Back in the saddle again...

Well the past several months have been quite a whirlwind. As advertised, we dispersed our cowherd this past October, with the exception of the 2019 bull calf crop which we intended to and are selling now. Our goal was to slow down and still find a way to maintain our lifestyle, always keeping a small group of cows and our sanity! We would like to thank everyone that attended and/or purchased cattle in our dispersal, and wish them all the best of luck with the genetics that we so diligently designed.

Jacobson Red Angus has taken on a new view and business plan, but we still plan to raise the same quality Red Angus genetics. We continue to have a partnership with our son, Cody, and he owns his share of the current herd. Through our dispersal we have established a new business relationship with Prairie Red Angus, owned and operated by Spring Prairie Colony out of Hawley, MN. They purchased a large group of cows from the dispersal, as well as our late bred cows which we sold them privately last summer. Many of our top bull calves were on these cows and are in this sale, and Prairie Red Angus will continue to provide their best bulls to this event.

Our genetic focus has always been on the Red Angus female, and now we will enhance our focus on traits like calving ease, structure and udder quality, heifer pregnancy, stayability and high quality carcass traits. We would like to become the premier genetic provider in the mid-west for low birth, convenience minded and carcass trait minded cattle.

A major projects that Jacobson Red Angus and Prairie Red Angus is currently putting in place, is one in which we will be aggressively bidding and/or purchasing calves sired by our bulls. 



THE POWER OF 50K

Bull selection is one of the most significant decisions ranchers make in terms of influencing the overall profitability of their operations; therefore, Red Angus strives to deliver reliable genetic predictions to stakeholders to ensure producers are making the most informed decisions possible in pursuit of production goals.

For years, ranchers utilizing Red Angus EPDs (Expected Progeny Differences) in their selection decisions have enjoyed the built-in reliability and risk reduction provided through the breed's early adoption of Total Herd Reporting (THR) data. To further advance EPD accuracy and reliability, Red Angus can now incorporate 50K genomic data.

For generations, animal breeders have relied on phenotypic measurements to determine what the animal possesses at the gene level. Now, with the inclusion of 50K genomic data, we can actually measure the impact of identified gene effects before the weight or measurement is ever recorded.

EPDs predict an animal's true genetic merit which can be passed on to offspring. As the amount of data included in an animal's EPD calculation increases, ranchers can have more confidence that the EPD correctly identifies the animal's true genetic merit. This is communicated to stakeholders in the form of "Accuracy," which is printed in conjunction with each EPD and ranges from 0 to 99.


