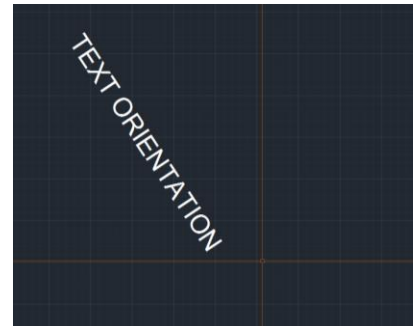
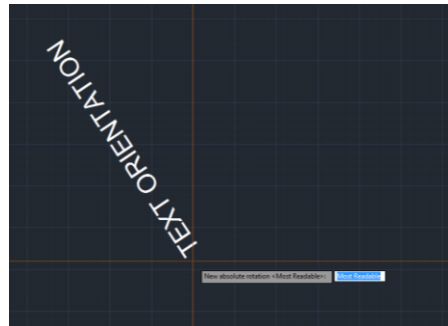
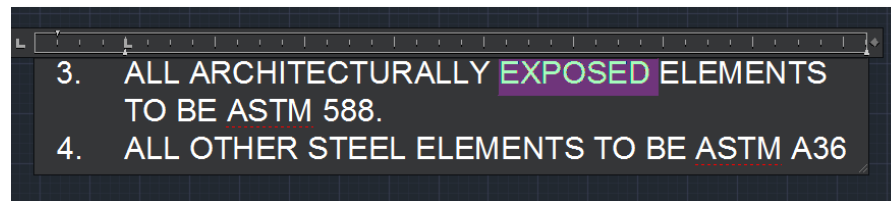
Selection tools

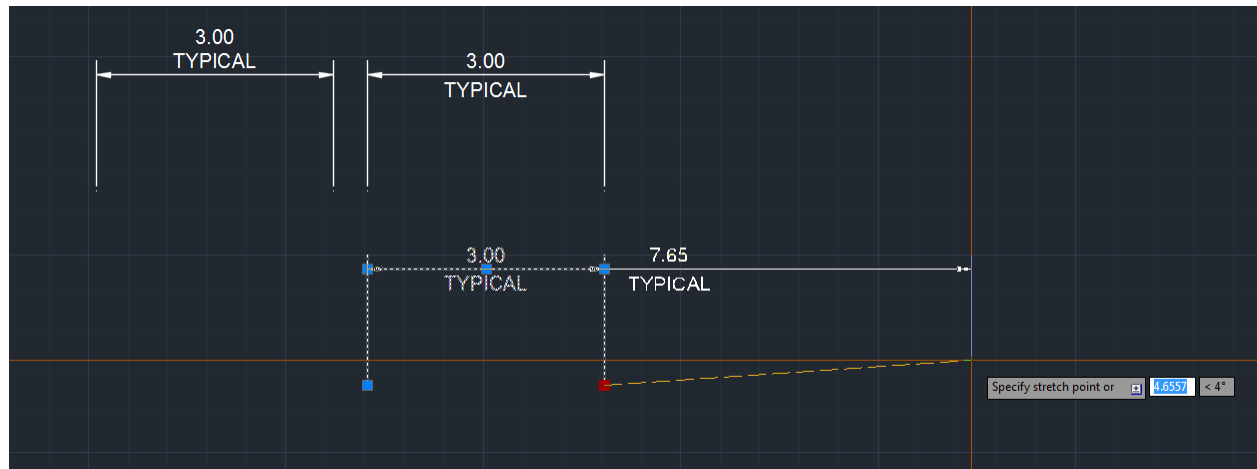
Working with text

- MTEXT editor – little known tricks
- TEXTALIGN
- Text justification
- Resizing text box
- TORIENT - Text orientation



