Cost

- Both domestic and international transcript assessment requests are \$100 CAD

Documentation

- Official transcript document is required direct from your post-secondary institution to the CPAWSB

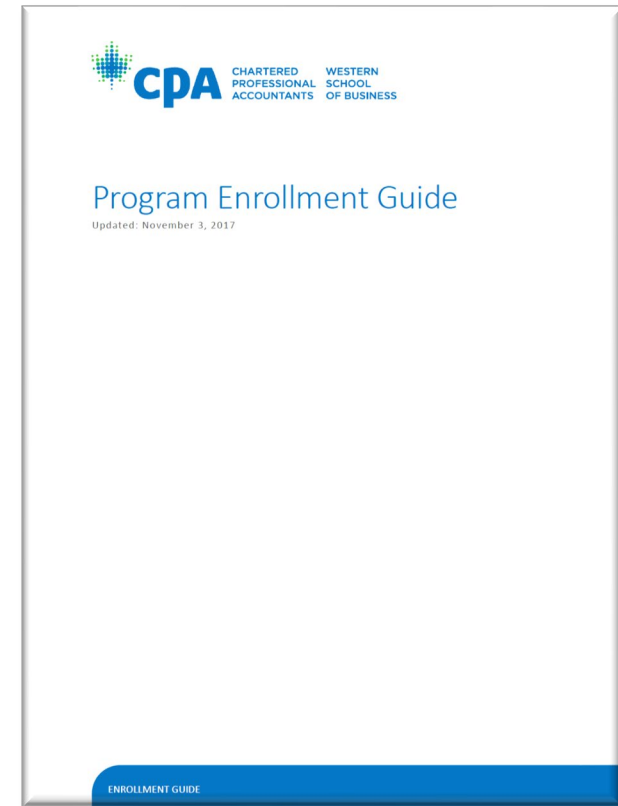
3rd Party Evaluations

- For degrees earned outside of Canada, a 3rd party evaluation is required
