She created and co-taught an 8-credit program called *Making Media, Making Change*. She has consulted with schools, school districts, parent groups and other youth-serving organizations throughout North America on issues related to digital media, children, youth.

Antes de crear Spark & Stitch Institute en 2019, Erin enseñó a estudiantes de pregrado durante 9 años con el Consorcio de Educación Superior para Asuntos Urbanos.