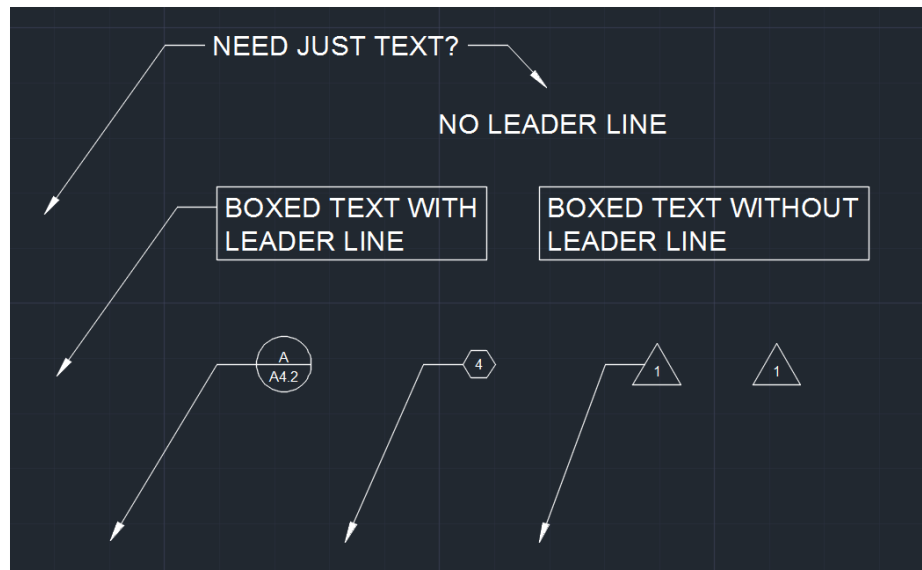
Working with dimensions

- QDIM – quick dimensioning and editing
- Stack dimensions - \X followed by text
- DIMSCALE set to 0 – for multiple viewport scales
- Trim and extend dimensions



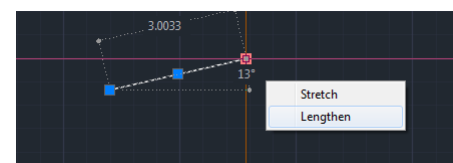
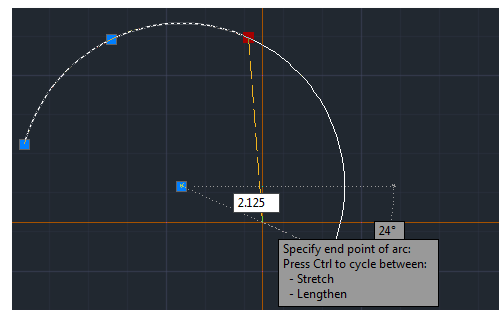
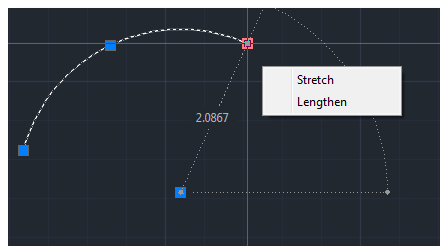
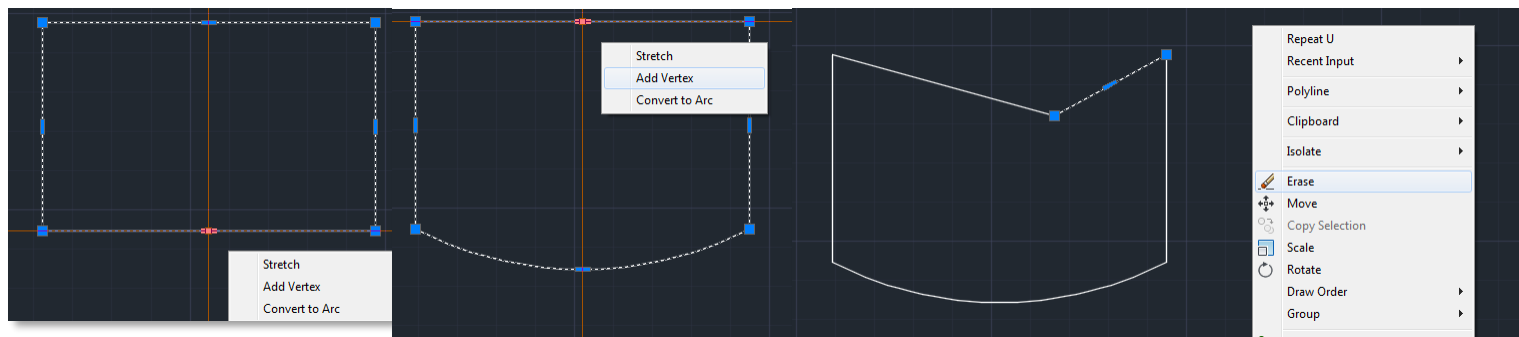
Working with multileaders

