Aim:

1. To recite Qura'an as it was revealed.

It is narrated that he sas said: "Verily Allah Most High loves for the Qura'an to be read as it was revealed." (Kanzal' Amal V.2

Hadeeth # 3069)

Angel Jibreel revealed the Reading, Allah *swt* taught him and the prophet *sas* received it as he heard it. He taught his companions the Holy Quran as he received it from Jibreel (*As*), urging them to recite it as it was revealed.

2. To fulfill the obligation (Fard) of learning the Tajweed.

Its Legal Status:

The science of Tajweed is Fard Kefaya but the practice of Tajweed is a must for everyone who reads Quran- even if one doesn't know the Tajweed rules from theoretical point of view.

Object:

- I. To obey the commands of Allah *swt* and to follow His prophet Mohammad *sas*.
- **II.** To learn the Phonetics and rules of Pronunciation and intonation of The Glorious Quran.

The proof that Tajweed is obligatory (fard) is from:

Quran:

1. Furgan: 32 "...... We have recited it with distinct recitation"

2. Muzzammil: 4 "......and recite the Quran with measured recitation."

Hadeeth:

- **1.** Zaid ibn Thabit narrateshis *sas* saying that "Verily Allah Loves the Quran to be read as it was revealed."
- 2. Prophet Muhammad (SAS) said, "Best among you is one who learned to read the Qur'an and taught others." (Bukhari and Muslim)
- **3.** He also mentioned, "The example of a believer who recites Qur'an is like that of a fruit whose smell is good and taste delicious." (Ahmad in Masnad)
- **4.** In another tradition he said, "One who recites the Book of Allah (Qur'an) will be rewarded the equivalent of ten good deeds for each and every letter.. " (Tirmizi, Darumi)
- 5. He'also said,"Learn Qur'an and recite it. Indeed the example of a person who learns how to read the Qur'an, recites it, and acts upon it, is like that of a bag full of musk, the fragrance of which spreads in the entire house " (Tirmizi, Annisai, Ibn Maja)
- **6.** And there is another saying of the Prophet (*sas*),"A believer who does not remember even a small portion of the Qur'an is just like a deserted home." (Tirmizi, Abu Daud, Ahmad)

Definition of Tajweed:

Linguistically = to improve

As a terminology of Phonetics of Quran: It means recitation of every letter of The Holy Quran from its point of articulation, with its attributes and other rules of phonetics.
