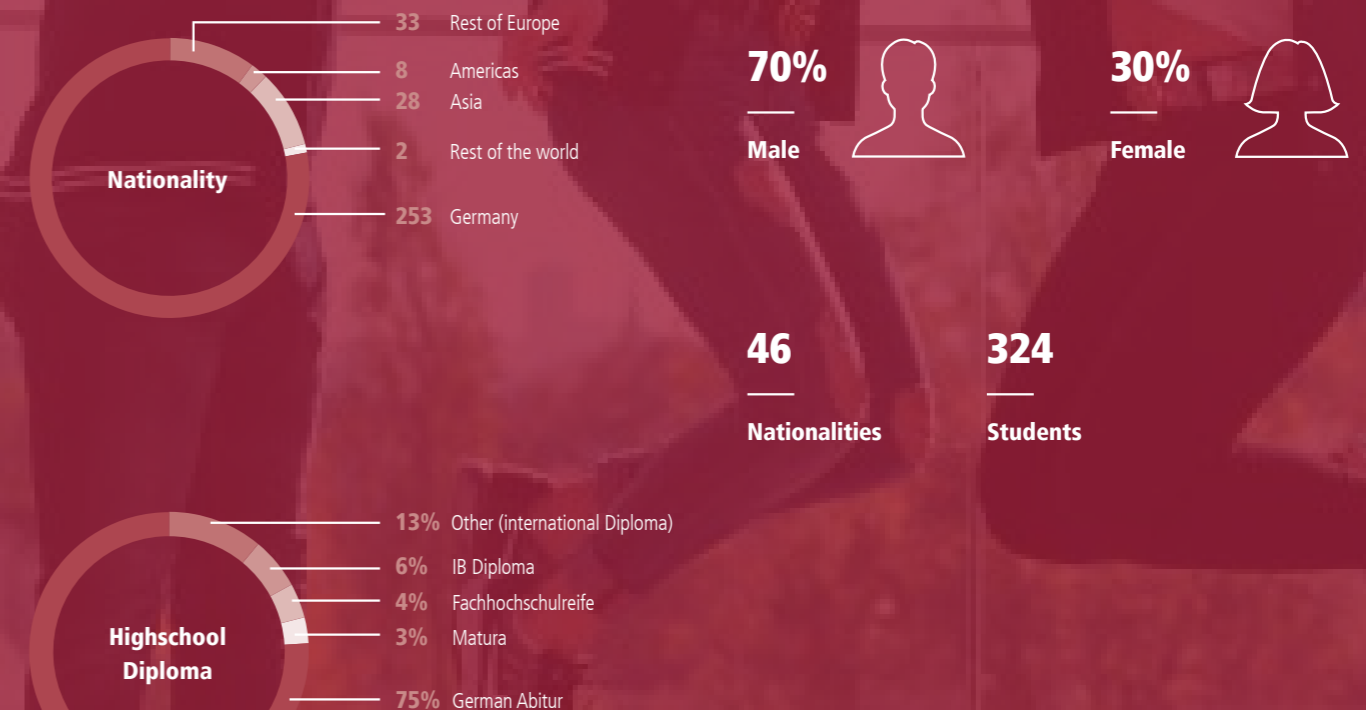

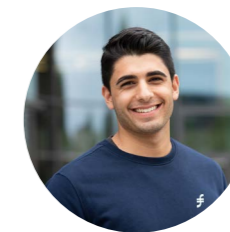

Located in the city centre of Frankfurt is the Kleinmarkthalle. The indoor market hall is a culinary paradise. It is open everyday of the week except Sundays.

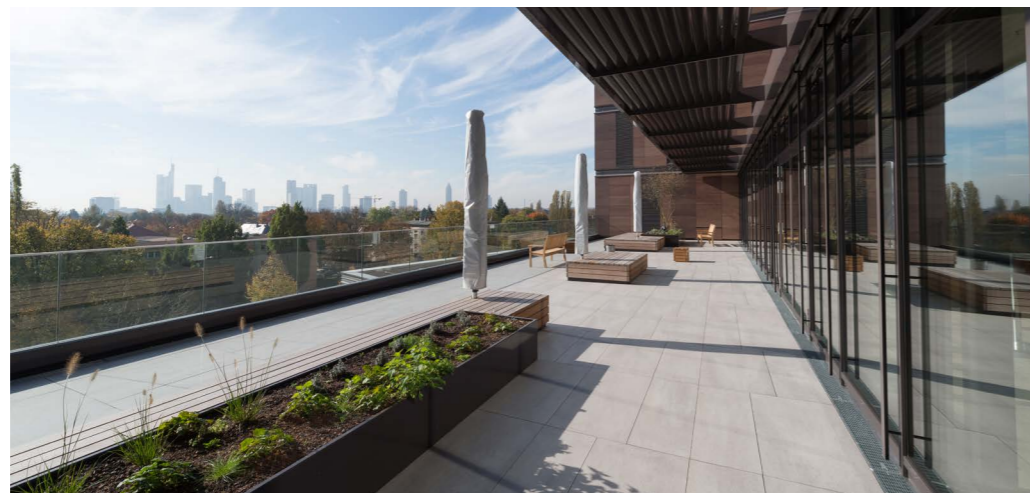
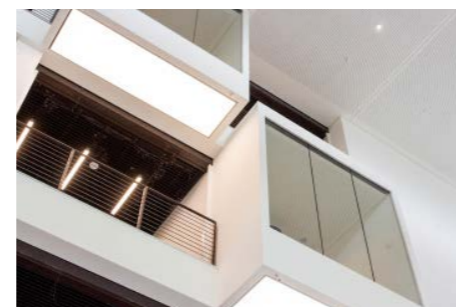

