Over the weekend Cassie Moseley dominated the barrel racing action at the Guymon Pioneer Days Rodeo in Guymon, OK. Over the course of two quick run in a total time of 34.83, Cassie and her mount Mitey Easy Alibi (better known as Mitey Man) walked away with \$7301 and jumped up to 5th in the WPRR NFR Barrel Racing standings. After ending up 4th in the World last year, earning over \$96k at the WNFR alone and over \$156k on the year total, Cassie let Mitey Man catch a breath before easing around to the first winter rodeos in Odessa, TX and Denver, CO.

After a non-productive rodeo at Houston landing her 18th in the World, Moseley started entering a few more rodeos trying to scrap

her way back up in the standings. Moseley won a little here and there and finally hit the mother lode in Guymon, and leapfrogged her way back up.

Moseley's first run at Guymon, on wetter ground, left her wondering how her run would hold up to the others but Mitey Man's run held in there for a third place even after safetying up a bit on the second and third barrels. The team came back and stormed through the second round with a smoking run and won the round and the average.

With the easy running style Mitey Man displays, he routinely clocks faster than he looks and Guymon was no exception. For anyone who watched the 2008 WNFR, they may have been surprised when round after round he looked to high lope around the barrels but a quick glance at the clock put him in the money in nearly every round.

Moseley and her big strided grey will plan to try and make the most money with the least amount of trailer time. The team will save themselves for the big money runs including the Fourth of July. "If I make it to the Finals, I want a fresh horse," Moseley said.

She will also keep busy with her upcoming colts, including offspring of Dashing La Jolla (son of Streakin La Jolla), Smash Par (son of Easily Smashed), Panther Mountain, and Shazoom all of whom she purchased as second career racehorses.

PRCA, WPRA Working Together on Initiatives to Enhance the Sport

The Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) and the Women's Professional Rodeo Association (WPRA) announced May 4 that the two organizations are working together on a number of initiatives designed to enhance the ProRodeo experience for their respective members.

The PRCA and WPRA announced that they are drafting a joint marketing initiative that, when finalized, will allow the two organizations to combine efforts to bring additional sponsors to the sport of ProRodeo. Additionally, the WPRA confirmed that its members will be fully participating in the upcoming Wrangler Million Dollar Tour presented by Justin Boots and the culmination of the Tour, the Justin Boots Playoffs, which will feature total prize money in excess of \$6.2 million.

"I have been very encouraged by the spirit of cooperation that we recently have been able to achieve between our two great rodeo organizations," said PRCA Commissioner Karl Stressman. "I have been working closely with (WPRA President) Kathi Myers and the WPRA Board to make sure that we can put all of the issues of the past behind us and move on with what is good for all of ProRodeo. We are working together on a number of fronts that I think have the potential to greatly improve ProRodeo for all of the members of the PRCA and WPRA over the next few years."

"I am very excited by the joint initiatives that we are working on with the PRCA," Myers added. "The WPRA Board is focused on continuing to improve the barrel racing event for all of our members and is looking to also grow the other new programs we've developed for all female rodeo competitors. We have been very pleased with the level of commitment and cooperation that Karl Stressman and the PRCA staff have shown in working with us to continue to move forward."

Stressman also indicated that ProRodeo is not only surviving but thriving during the economic downturn.

"ProRodeo provides quality family entertainment at a value price, and both our fans and sponsors seem to appreciate our sport even more in these tough economic times," said Stressman. "Now is a great time for the PRCA and WPRA to truly join forces to continue to take this great professional sport to the next level."

KY Derby Upset Winner Mine That Bird Has Strong NM Roots

Purists scoffed at New Mexico-bred Peppers Pride when she broke the world record for most consecutive wins. Now they have Mine That Bird to deal with.

Mine That Bird, a 50 to 1 shot with two starts this year at Sunland Park near El Paso, scored the second biggest upset in Kentucky Derby history yesterday, defeating second-placed Pioneerof the Nile by 6 3/4 lengths.

"I wasn't worried. He's a small horse and I knew I could squeeze him through," said jockey Calvin Borel, who brought Mine That Bird flying up the rail, much the same way that he did with Street Sense, when he won the 2007 Kentucky Derby.

It was the greatest margin of victory in the Derby since Assault's 8-length win in 1946. Barbaro won by 6 1/2 lengths in 2006.

"I didn't have any real feeling that I could win the Derby," said New Mexico-based Bennie "Chip" Woolley, the only first-time Kentucky Derby trainer to win in the race's 135-year history. "They say you are supposed to come with high hopes and low expectations. All I knew is that we'd be more competitive than anybody thought we would."

Owned by Mark Allen and Leonard Blach, both of Roswell, NM, Mine That Bird was a \$9,500 purchase at the 2007 Fasig-Tipton October Yearling Sale. Allen and Blach paid \$400,000 for the gelded son of Birdstone, after he won 4 of 5 starts at Woodbine in Toronto and was made Canada's 2-year-old champion.

Mine That Bird placed second in his first start this year for Allen and Blach at Sunland Park, but finished a disappointing fourth in the Sunland Derby on March 29. He was being pointed toward a stakes race at Lone Star Park in Texas, when richer candidates (Mine That Bird had earnings of \$374,381) began dropping out of the Kentucky Derby.

"This is an opportunity you might never get again," said Woolley, a former rodeo bareback rider who for the past 25 years has primarily trained Quarter Horse runners.

