment workshop offered by another organization, you must still complete a diocesan PGC Workshop to be cleared by the Diocese)
- A Certificate that you have completed Mandated Reporter Training
- A signed Acknowledgement Form that you will abide by the Diocesan Code of Conduct
- A signed Acknowledgement Form that you will follow the Diocesan Abuse Reporting Policy

All volunteers who work with children and youth and all who supervise groups/programs/ clubs/activities for children and youth must complete all State and Diocesan Requirements before they begin working with children and youth.
