
Hats and Electronic Policy

Hats, Caps, & Head Coverings Policy

- Hats, caps, and other head coverings shall not be worn indoors, unless they are worn for religious or medical reasons.
- Approved hats may be worn during outside activities for sun protection.

Electronics Policy

• Any personal electronic device may be used before school begins and after the regular school day ends or during the lunch period when outside. The device shall not be used during class as a camera, calculator, and/or for email or text messaging and shall be turned off during class time and at any other time as directed by a school employee. The device may only be used for academic purposes with staff approval and shall not disrupt the education program or school activity.



- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Absence of undergarments is prohibited. Clothing shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. See-through or fish-net fabrics, halter tops, off-the-shoulder or low-cut tops, tube or strapless tops, bare midriffs, and skirts or shorts that show the buttocks are prohibited.
- Bathing suits are not permitted as outer wear, except when in use for a P.E. activity or athletic activity.
- Clothing, jewelry and personal items (backpacks, fanny) packs, gym bags, water bottles, etc.) shall be free of writing, pictures or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane or sexually suggestive, which bear drug, alcohol or tobacco company advertising, promotions and likenesses, or which advocate racial, ethnic or religious prejudice.

• Clothing or grooming that is obscene or defamatory, or that so incites students to create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful acts on school premises, or the violation of school regulations, or the substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the school is not permitted.

Clothes and belts must be the appropriate size and length when worn.

Gang-related and/or obscene/profane/vulgar tattoos must be covered at all times.



 School offices will be open to parents & community by appointment only.




ESSER III SURVEY RESULTS


Improve Advanced Placement Exam scores by providing workshops to review material and prepare for exams either before school, after school, and/or on Saturdays. 1,003 responses




Summer Bridge Program for incoming ninth grade students to review key math concepts and prepare for high school. 1,004 responses