- No leader line, just text
- Leader with boxed text
- Leader with blocks




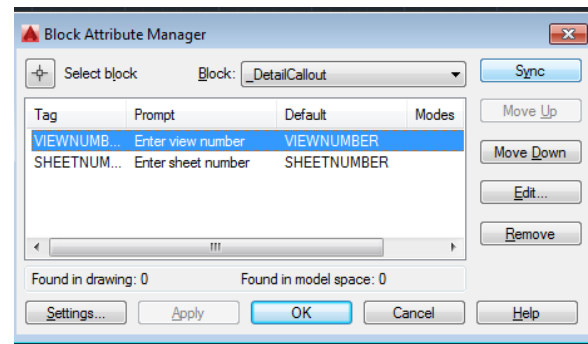
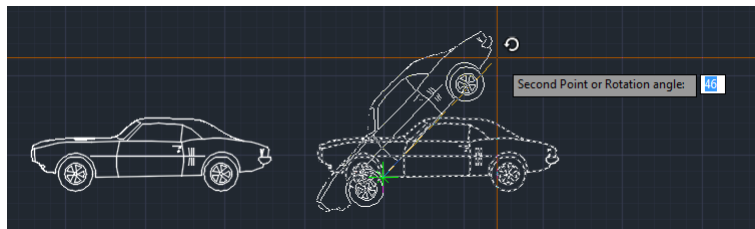
GRIPS Editing

- Objects: Lines, Polylines, Arcs, Arrays
- Dimensions
- Leaders



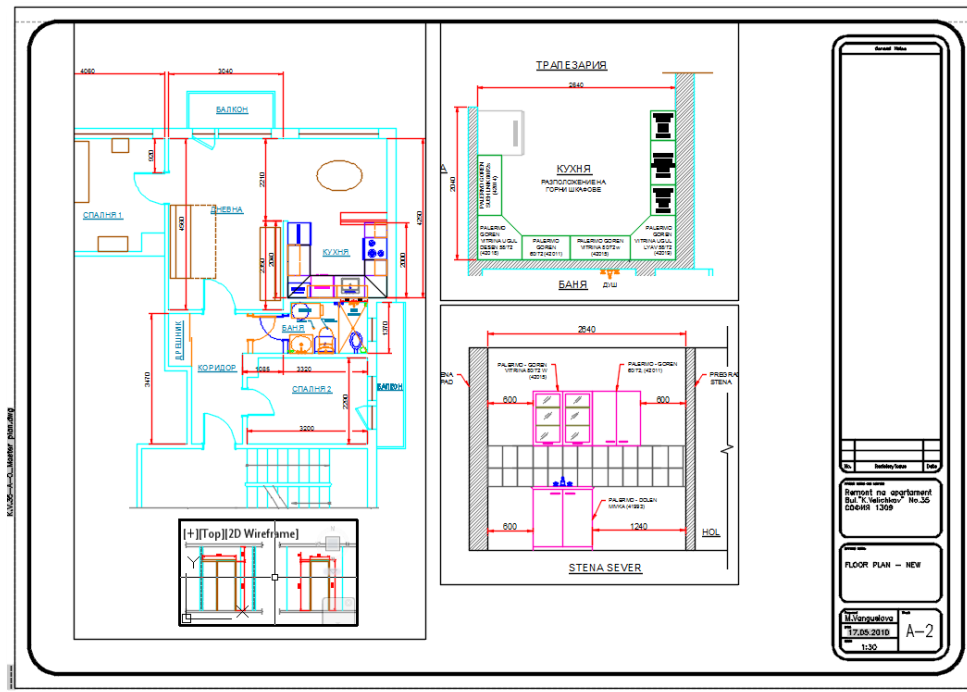
Objects creation and editing

- Layer creation – use of comma “,”
- PEDITACCEPT
- TRIM/EXTEND - Extend option
- Rotate using directions (N, S, E, W) - 90° increments
- Copy – Array option
- MOCORO – Move, Copy, Rotate within one command
- Automatic Area
- BATTMAN - when working with block attributes 
- ATTIPEDIT – CTRL+select attribute line to edit



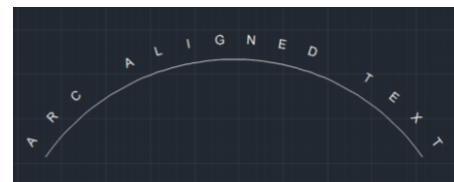
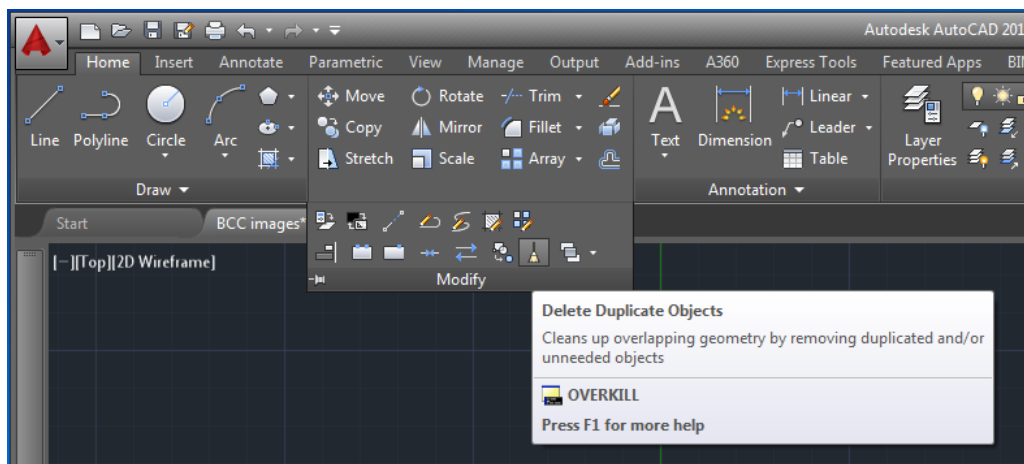
Viewports

