

Everyone knows that when it comes to credit score, higher is better. But when you're trying to set a new high score, it helps to know the rules of the game! Whether you're talking about the traditional FICO score or the newer Vantage model, there are four main components used to calculate your credit score. Think of them as the levels in a video game, and let's break them down one at a time:





Just like Tetris blocks, your balances build up over time. And just like it's important to clear out those blocks in a timely manner, credit score calculations like to see you pay down your balances on a regular basis. Making your payments on schedule just might be the most important aspect of maintaining a healthy credit score. You should always make your minimum payment, but if you go above and beyond and pay a little more each month, it will work in your favor.

LEVEL 2

CREDIT USAGE

When you're in 2nd place in Mario Kart and you get the red shell, you use it, right? You bet! And you can apply the same logic to using your credit. If you don't use it, the credit score companies don't have information to work with. It may seem a little paradoxical, but your credit score may actually go down in times of heavy usage. But don't worry, when you continue to make consistent payments (see Level 1), it will go right back up.
