BEN MCPEAK COUNTRY MUSIC ARTIST

Ben McPeak is a touring Country Music Band. The music is that straight ahead 90's country sound that will keep you on the dance floor. He plays a mixture of original and cover songs that lean more towards traditional country. Ben McPeak started performing professionally the day after he graduated high school, and has been at it ever since. McPeak performed full time at San Antonio's former Fiesta Texas Opryland theme park



(now Six Flags) while also fronting his own band, playing clubs and private shows. While keeping the band together, McPeak's full time music career took a bit of a back seat as he began building a professional career as a wealth advisor, aircraft broker, and entrepreneur. A few of his ventures in the business world took him to Nashville where he befriended some of the best writers in the country music industry. So, with many years of live show experience, writing sessions in Texas and

Nashville, he decided it was time to combine his talents and record his debut album, *Better Off*,—

On *Better Off*, McPeak wraps his rich baritone vocals around eight neo-traditionalist tracks, influenced by the '90s-era country he loves most. Among his touchstone artists are several who topped the charts then, including Garth Brooks, George Strait, Alan Jackson and Keith Whitley. (Of course, Haggard, Jennings, Cash and Twitty also make his list.)



McPeak cowrote three songs on *Better Off* with some of the hitmakers who helped put those artists on top of the charts. After introductions by good friend and album producer

Billy Decker, he composed “Good Woman Waiting” with Bernie Nelson (“The Ride,” “Daddy Never Was the Cadillac Kind”) and Frank Myers (“You and I,” “I Swear”).

“Being in the room with these guys who have had humongous hits was not only an awesome way to learn, but also a very humbling experience,” says McPeak, who wrote “What Would Chris LeDoux,” about another favorite, with Nelson and Robert Arthur (Brad Paisley, Cody Johnson). McPeak and Troy Olsen (Blake Shelton, Tim McGraw) penned “Lonely Leave Me Alone.”

The title track is by Logan Mize and Casey Beathard; “Fix You Up” is by Rhett Akins, Ben Hayslip and Craig Wiseman; Akins, Hayslip and Chris Young wrote “Put It on Repeat.”

The album was recorded at Benchmark Sound in the same Music Row building where Cash, Strait and many other top artists recorded under its Emerald Sound Studio name (Eddie Rabbitt tracked “I Love a Rainy Night” there). It was mixed at Westwood Studio, also in Nashville.

McPeak is planning to perform at select Texas venues in support of the project, and turn country music fans on to this recording, now that it’s finally here.
