Father Should Honor Their Children's Birthright

- 2 Tim. 3:15
- "And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

- 1. Compassion like the father of the prodigal son
- 2. Patience in instruction and discipline
- Col. 3:21
- "Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged."

- 3. Nurturing as we encourage, help and strengthen our children
- Nurture = to bring up; train; educate.
- Lk. 11:11, 13

- Lk. 11:11
- "If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent?"

- Lk. 11:13
- "If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?"

- 4. Be the right kind of example –
- A faithful father teaches by example
- Prov. 23:26
- "My son, give me thine heart, and let thine eyes observe my ways"

- 1. Put the kingdom first and teach the family to do the same
- Mt. 6:33
- "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

- 2. Teach his children to love, respect & obey their parents
- 3. Be a loving husband & a considerate father
- 4. Provide physical and spiritual leadership

- 5. Be honest in all his dealings
- 6. Set aside Sunday for his family to worship
- 7. Never speak or act in an unChristian manner

- 8. Rule his household with love, kindness, and care
- 9. Love and respect every family member
- Mt. 7:12

- 1. Pray with and for your children
- Js. 5:16

 "Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much."

- 2. Teach them to study and worship
- Mt. 4:10
- "Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve."

- 3. Show them how to do good works
- Mt. 5:16
- "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven."

- 4. Prepare their hearts
- Js. 1:12
- "Blessed *is* the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him."