Leonard Blach owns and operates Buena Suerte Equine, a well known New Mexico Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred breeding facility, former home of Quarter racing legends Go Man Go and Easy Jet. Mark Allen's operates family-owned Double Eagle Ranch in Roswell. His father, Bill Allen, operated Alaskan oilfield service business Veco, and was a witness in the corruption investigation of former Alaskan Senator Ted Stevens.

Ellensburg Rodeo Announces Ticket "Stimulus Package"

Numerous Washington kids and military veterans will be able to attend performances of the Ellensburg (Wash.) Rodeo for free on Sept. 4 and Sept. 7. The rodeo committee announced the "Ellensburg Rodeo Stimulus Package" at a press conference on April 29.

"We are delighted to be able to give something back to the community that has been a critical part of the Ellensburg Rodeo," said Dave Standish, Ellensburg Rodeo president. "It couldn't come at a better time with the current state of the economy."

The Ellensburg Rodeo runs Sept. 4-7, and will also host the Xtreme Bulls Tour Finale, presented by B&W Trailers Hitches, on Sept. 5.

On Sept. 4, there will be free admission to the rodeo and fairgrounds for the Kittitas County youth baseball players (620 tickets) and local Veterans of Foreign War members (100 tickets). On Sept. 7, there will be free admission to the rodeo and fairgrounds for the Kittitas County 4H and Future Farmers of America members (more than 400 tickets) and local VFW members (100 tickets).

PAY IT FORWARD - WITH JILL MOODY

The great thing about our sport is that you can ride a slow horse to be fast or a fast horse to be slow and either way way win the barrel race.

As the grass turns green and the trees sprout new leaves the horsepeople of the Northern Plains are finally able to find their horses which have been hidden under layers of hair for the past five months. All hands are on deck repairing the fences, spring cleaning the barn, organizing the trailer, and gearing up for the competitions that are springing up along with the grass. This is the time of year when everyone wants to get ahead of the game by learning new techniques and polishing up on already acquired skills.

There are several avenues of instruction available to the prospective student. Clinics, videos, RFDtv, private instruction and help from the neighbor are some of the options offered to the inquiring mind. Age and experience of both horse and rider, cost, distance, and credentials are important aspects to consider when choosing how and from whom to illicit advice. I believe that everyone who is striving to become a better horseperson has something to offer and something to learn. I also believe that there is no right way or wrong way. Some ways may be safer, faster, and more efficient than others but who can really say what is right or what is wrong. After all barrel racing is a timed event; the fastest time wins, period.

Those of us who train, compete, and teach may think we have it all figured out but never say never. "I've got it figured out" turns into "I have no idea" more than you would expect among "professionals." Success can be measured in several different categories; money won, championships won, numbers sold, and attendance are a few.

Most of us migrate towards the people who have the biggest numbers behind their name to seek advice. We consider them to

be knowledgeable and rightly so. But one can't discount the little girl down the street who is kicking everyone's butt at the jackpot. Nor can you ignore the young woman on the home raised and trained horse who is placing at the prorodeos.

They might not know how to express it but they must be doing something right. "Usually" smoother is faster and a pretty runs stop the clock sooner. A slow horse that makes a smooth pretty run will probably outrun the triple A horse that bounces off of the fences, but never say never.

A flawless run to one person is categorized as terrible by the next. The great thing about our sport is that you can ride a slow horse to be fast or a fast horse to be slow and either way win the barrel race. There is no right or wrong, it's a timed event!

The professionals in the barrel racing industry have figured out ways to do things in a manner that they consider right because they have found success with certain methods. But great competitors are not always great trainers, great clinicians do not always compete, and great trainers live a world of their own! Keep that in mind when you are looking for an instructor, clinician, trainer, or jockey.

With that said remember that everyone has something to offer and with each experience take with you what you can use and put the rest in storage. I was told that exact thing as an aspiring trainer and it only took me 20 years to figure out what it means.

My interpretation of that tidbit of advice is that once you know what you can use and what to put in storage you will understand what it means! Honestly, it's just adding up life's lessons but I will

try to give you an example.

Let's say I have chosen to go to a barrel racing clinic. My clinician sets up a barrel pattern but is focusing on the third barrel. She has me lope through the first and second directly to the third and turn it and come home. That exercise is something I would put on the back burner because I believe horses easily adapt to patterns and I want them to do the whole pattern. My friend who came to the clinic with me will use the clinician's exercise because she believes you should have enough control to put your horse where you want them, not necessarily following a pattern. Obviously the clinician believes there is some benefit to that exercise because she is using it as a teaching tool. But what "exactly" is she trying to teach?

Each person has their own interpretation, right or wrong. If they win the barrel race I guess they were right. But if they don't was the clinician's advice wrong or did the student interpret it wrong?

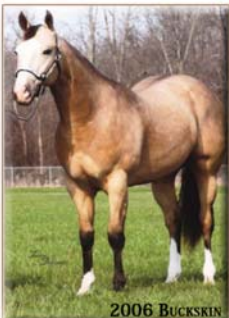

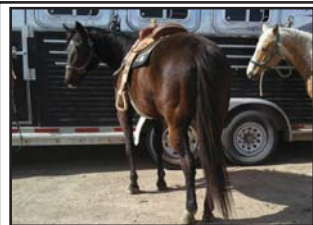