The Generation Contract

Study first, pay later: the Generation Contract (GC) is an innovative model to finance your studies. The GC allows the applicant to study at Frankfurt School without paying tuition fees during the study programme. Repayment starts after a successful career entry and after obtaining a minimum income of 30,000 EUR gross salary. Then alumni pay back a fixed percentage of their income over 10 years.

Application deadline

Admission to the programmes is competitive and places fill quickly. We therefore encourage you to complete your application as early as possible. Please keep in mind the following deadline: June 30***

Assessment Centre

We arrange multiple Assessment Centres each year in both English and German for your convenience. These take place on our campus or online and consist of various tests plus an interview. The Assessment Centre is free of charge.

Admission decision

The final decision regarding admission to our BSc programmes will be based on a combination of the candidate's school grades, English language abilities and performance at the Assessment Centre. We also take into account other significant experiences, commitments or awards such as internships, international experiences and volunteer projects.

Our programmes start at the beginning of September. A week before the classes start there will be an introduction week where you will have the chance to meet your future course mates.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Application & Admission

When can I start my application and when is the application deadline?

Our application portal always opens one year before the start of your studies. Therefore, if you are planning on starting your studies in September 2021, the application portal will be open from the 1st of September 2020 until the 30th of June 2021. Applications after June 30th will still be considered; however, places will be assigned based on availability and academic merit.

When will I receive a response regarding my application?

Once you have submitted your online application, you will usually hear back from us within 10 days. Exceptions can, of course, occur.

Do I need to take an English test (e.g. TOEFL or IELTS)?

No, you do not. An English test is incorporated into our Assessment Centre, therefore you are not required to take an external one. However, should you have already taken one of these tests, you can of course upload your results into your online application.

What is the Assessment Centre?

The Assessment Centre consist of analytical, math and English tests as well as an interview. The Assessment Centre allows us to get an overall impression of our candidates and for you to see whether Frankfurt School is the right choice for you. It is possible to master it in German or English. It is free of charge.

How often can I take the Assessment Centre?

You can only take the Assessment Centre once per academic year (September to August).

How can I prepare for the Assessment Centre?

Generally, you cannot prepare for the Assessment Centre. The Assessment Centre is based on general knowledge. We recommend you speak with our students for insider tips. If you don't know any current students, feel free to contact us and we will send you one of our students contact details. You can participate as well in our monthly Student Chat.

When are your Assessment Centre dates?

Our German Assessment Centres take place approximately once a month and in English they are every couple of months from November to July. Please see our website for the specific dates.

I'm not able to attend your Assessment Centre in Frankfurt.

What other options do I have?

If you are unable to come to Frankfurt, you may alternatively take part in our Online Assessment Centre or hand in one of the following test results instead:

- SAT
- ACT
- TestAS

If you are not able to come to our Campus in Frankfurt, we offer Online Assessment Centre. Please take a look on [xxxxx](#)

Do I need to have my secondary school diploma to apply?

No, you do not. If you have not graduated yet, then you can apply by uploading your last two school report cards. You can hand in your final school certificates later, before your study start.

Can I switch between different time models (full time, 3-day model, block model) after I submitted my application?

Yes, you can still change to your preferred time model before programme start.

Semester abroad

How much does the semester abroad cost?

The semester abroad costs vary depending on the country and university you choose.

Is the semester abroad obligatory?

Yes, you must complete at least one semester abroad during your studies.

Do I need to study at a partner university?

No, if you have chosen a university which is not listed as one of our partner universities, you may go abroad as a "free-mover". Please note, in this case, it is completely up to you to plan your semester abroad.

General questions

When do exams take place?

Exams at Frankfurt School take place twice a semester. In October and March you have your mid-terms and in December and May your final semester exams.

When are the semester holidays?

Semesters are September to December and February to May. Between these months, you are on holiday.

Can I do a master's degree after my bachelor's degree?

Yes, you can do a Master's degree after your Bachelor's degree. If you choose to do your Master's at Frankfurt School, you are eligible to skip the first semester of the programme. This means your master's would be one and half years instead of two.
