

This crib conforms to the standards of the U.S. Product Consumer safety commission.

Mattress Positions:

Please use the following guidelines as set forth by the American Academy of Pediatrics to decide which level is appropriate for your child:

LEVEL (1) highest position

To be uses by newborns, until shortly before they can sit alone. Under no circumstances should the mattress support be in its highest position after the child can sit.

LEVEL (2 or 3) middle positions

To be used by babies who can sit, until shortly before they can stand. Under no circumstances should the mattress support be in the middle position after the child can stand. Either possition can be used, It is your preference.

LEVEL (4) lowest position

The mattress support must be in it's lowest position before the baby can stand.

Under no circumstances should the child be allowed to use this crib when they reach 35 inches tall.

* Read all instructions before assembling crib.

KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.

- * Before each usage or assembly, inspect crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing or broken. Ask your dealer or write to BRATT DECOR, INC. for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- * After raising side, make sure latches are secure.
- * When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35" (90 cm), the crib shall no longer be used.
- * DO NOT place crib near window where cords from blind or drapes may strangle a child.
- * If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- * DO NOT leave child in crib with side lowered. Be sure side is in raised and locked position whenever child is in crib.
- * When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- * Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- * DO NOT use a water mattress with this crib.
- * Replace teething rail if damaged or loose



It is extremely important to make sure all bolts and other fasteners are securely tightened and checked for tightness at least once a week.




Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.








Attach the Front Bracket (H), the Back
Bracket (I) and the L Bracket (J) to the Side
Piece (A) using 8 of the Wood Screws (M). Insert the
casters by pushing them firmly (until they click into
place) into the mounting bushings on the bottom of the
legs. Now repeat this for Side Piece (B).






Attach the 2 Strike Plates (K) to the front gate using 4 of the Wood Screws (M). Note, the pilot holes are pre-drilled.





Attach the Back Piece to the Left Side (A) and the Right Side (B) using the 4 Long Machine Screws (N) and 4 of the Split Washers (P). Use the Hex Tool (R) to tighten the screws.





Attach the Stabilizer Bar (F) using 4 of the Short Machine Screws (O) and 4 of the Split Washers (P). Please make sure the Stabilizer bar is installed as shown.

Attach the Mattress support using 4 of the Short Machine Screws (O). Use the Hex Tool (R) to tighten these screws.



Finaly, install the Front Gate with the strike plates pointing inside the crib. Insert one of the Slide Rods (G) throught he top hole of the gate, then through the top bracket, then through the hole on the bottom of the Front Gate, through one Spring (Q) and finaly through the L Bracket. Attach the slide rod using 1 Short Machine Screw (O) and 1 Split Washer (P). Now repeat on the other side.



Maintenance:

Once a week inspect the crib for any damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. Discontinue using the crib if any parts are missing or broken, contact Bratt Decor, Inc. For replacement part if needed.

Cleaning: if crib is dirty, wipe with a cloth dampened with warm water. **Do not use solvents.**

Storage: store in a dry place.

Warning: if this crib is not purchased new, do not use it until you have contacted Bratt Decor, Inc. To find out if the crib conforms to the current safety standards.

Place these assembly instructions and the hex tool in the bag provided on the mattress support. You will need these assembly instructions every time you assemble this crib.