- Cycle viewports (CTRL+R)
- Spaceswitch – to disable double click viewport activation
- VPLAYER



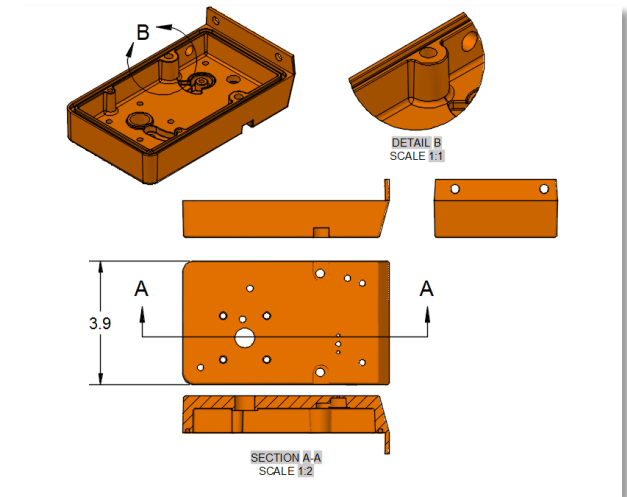
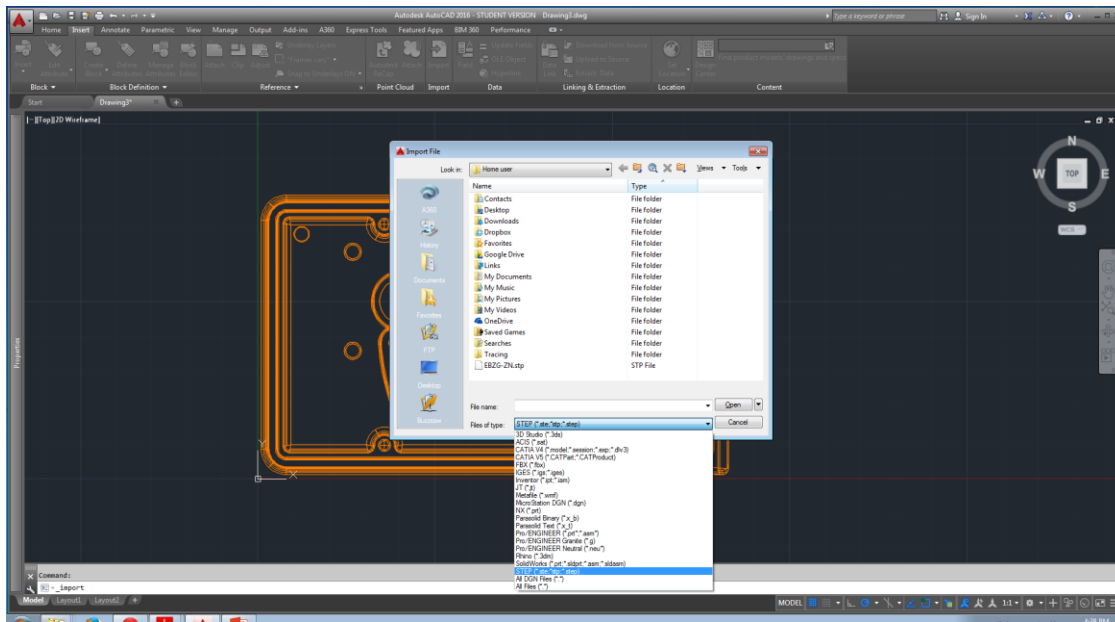
Some Express (or former Express) tools

- Text tools:
 - Convert single line text to Mtext
 - Auto Number
 - Enclose text in object
 - Fit text
 - Arc Aligned
- OVERKILL – Delete Duplicate Objects (now in Home tab)
- SuperHatch
- BURST – explode block with attributes and keep attribute value



Common platform for Files from other software

- Import files created in Fusion 360, Inventor, SolidWorks, Rhino and many other software
- Create detail views
- Annotate
